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# Handkerchiefs

Use J. & P. COATS

TATTING-CROCHET, Size 70

**No. 9066 . . . MATERIALS:** J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, Size 70, 2 balls.

Sr of (4 ds, p) twice, 4 ds, cl and tie. \* Rw, lr of 4 ds, 3 sm p's sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, sm p, 10 ds, cl and tie. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, r of 2 ds, join to 2nd p of sr, 2 ds, 6 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch and join thread to last sm p of lr. R of 4 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl and tie. Repeat from \* for length desired. Tie and cut.

**No. 9063 . . . MATERIALS:** J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, Size 70, 2 balls . . . Handkerchief.

**MOTIF (Make 4) . . .** Beginning at a corner, lr of 4 ds, sm p, 10 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 6 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. \* Sr of 4 ds, join to last sm p of preceding lr, 2 ds, 9 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch, make a center r of 8 ds, sm p, 4 ds, lp,

4 ds, sm p, 8 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, sr of (2 ds, p) twice, 2 ds, join to center p of preceding sr, 2 ds, 8 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, center r of 8 ds, join to last sm p of previous center r, 4 ds, join to lp of 1st center r, 4 ds, sm p, 8 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch, sr of 2 ds, 4 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to 2nd-from-last p of last sr, 2 ds, 4 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Lr of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding sr, 10 ds, p, 10 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Sr of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 2 ds, 9 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch, make and join another center r as before. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, r of (2 ds, p) twice, 2 ds, join to center p of last sr, 2 ds, 8 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, make and join another center r. Rw, sp of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch, r of 2 ds, 4 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to 2nd-from-last p of last sr, 2 ds, 4 p's sep by 2 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 6 ds, p,

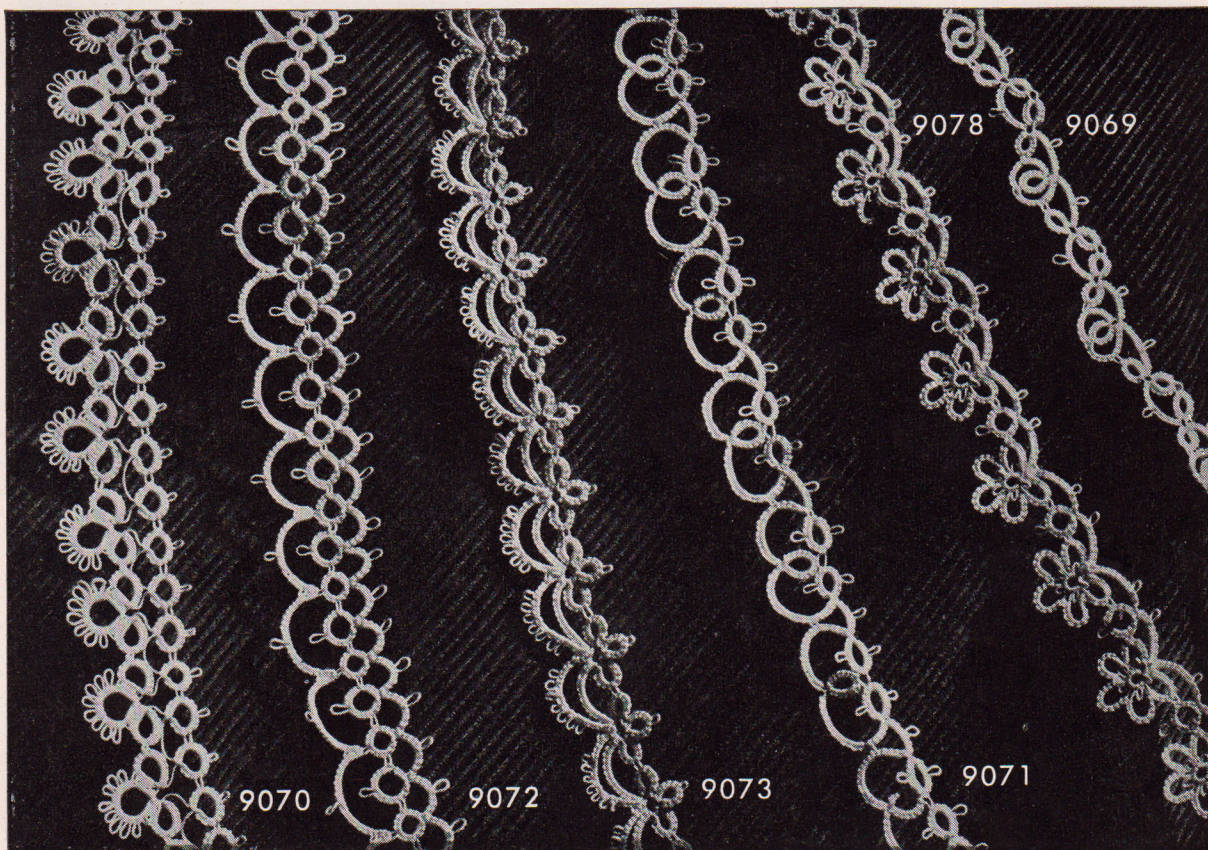
4 ds, p, 10 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Repeat from \* once more, joining the last sm p of last center r to 1st sm p of 1st center r and joining the last sm p of last sr to the 1st sm p of the 1st lr. Tie and cut.

**EDGING . . .** R of 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to 2nd free p of 1st lr made on a motif, 2 ds, 5 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. \* Sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, r of 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to next-to-last p of preceding r, 2 ds, 5 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Repeat from \* until piece reaches corresponding position on other side of handkerchief, joining 6th p on last r of edging to the 1st free p of 3rd lr made on next motif. Continue thus until the 4 motifs are joined. After completing the tatting, baste the corners in place. With ruler, draw lines on handkerchief just touching the picots of the corner and fasten corners to handkerchief by buttonholing over this line, catching in the picots. Whip edging in place.

Sr of 4 ds, 3 sm p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{8}$  inch, r of 9 ds, sm p, 4 ds, sm p, 5 ds, cl. \* R of 5 ds, join to last sm p of preceding r, 2 ds, 8 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, sm p, 5 ds, cl. R of 5 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 4 ds, sm p, 9 ds, cl (last 3 r's constitute a clover). Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{8}$  inch, r of 4 ds, join to last sm p of last sr, (4 ds, sm p) twice, 4 ds, cl. Sp of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch, sr of 4 ds, join to last sm p of preceding r, (4 ds, sm p) twice, 4 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{8}$  inch, r of 9 ds, join to sm p of last r of clover, 4 ds, sm p, 5 ds, cl. Repeat from \* for length desired.

**No. 9072 . . . MATERIALS:** J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, *Size 70.*

**1st row:** Tie ball and shuttle threads together. Sr of 4 ds, 3 sm p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. \* Rw, ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Rw, lr of 4 ds, join to last sm p of preceding r, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Rw, sr of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 4 ds, 2 sm p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. Repeat from \* for desired length, ending with a sr. **2nd row:** Fasten ball and shuttle threads to 2nd p of 1st r of 1st row. Ch of 2 ds, sm p, 9 ds, p, 9 ds, sm p, 2 ds, \* skip lr, join free p of next sr of 1st row. Ch of 2 ds, join to last p of preceding ch, 9 ds, p, 9 ds, sm p, 2 ds. Repeat from \* across. Tie and cut.

**No. 9073 . . . MATERIALS:** J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, *Size 70.*

**1st row:** Tie ball and shuttle threads together. R of 6 ds, sm p, 5 ds, sm p, 1 ds, cl. \* R of 1 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, (5 ds, sm p) twice, 1 ds, cl. R of 1 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 5 ds, sm p, 6 ds, cl (shamrock made). Rw, ch of 16 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 5 ds, sm p, 1 ds, cl. Repeat from \* for desired length. Tie and cut. **2nd row:** Fasten ball and shuttle threads to sp at base of 1st shamrock of 1st row. Ch of 2 ds, sm p, \* 4 ds, 7 p's sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, sm p, 2 ds, join to sp at base of next shamrock. Ch of 2 ds, join to last sm p of preceding ch. Repeat from \* across. Tie and cut.

Tie ball and shuttle threads together. R of 4 ds, 3 p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 6 ds, sm p, 14 ds. \* Rw, r of 8 ds, join to 2nd p of preceding r, 8 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 14 ds, sm p, 6 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to 2nd p of next-to-last r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Ch of 4 ds, p, 4 ds. R of 4 ds, 3 p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 6 ds, join to sm p of next-to-last ch, 14 ds. Repeat from \* for desired length, ending with rw, r of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to 2nd p of next-to-last r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Tie and cut.

**No. 9078 . . . MATERIALS:** J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, *Size 70.*

Tie ball and shuttle threads together. Lr of 4 ds, sm p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. \* Rw, ch of 3 ds, p, 7 ds, sm p, 1 ds. Rw, sr of 1 ds, 9 sm p's sep by 1 ds, 1 ds, cl. Ch of 6 ds, join to last sm p of last lr, 4 ds. Skip 1 p on last sr, join to next p. (Ch of 10 ds, skip next p on same sr, join to next p) 3 times. Ch of 4 ds, sm p, 6 ds, join to base of sr (flower made). Rw, ch of 1 ds, join to p on adjoining ch, 7 ds, p, 3 ds. Rw, lr of 4 ds, join to sm p of last ch of flower, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Repeat from \* for length desired. Tie and cut.

**No. 9069 . . . MATERIALS:** J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, *Size 70.*

Tie ball and shuttle threads together. \* Sr of 6 ds, sm p, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 5 ds, p, 6 ds. Rw, lr of 7 ds, sm p, 7 ds, cl. Ch of 6 ds, join to sm p of sr, 6 ds, join to sm p of lr, 6 ds, sm p, 6 ds and fasten ball thread to sp at base of lr. Rw, ch of 6 ds, p, 5 ds. Rw, sr of 6 ds, join to sm p in next-to-last ch, 6 ds, cl. Rw, sr of 6 ds, sm p, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 6 ds, p, 6 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 6 ds, cl. Rw, repeat from \* for length desired. Tie and cut.

R of 9 ds, p, 7 ds, p, 2 ds, cl. \* Rw, r of 9 ds, p, 3 ds, sm p, 6 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, r of 2 ds, join to 2nd p of next-to-last r, 2 ds, 9 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, r of 6 ds, join to sm p of next-to-last r, 3 ds, p, 9 ds, cl. Rw, r of 2 ds, join to last p of next-to-last r, 7 ds, p, 9 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{8}$  inch, r of 6 ds, cl. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{8}$  inch, r of 9 ds, join to p of next-to-last r, 7 ds, p, 2 ds, cl. Repeat from \* for length desired. Tie and cut.

### No. 9074 . . . MATERIALS: J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, Size 70.

**1st row:** Tie ball and shuttle threads together. \* R of 2 ds, 4 sm p's sep by 2 ds, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 9 ds, p, 9 ds, join to 4th sm p of preceding r. Rw and repeat from \* for desired length, ending with a joined ch. Tie and cut. **2nd row:** Fasten ball and shuttle threads to 2nd sm p of 1st r of 1st row. Ch of 2 ds, sm p, 7 ds, sm p, 2 ds. \* Join to 2nd sm p of next r on 1st row. Ch of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding ch, 8 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, (sm p, 4 ds) twice, join to 2nd sm p of next r on 1st row, (4 ds, sm p) twice, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 22 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, sm p, 4 ds, join to 3rd sm p of preceding r, 4 ds, join to same p to which preceding r is joined, (4 ds, sm p) twice, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 8 ds, sm p, 2 ds, join to 2nd sm p of next r on 1st row. Ch of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding ch, 7 ds, sm p, 2 ds. Repeat from \* across. Tie and cut.

### No. 9075 . . . MATERIALS: J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, Size 70.

Tie ball and shuttle threads together. R of 2 ds, 7 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. \* Rw, ch of 6 ds, p, 6 ds. Rw, r of 2 ds, 7 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 6 ds, join to 6th p of next-to-last r, 5 ds, sm p, 1 ds. Rw, r of 7 ds, join to 6th p of preceding r, 3 ds, (p, 5 ds) twice, cl. Rw, r of 1 ds, join to sm p on preceding ch, 9 ds, p, 9 ds, sm p, 1 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 1 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 14 ds. Rw, r of (2 ds, p) twice, 2 ds, join to last p of next-to-last r, 2 ds, 4 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 14 ds, sm p, 1 ds. Rw, r of 5 ds, join to 5th p of preceding r, 5 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 7 ds, cl. Rw, r of 1 ds, join to sm p on preceding ch, 9 ds, p, 9 ds, sm p, 1 ds, cl. Ch of 1 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 5 ds, p, 6 ds. Rw, r of 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to last p of next-to-last r, 2 ds, 5 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Ch of 6 ds, p, 6 ds. Rw, r of 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to p on

next-to-last ch, 2 ds, 5 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Repeat from \* for desired length. Tie and cut.

Tie ball and shuttle threads together. R of 3 ds, 6 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 1 ds, sm p, 7 ds, sm p, 2 ds. \*\* Rw, r of 6 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 2 ds, p, 8 ds, cl. Rw, r of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding ch, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl. R of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 6 ds, p, 8 ds, cl and tie over closings of both r's (clover made). Rw, ch of 11 ds. R of 10 ds, p, 2 ds, sm p, 8 ds, cl. Ch of 9 ds, sm p, 3 ds. For round motif, rw, r of 7 ds, sm p, 3 ds, lp, 3 ds, sm p, 7 ds, cl. \* Rw, ch of 3 ds, 4 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Rw, r of 7 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 3 ds, join to lp of preceding r, 3 ds, sm p, 7 ds, cl. Repeat from \* 2 more times. Rw, ch of 3 ds, 4 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Rw, r of 7 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 3 ds, join to same lp, 3 ds, join to sm p of 1st r of round motif, 7 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to free p of 3rd r of clover, (3 ds, p) twice, 3 ds. Join to base of 1st r of round motif, thus completing it. Ch of 3 ds, join to sm p of adjacent ch, 9 ds. R of 8 ds, join to sm p of adjacent r, 2 ds, p, 10 ds, cl. Ch of 11 ds. Rw, r of 8 ds, join to 3rd p on 1st ch of preceding round motif, 6 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl. R of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl and tie. Rw, r of 8 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 6 ds, cl (clover made). Rw, ch of 2 ds, join to sm p of next-to-last r, 7 ds, sm p, 1 ds. Rw, r of 3 ds, join to 2nd p of preceding r, 3 ds, 5 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 1 ds, join to sm p of preceding ch, 7 ds, sm p, 2 ds. Repeat from \*\* for length desired. Tie and cut.

### No. 9080 . . . MATERIALS: J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, Size 70.

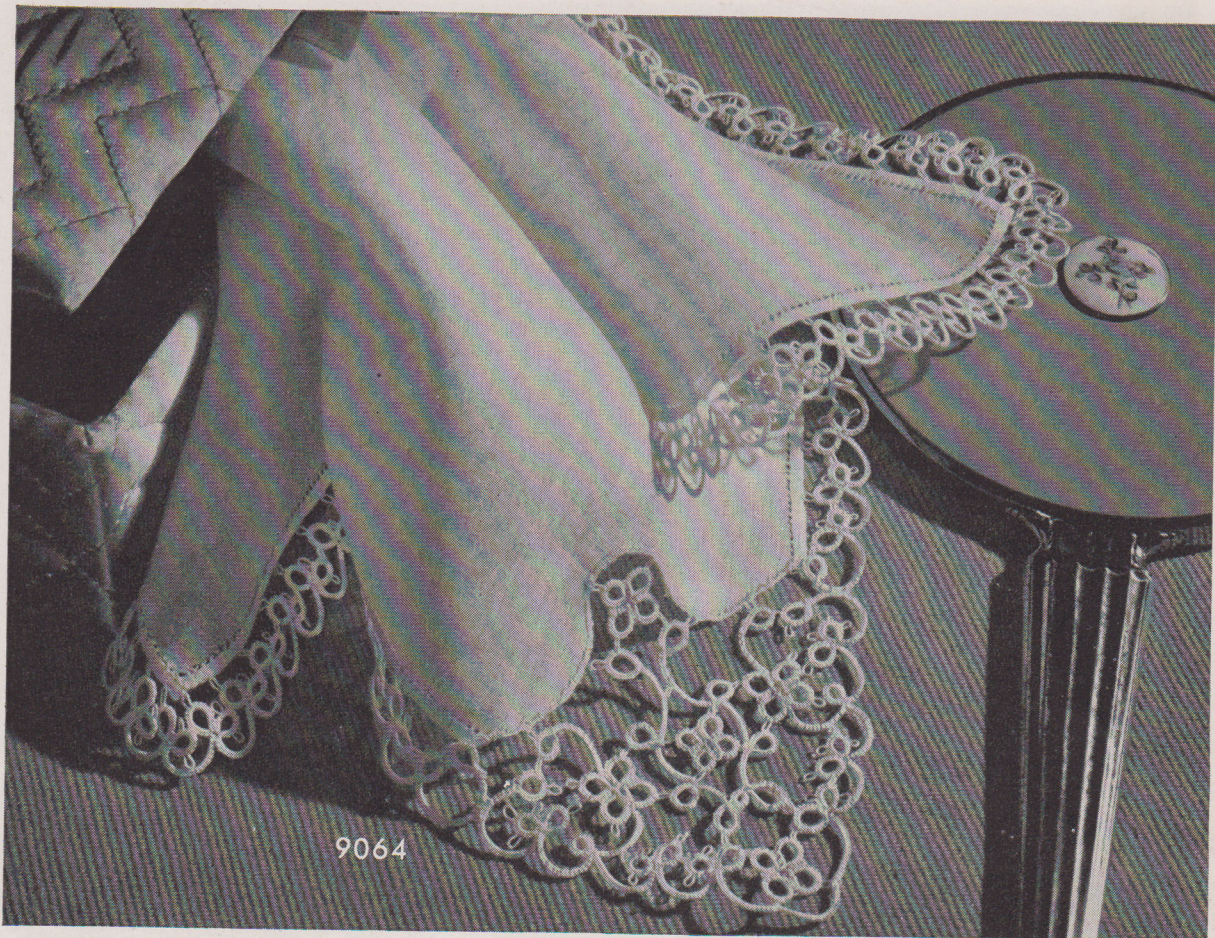
**1st row:** Sr of 2 ds, 5 sm p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, \*\* r of 5 ds, join to next-to-last sm p on preceding sr, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, sm p, 5 ds, cl. Sp of  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch, make a flower as follows: R of 2 ds, sm p, 5 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 5 ds, sm p, 2 ds, close to within  $\frac{1}{16}$  inch (this closing will be referred to as "part cl"). \* R of 2 ds, join to last sm p of preceding r, (5 ds, sm p) twice, 2 ds, part cl. Repeat from \* 2 more times. R of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 5 ds, sm p, 5 ds, join to 1st sm p of 1st r of flower, 2 ds, part cl. Join to base of 1st r of flower. Join thread to sm p joining 1st and 5th r's of flower. Sp of  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch, r of

5 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, sm p, 5 ds, cl. Sp of  $\frac{1}{4}$  inch, r of 2 ds, sm p, 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 2 ds, 3 sm p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Repeat from \*\* for length desired, ending with a sr. Now work along edge of 1st row as follows: **2nd row:** \* Sp of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch, join thread to sp at base of next r. R of 10 ds, sm p, 6 ds, cl and tie over closing, drawing thread through between the 2 sp-threads just preceding the r. Sp of  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch, r of 3 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 7 ds, p, 7 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl. Sp of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch and join to base of next r of 1st row. R of 6 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 10 ds, cl and tie. Sp of  $\frac{3}{8}$  inch and join to base of next sr. Repeat from \* across. Tie and cut.

### No. 9076 . . . MATERIALS: J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, Size 70.

**1st row:** Tie ball and shuttle threads together. \*\* Sr of 3 ds, 6 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, 9 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, sm p, 3 ds. Rw, sp of  $\frac{1}{8}$  inch, lr of 3 ds, sm p, 3 ds, 7 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl. \* Lr of 3 ds, join to last sm p of preceding r, 3 ds, 7 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl and tie to base of preceding r. Repeat from \* once more. Lr of 3 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 3 ds, 7 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to 1st sm p of 1st lr, 3 ds, cl and tie to base of preceding r. Tie thread over the closing of 1st r to complete circle and carry thread to sm p joining the 1st and 4th lr's and fasten (clover made). Rw, ch of 3 ds, join to sm p of preceding ch, 3 ds, 9 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds (scallop complete). Rw, repeat from \*\* for length desired, ending with a sr and allowing  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches for each scallop. Rw, ch of 3 ds, 12 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Now work along edge of 1st row as follows: **2nd row:** Rw, r of 4 ds, join to next-to-last p of last sr of 1st row, 6 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 4th p of adjacent r of next clover, 7 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, 5 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to 4th p of next r of same clover, \* 3 ds, 9 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to 4th p of next r of same clover, 3 ds, p, 6 ds, join to 2nd p of next sr, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding ch, (3 ds, p) twice, 3 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to next-to-last p of last sr, 6 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 4th p of adjacent r of next clover, 7 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding ch, 3 ds, 4 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to 4th p of next r of same clover. Repeat from \* across, ending with ch of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding ch, 11 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Tie to base of 1st sr made and cut.

**No. 9064 . . . MATERIALS:** J. & P. COATS TATting-CROCHET, *Size 70, 2 balls . . . Handkerchief.*

**CORNER . . .** First make the 5 flower motifs. R of 3 ds, sm p, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl. R of 3 ds, join to last sm p of preceding r, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl. Make 2 more r's the same way, joining the last sm p of the 4th r to the 1st sm p of the 1st r. Tie and cut—a small flower made. R of 4 ds, sm p, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Make 3 more r's same as this, joining them as r's of small flower were joined—a large flower made. Tie and cut. Make 3 more large flowers. Next make a scroll. Beginning at the inner corner, tie ball and shuttle threads together. R of 7 ds, join to p of 1st large flower, 5 ds, p, 12 ds, cl. R w and, curving ch away from flower, make ch of 9 ds, p, 11 ds. R w, r of 14 ds, join to p of 2nd large flower, 6 ds, cl. Join to p of small flower. Reversing curve of ch, ch of 14 ds, join to next p of small flower, r of 6 ds, join to next p of 2nd large flower, 14 ds, cl. R w, ch of 9 ds. R w, r of 12 ds, p, 12 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, sm p, 6 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Make another scroll to correspond on the other side of this piece, joining to next p on the 1st large flower, then joining the 1st ch of the 2nd scroll to the p in the 1st ch of the 1st scroll. Join 3rd large flower

to correspond with 2nd large flower. End by fastening the last ch of the 2nd scroll to the sm p of the last r on the 1st scroll. R of 12 ds, p, 12 ds, cl. Tie and cut.

**SIDE SCROLL . . .** R of (5 ds, p) twice, 10 ds, cl. R w, ch of 18 ds and fasten to sm p between the 2 inner r's of the 2nd large flower. Carry thread on wrong side of work to the opposite p, fasten and make ch of 12 ds, p, 6 ds. R w, r of 16 ds, cl. R w, ch of 20 ds. R w, r of 10 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl. R of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 2 ds, (p, 4 ds) 3 times, cl. R w, ch of 20 ds, sm p, 4 ds, sm p, 6 ds. R of 10 ds, p, 4 ds, join to 2nd p of 1st r of this scroll, 6 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Make another Side Scroll to correspond on other side. To complete corner, fasten ball and shuttle threads to sp at base of the r of 16 ds on the 1st Side Scroll. Ch of 20 ds. R w, r of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to p in 2nd ch of Side Scroll, 4 ds, p, 2 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl. R of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 8 ds, (p, 5 ds) twice, cl. R w, ch of 20 ds. R w, r of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 2 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl. R of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 4 ds, join to p on last r of 1st scroll, 4 ds, join to a p of the remaining large flower, 10 ds, cl. R w, (ch of 20 ds, join to p in next r of

same flower) twice, ch of 20 ds. R w, r of 10 ds, join to last p on same flower, 4 ds, join to p in last r of 2nd scroll, 4 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl. R of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 2 ds, 3 p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. R w, ch of 20 ds. R w, r of 5 ds, join to 2nd p of preceding r, 5 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl. To complete the corner and start the edging, r of (5 ds, p) twice, 10 ds, cl. Ch of 4 ds, join to 2nd sm p of last ch of Side Scroll, 4 ds, join to 1st sm p of same ch, 20 ds. R of 10 ds, join to 2nd p of preceding r, 8 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl. \* R of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 2 ds, (p, 4 ds) 3 times, cl. R w, ch of 20 ds. R w, r of 5 ds, join to 2nd p of preceding r, 5 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl. For edge, repeat from \* for required length. Finish with a ch of 20 ds, join to sm p of Side Scroll, 4 ds, join to next sm p, 4 ds. R of 10 ds, join to p of preceding r, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, cl.

Baste corner to handkerchief, mark material with a pencil just touching picots and work buttonhole stitch over this line, catching in corresponding picots. Cut away material from under corner.

Leave all thread-ends long enough to be threaded into a needle and, after motif has been basted to towel, pull the thread ends through to the wrong side and fasten securely.

**SPRAY . . .** Begin design with Large Flower at center. Using Yellow, tie ball and shuttle threads together. R of 4 ds, sm p, 2 ds, 6 lp's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, sm p, 2 ds, 6 lp's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 5 ds, join by shuttle thread to last sm p of r, 5 ds, sm p, \* 5 ds, 3 p's sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, join to center sm p of r, 5 ds, 3 p's sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, sm p, 5 ds, join by shuttle thread to 1st sm p of r, 5 ds and fasten at base of r. This completes the 1st petal. Rw, make another r. Rw, ch of 5 ds, join by shuttle thread to last sm p of preceding r, 5 ds, join to sm p of preceding ch. Repeat from \* once more. Complete the 3rd petal in the same manner as the 2nd petal and make the 4th petal like the others, joining it by the last p in the ch to the 1st petal. Tie and cut.

**MEDIUM FLOWER . . .** With Fuchsia, make r of 4 ds, sm p, 8 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to last sm p of preceding r, 8 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Make 3 more r's same as last r. R of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 8 ds, join to p at left center of ch on Large Flower, 8 ds, join to 1st sm p of 1st r, 4 ds, cl, tie and cut. Make another Medium Flower with Fuchsia and join in the same way to center p on left part of ch on Large Flower, having a whole petal of Large Flower free between Medium Flowers. Make another Medium Flower with Turquoise and join it to the center p on right part of ch of next petal on Large Flower.

**SMALL FLOWER . . .** With Fuchsia, r of 4 ds, sm p, 8 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 8 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Make another r same as last r. R of 4 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 8 ds, join to 1st p of 1st r, 4 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Make another flower same as this, using Turquoise.

**STEMS AND LEAVES . . .** First make the stem and leaf at the top of the Large Flower. Use Green ball and shuttle threads fastened together and to the p between the 4th and 1st petals of the Large Flower. Ch of 5 ds, r of 15 ds, p, 15 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Next, fasten ball and shuttle threads to center p of next ch to the right of stem and

leaf just made, ch of 3 ds, fasten to p joining adjacent r's of the Medium Fuchsia Flower. Carry threads on wrong side of work to p joining the 3rd and 4th r's of the same flower, ch of 6 ds. R of 14 ds, p, 14 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Now fasten ball and shuttle threads to p between next 2 r's of same flower, ch of 5 ds. R of 14 ds, p, 14 ds, cl. Rw and make another r in the same way. Ch of 9 ds, join to p between r's of Small Turquoise Flower, carry threads on wrong side of work to p between opposite 2 r's of same flower. Ch of 5 ds. R of 14 ds, p, 14 ds, cl. Tie and cut. For the lower spray, begin with the stem and leaf to the left of the long spray. Using Green as before, tie ball and shuttle threads together and fasten to 1st p of ch in 3rd petal of Large Flower, ch of 10 ds, fasten to 1st free p of Fuchsia Medium Flower, r of 14 ds, p, 14 ds, cl. Tie and cut. For the long spray, fasten ball and shuttle threads to p joining the next 2 petals of the Large Flower. Curving chain to left, ch of 9 ds, join to 1st free p of Turquoise Medium Flower. Reverse curve and make a ch of 18 ds. R of 14 ds, p, 14 ds, cl. Make another r the same way. Reverse curve and make another ch of 10 ds. Make another pair of r's like those just made. Reverse curve, make a ch of 10 ds, join to p between the 2 r's of the Fuchsia Small Flower. Carry thread to p between opposite 2 r's, fasten. Ch of 5 ds. R of 14 ds, p, 14 ds, cl. Tie and cut. For the 3rd spray, fasten ball and shuttle threads to last p of ch of 2nd petal of Large Flower, ch of 5 ds, join to p between adjacent r's of the Turquoise Medium Flower. Carry thread to p between opposite 2 r's of same flower, fasten. Ch of 5 ds, r of 14 ds, p, 14 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Pin spray in desired position on towel. Tack all picots to towel.

**No. 9109 . . . MATERIALS:** J. & P. COATS TATTING-CROCHET, *Size 70, 1 ball each of Shaded Pinks and Shaded Greens and a few yards of Yellow . . . Fingertip towel.*

**FLOWER CENTER . . .** With Yellow, r of 1 ds, 5 sm p's sep by 2 ds, 1 ds, cl. Tie and cut.

**FLOWER PETALS . . .** Attach Pink ball and shuttle to a p of Flower Center, ch of 3 ds, sm p, 8 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 3 ds. \* Draw shuttle thread tight to form loop and fasten to next p of Flower Center. Ch of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding ch, 8 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 3 ds. Repeat from \* around, joining last ch to 1st p on 1st ch. Tie and cut.

**SMALL STEM AND LEAF . . .** Attach Green ball and shuttle to join-

ing p between petals of flower, make a ch of 4 ds. R of 12 ds, p, 12 ds, cl. Tie and cut.

**LARGE STEM AND LEAVES . . .** Attach Green ball and shuttle to 2nd joining p to the left of Small Stem and Leaf, make a ch of 14 ds. R of 12 ds, join to p of next petal, 12 ds, cl. Rw, r of 12 ds, p, 12 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 15 ds, p, 12 ds. R of 12 ds, join to p of next petal, 12 ds, cl. Rw, r of 12 ds, p, 12 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 12 ds, r of 12 ds, p, 12 ds, cl. Tie and cut.

Draw a 2-inch triangle on fingertip towel, arrange and sew flower and leaves as in illustration so that picots touch the lines of the triangle. Finish by working buttonhole stitch over line, catching in the picots.

Ch of 3 ds, join by shuttle thread to last p of last r, 1 ds, join by ball thread to last sm p of preceding ch, 6 ds, join by ball thread to next p of same ch, 12 ds, join by shuttle thread to next p of last r, 6 ds, p, (6 ds, sm p) twice, 1 ds, join by shuttle thread to next p of same r, 3 ds, fasten at base of r. Repeat from \* 2 more times, joining last p's of last ch to free p's of 1st ch. Tie and cut, leaving a length for sewing.

**SMALL FLOWER . . .** With Pink, make r of 3 ds, sm p, 9 ds, join to a free p on Large Flower, 9 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl. \* R of 3 ds, join to last p of last r, 9 ds, p, 9 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl and tie. Repeat from \* 4 more times, joining last p of last r to 1st p of 1st r. Tie and cut, leaving a length for sewing. Make another Small Flower, using Yellow and joining it to next free p on Large Flower (to the right of Pink Flower).

Cut away the material from under the tatting. Finish napkins same as place mat on smaller scale required.

R w, r of 3 ds, 3 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 6 ds. R w, r of 3 ds; 3 p's sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. Work long side as follows: \*\* Rw, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Repeat from \*\* 9 more times. Rw, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Make other end as follows: Rw, r of 4 ds, lp, 4 ds, cl. (Rw, ch of 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 2 ds; rw, r of 4 ds, join to lp of this end r, 4 ds, cl) twice. Work along opposite side as follows: Rw, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to corresponding p on long side of oval, 4 ds, cl. Continue thus across, joining last ch to base of 1st r. Tie and cut.  
**2nd rnd:** R of 4 ds, join to 1st p on 1st ch of previous rnd, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of (2 ds, p) twice, 2 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to next p on same ch, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of (2 ds, p) twice, 2 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to 1st p on next ch, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of (2 ds, p) twice, 2 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to next p on same ch, 4 ds, cl—end completed. \* Rw, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to p on next ch, 4 ds, cl. Repeat from \* across to opposite end. Work other end and opposite side to correspond, joining last ch to base of 1st r. Tie and cut.  
**3rd rnd:** R of 4 ds, join to 1st p on 1st ch of last rnd, 4 ds, cl. \* Rw, ch of (2 ds, p) 3 times, 2 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to next p on same ch, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of (3 ds, p) twice, 3 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to 1st p on next ch. Repeat from \* 2 more times. \*\* Rw, ch of (2 ds, p) 3 times, 2 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to p on next ch. Repeat from \*\* to opposite end. Work other end and opposite side to correspond, joining last ch to base of 1st r. Tie and cut.  
**4th rnd:** R of 2 ds, join to any p on 3rd rnd, 2 ds, cl. \* Sp of 1 inch, r of 2 ds, join to next p, 2 ds, cl. Repeat from \* around. Hereafter mark the end of each rnd.  
**5th rnd:** \* Sp of 1 inch, r of 2 ds, join to thread between next 2 r's on previous rnd, 2 ds, cl. Repeat from \* around.  
**6th to 9th rnds incl:** Repeat 5th rnd, making the sp between r's 1/4 inch longer on each successive rnd. Tie and cut at end of 9th rnd. Starch and press.

join to last p of last r, 12 ds. Join between the 2 petals, following joining of Pink and Lavender flowers. This completes 1st unit. For 2nd unit carry thread across back and fasten between 2 petals directly opposite. Ch of 12 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to adjacent p of Pink flower, 10 ds, p, 14 ds, cl. Rw, r of 14 ds, p, 10 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, join to last p of last r, 14 ds. R of 9 ds, join to p on Yellow flower preceding

joining of Yellow and Lavender flowers, 5 ds, p, 14 ds, cl. Tie and cut, leaving a length for sewing. Attach Green to center top of petal directly opposite start of 1st unit of stems and leaves and work 3rd unit to correspond with 1st unit. For 4th unit, carry thread across back and fasten between 2 petals directly opposite. Ch of 10 ds, r of 12 ds, p, 12 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Outline a 2-inch circle in center of one end of towel. Arrange piece inside this circle, tacking with threads left for this purpose. With Green work buttonhole stitch over circle, catching those picots which touch circle.

2 ds, cl. Repeat from \* until Side Edge measures 7 3/4 inches. Make another 3-r motif as follows: Sp of 1/4 inch, r of 4 ds, join to next-to-last p of preceding r, 8 ds, (p, 4 ds) twice, sm p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 6 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 6 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, (4 ds, p) twice, 12 ds, cl. Cut and tie. Make another strip the same way for the other side.

To join the End Motif to the Side Edge, r of 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to 3rd p on 1st r of 3-r motif of Side Edge, 2 ds, 5 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Sp of 1/4 inch, r of 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 2 ds, 5 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Sp of 1/4 inch, r of 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to 1st p of 8th r of end spray, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to 1st p of adjacent r of same spray, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl. Sp of 1/4 inch, rw, r of 2 ds, 5 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to 1st p on 2nd r of 3-r motif of

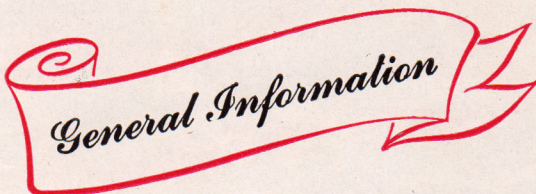
Side Edge, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl. Sp of 1/4 inch, r of 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to 2nd p of same r of 3-r motif, 2 ds, 5 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Sp of 1/4 inch, rw, r of (2 ds, p) twice, 2 ds, join to 3rd p of 6th r of spray, 2 ds, join to last p of adjacent r of spray, 2 ds, 3 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Sp of 1/4 inch, r of 2 ds, join to next-to-last p on preceding r, 2 ds, 6 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Sp of 1/4 inch and make another r the same way. Sp of 1/4 inch, r of 2 ds, join to next-to-last p on preceding r, 2 ds, 4 p's sep by 2 ds, 2 ds, join to 1st p on 3rd r of 3-r motif on Side Edge, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, cl. Cut and tie. Make 3 more joinings same as this.

Baste tatting to linen and mark linen with pencil just touching the picots on the inner edge. Buttonhole stitch over pencil-mark, catching in picots. Cut away material from under tatting.

of 4th-from-last r, (5 ds, p) twice, 5 ds. \* Rw, r of 5 ds, 5 p's sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl. Ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Rw, r of (5 ds, p) twice, 5 ds, join to 3rd p of next-to-last r, (5 ds, p) twice, 5 ds, cl. Make another r of 5 ds, 5 p's sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to 4th p of 3rd-from-last r, (5 ds, p) twice, 5 ds. Repeat from \* around handkerchief, at the end finishing the other side of the corner with a group of 3 r's and a ch to correspond with 1st half.

Sew edging around handkerchief in usual way and, after basting corners in place, draw line on material just touching picots and buttonhole over line, catching in picots. Cut away material beneath corner motif.
