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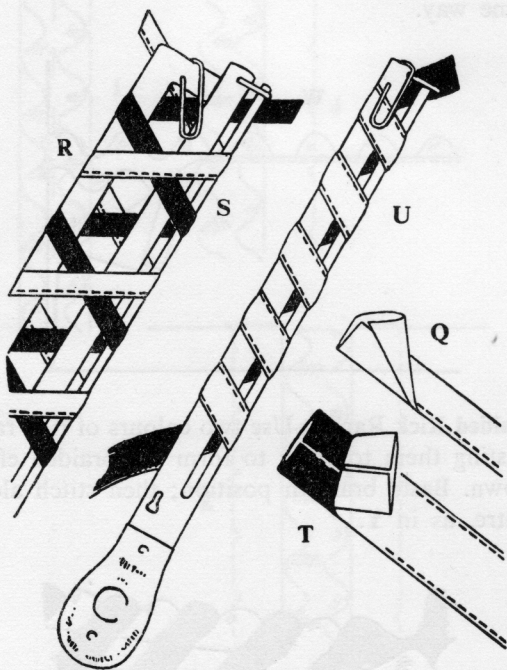
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Trimmings from Bias Binding. A variety of decorative effects can be achieved with bias binding by using the Singercraft Guide. Two of the possibilities are shown here. In **Q**, fold bias binding so that raw edges are inside, then stitch as shown. Using two colours of binding, wind in criss-cross pattern on the Guide, as in **R**. Hold ends of binding

in place with a paper clip, as at **S**. Stitch together. In **T**, two colours of bias binding are laid together, raw edges inside, and stitched on both folded edges.



The double-faced strip is then wound around Singercraft Guide, as in **U**, and stitched through slot in Guide. Both of these trimmings are practical for cotton garments and home furnishings.

Other uses of the Singercraft Guide are shown on pages 134 and 230. Consult the instruction sheet that comes with the Guide for complete instructions on using it.

Rick Rack Applied with Singercraft Guide. Wind rick rack around Guide in same manner as binding in **U**, then stitch in position.
