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

HOW TO USE THE ADJUST-O-PEG

MEAVING

FOR DIP FILM

- 1. Set pegs to desired position.
- 2. Form wire around pegs.
- 3. Dip wire in film and let dry.
- Assemble dipped wires to make flowers, earrings or ornaments.

FOR YARN and RAFFIA SQUARES

- Set pegs in every other hole in outer row of holes in the Adjust-O-Peg.
- Wind yarn around pegs as illustrated.
- 3. Thread needle and weave as illustrated.
- Assemble squares into Afghan or place mats.

FOR RAFFIA & STRING FLOWERS

- Set up pegs as per pattern desired.
- Wrap raffia or string around pegs.
- 3. Thread needle and stitch knitcenteraofoflower.
 - Remove from loom, add pin or earring attachment and wear.

Adjust-O-Peg Instructions Wire Edged Flowers & Other Projects

The use of pliers is recommended for inserting and removing the pegs.



The ADJUST-O-PEG is used the same way for most all of the different projects that use a wire edge to hold and form the material being used. The first step in preparing the Adjust-O-Peg for use is to insert the pegs in the holes so that the pattern desired is developed by the pegs. Then the wire is formed and the ends twisted so the wire will hold the shape given to it by the position of the pegs. See figure 1.

Figures 2, 3, & 4 are pictures of finished dip film flowers. The wires were formed on the Adjust-O-Peg and then the wires were dipped in colored dip film. After the individual forms were dipped the parts were assembled into the flowers shown above.

Figure 5 shows ornaments and earrings made on the Adjust-O-Peg. The technique of using the Adjust-O-Peg to make dip film flowers is fully illustrated in the book titled "Dip Film Flowers". Figures 6 & 7 show flowers made with the braid covered wire and Pearl Parchment. Pearl Parchment is a decorative paper. Most any paper could be used as well as burlap, satin or any other material that is thin, flat & flexible. You may develop your own patterns for making flowers by using a real flower and breaking it apart. The various parts of the flower are then laid on the Adjust-O-Peg and the pegs are set up around the part. After the pegs are set up the wire is formed and twisted to hold shape. The wire form is then dipped, if you are using dip film. If you are using the flat material for spanning across the wire you need to apply glue to the wire. To best accomplish this use a piece of foil or waxed paper and apply a line of glue on the foil in the shape of the wire form. It is then easy to apply the glue by rubbing the wire in the glue. The wire is then carefully placed on the decorative paper that is being used to span across the wire and left to dry. If the wire form was not flat when placed on the material you may have to cover it with waxed paper and then weigh it down with a book until dry. Trim around the wire with a pair of scissors or a sharp knife. The parts are then ready to assemble.





Raffia & String Projects



The Adjust-O-Peg is highly adaptable as a loom for Ribbon Straw. The pins & earrings shown above illustrate the types of designs possible when you use the Adjust-O-Peg for this purpose. Projects above range in size from 3/4" to 4".



These "Swinger" type earrings were made on the Adjust-O-Peg. These range in in size from 3/4" to 2".

STEP BY STEP



The plug may be used as a very tiny loom. When using plug for this purpose the needle may be passed between Raffia Straw and surface of plug to tie center of flower. With plug removed the hole in center of loom permits use of needle to tie center.



Set up pegs as shown in fig. 1. Secure raffia to Adjust-O-Peg with masking tape. Position raffia around pegs as shown above. Follow the next step as shown in fig. 2. Figure 3 is a continuation of the procedure so continue to follow the illustrations above. The procedure you have been following is continued until all pegs have been wrapped once. Figure 4 shows every other peg now being wrapped. In order to make the full flower continue wrapping around the rest of the pegs.

After all pegs have been wrapped tape the finishing end of the raffia to the Adjust-O-Peg. You may wish to use a contrasting color to

stitch the center. Take about 3 ft. of raffia and thread a needle with it. You may stitch with the raffia doubled. Place the needle up through the hole in the Adjust-O-Peg. Pull raffia up'until all excess is above the flower. Move needle over two strands to the left and insert the needle through the flower. Now bring the needle up through the strands to the left of where you started. Continue on around until you have stitched completely around the flower. Stop stitching with the needle going down toward the back of the flower. The raffia may then be tied off at the back. After stitching is completed flower may be removed.

Yarn Projects



flowers the pegs are set up on a circle and one on each heavy diagonal line. The center is stitched the same as the raffia flower shown above.

hole around the outside of the Adjust-O-Peg. Tie yarn to a corner peg and weave the yarn back and forth.

& forth through the strands going across the opposite direction. The needle is worked so that it goes over one strand & under the next.
