SHAGGY RUGS . . . Shaggy rugs are made on a canvas base and are easy to do and fun to make. Clark's O.N.T. Rug Backgrounds are the canvases to use for the designs on this leaflet. They can be bought in a variety of shapes and in three different sizes. With these backgrounds you can also make solid color rugs by using only one color for your bundles and sewing them to the canvas in the same manner as for shaggy patterned rugs.

To make the shaggy rug designs illustrated be sure to purchase the correct rug background as specified in the "Materials" listed with each design. Also be sure to use the side of the canvas having the number specified.

With a pencil, outline your entire design, drawing your line from dot to dot on the canvas, following the chart. If any part of the design is *not* outlined, it would be advisable where there is more than one color in the design, to make a circle around the dots in different colored crayons for separation. The word "CENTER" on chart corresponds to the "X" on the canvas. Start counting your dots from this "X" at the center to make it easy. "X"s on the outer edges, dividing the sides in half, will also help you in counting.

Following the symbols below the chart, make bundles in the length and color designated. We think you will find it more inter-

esting to make a quantity of bundles of one color at a time, and then sew them to the canvas.

BUNDLE WINDER . . . The little gadget below we've called a Bundle Winder. Use it for speed and ease in making these rugs. Follow directions below for its use.

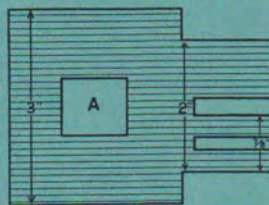


DIAGRAM FOR BUNDLE WINDER

HOW TO MAKE BUNDLES

To Make a 3" Cut Bundle: Wind rug yarn 12 times around the 3-inch width (see diagram) of Bundle Winder. Cut it loose from the ball of yarn. Using a darning needle with Clark's O.N.T. Button and Carpet Thread, bind firmly around the wound yarn 2 or 3 times at center, through opening ("A" on diagram) and tie securely. Break off. Cut yarn at both ends of Bundle Winder, and pick up bundle by the bound center. You now have one complete bundle.

To Make a 2" Cut Bundle: Wind as for a 3" cut bundle, but wind yarn around the

2-inch width (see diagram) of Bundle Winder. Sew through center slot and cut yarn at ends of Bundle Winder before removing.

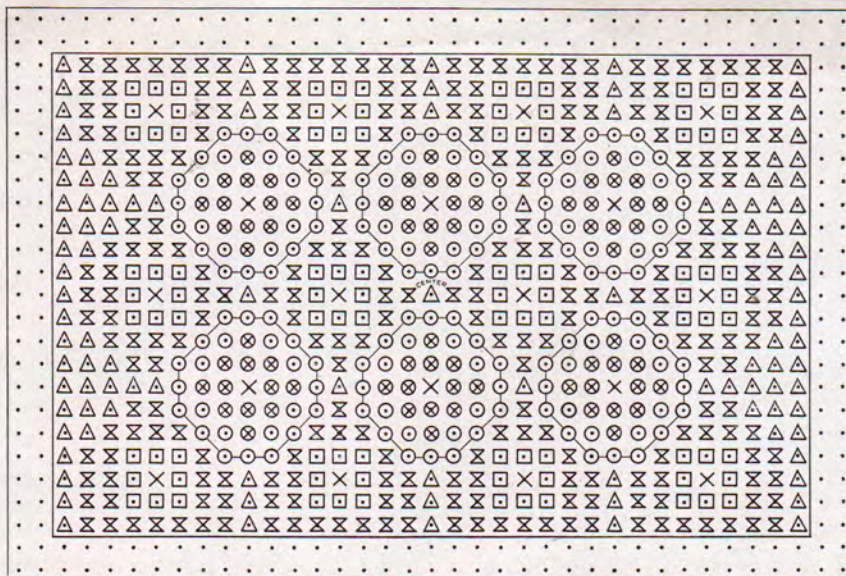
To Make a 2" Loop Bundle: Wind as for a 2" cut bundle, but do not cut yarn at ends of Bundle Winder. Remove by sliding off. You now have completed one loop bundle.

To Sew Bundles to Canvas: Place the knot of the bundle over the dot on the canvas, as indicated on chart. With darning needle and Clark's O.N.T. Button and Carpet Thread, sew bundle to canvas with two cross stitches, one over the other, on the wrong side (being sure to catch the bundle securely). Fasten thread and break off.

When all bundles are sewn to canvas, turn under on the edge outlined, and hem on the wrong side. (It will be necessary to trim the canvas at corners for an oval or round rug.)

TO WASH RUGS: Dissolve a generous quantity of mild soap flakes in lukewarm water. Squeeze suds through the rug until it is clean—NEVER RUB OR WRING. Rinse twice in clean lukewarm water, and squeeze out water with hands. Lay rug on floor, pulling into shape, and allow to dry. Do not use a washing machine or pass rug through a wringer. When a shaggy rug is almost dry, shake to restore fluff.

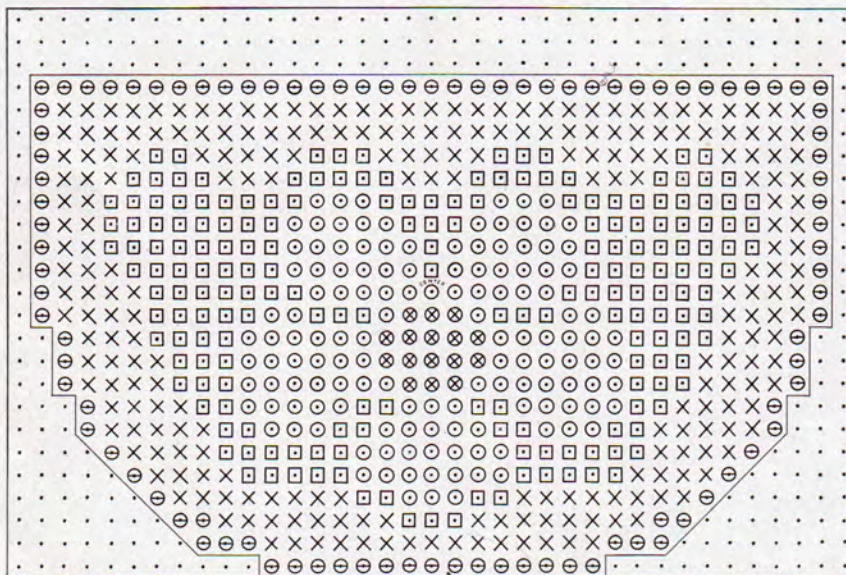
Finished Rug about 21 x 33 inches, using 28 x 40 inch canvas. Cut at outside line of stamped pattern and turn under to end design.

MATERIALS: CLARK'S O.N.T. COTTON RUG YARN, 14 balls, in colors as itemized.

Use 28 x 40 inch canvas. Hem square corners as directed. Cut around corners, allowing 1½ inches for hemming.
