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

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INSTRUCTIONS for STOLE, SHRUG and HANDBAG and 3 SHAPES of DAISIES - SEE PAGES 2 and 3

No. 1-DAISY STOLE

4-ply Knitting Worsted: nine 2-oz. skeins White and two 1-oz. skeins Peacock Blue. Plastic crochet hook size F-5.

CRAZY DAISY WINDER

SIZE - 21" x 76" without fringe.

DAISY: Following instructions on page 4, Illustration B, wind White yarn once around each spoke of Winder. Cut 1" long and weave center with Blue yarn (see Ill. E), making a 12-petal flower with 1 lp in each petal. Make 355 for Stole.

BLOCK: In White, sc in one petal, (ch 2, sc in next petal) 11 times, ch 2, join with sl st in 1st sc. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

2d BLOCK: In White, sc in one petal of another Daisy, * keeping lp on hook, insert hook in 1 sc on 1st Block, Y O and draw thru sc and lp on hook (sl st made), ch 2, sc in next petal on 2d Daisy, sl st in next sc on 1st Block, (ch 2, sc in next petal on 2d Daisy) 10 times, ch 2, join with sl st in 1st sc and fasten off.


3d BLOCK: Repeat 2d Block to *; sl st in 2d sc to left of joining of 1st 2 Blocks, ch 2, sc in next petal of 3d Daisy, sl st in next sc to right toward joining of 1st 2 Blocks, ch 2, sc in next petal of 3d Daisy, sl st in 1st sc on next Block to right of joining, ch 2, sc in next petal of 3d Daisy, sl st in next sc to right on previous Block, (ch 2, sc in next petal on 3d Daisy) 8 times, ch 2, join to 1st sc and fasten off. Continue to join Blocks as in Chart; Center row lengthwise — 35 Blocks;

next row on each side — 34 Blocks; next row on each side — 32 Blocks; next row on each side — 32 Blocks; next row on each side — 31 Blocks; and final row on each side — 30 Blocks.

EDGE: Attach White yarn with sc in 2d ch-2 sp on center Block at one end of Stole, ch 2, sc in same sp (shell made), (in next sp make a shell of sc, ch 2, sc) 4 times, * sc in next sp, holding back the last lp of each dc on hook make dc in same sp, dc in 1st ch-2 sp on next Block, Y O and draw thru all 3 lps on hook at same time (Cluster-decrease made), sc in same sp, (sc, ch 2, sc) in next 3 sps; repeat from * around with 5 shells around the Block at each corner of Stole. Join and fasten off.

FRINGE: Wind White yarn around a 6" cardboard. Cut at one edge. Hold 3 strands tog, fold in center, insert crochet hook up from underneath thru one shell on one end of Stole, catch lp of strands and pull thru, pass ends thru lp and pull tight. Tie 3-strand fringe in 5 shells around center Block on one end and in 3 shells on 5 Blocks on each side of center Block. Repeat on other end.

Stretch and pin Stole right-sidedown in true shape. Steam and press dry thru a folded cloth. Trim Fringe to an even length.



No. 2-DAISY SHRUG AND HANDBAG

4-ply Knitting Worsted: six 2-oz. skeins White for Shrug and 3 for Bag; and one 1-oz. skein Watermelon Red each for Shrug and Bag.

Plastic crochet hook size F-5.

CRAZY DAISY WINDER

DAISY: Following instructions on page 4, Illustration B, wind White yarn once around each spoke of Winder. Cut 1" long and weave center with Red yarn (see Ill. E), making a 12-petal flower with 1 lp in each petal.

BLOCK: In White, sc in one petal, (ch 2, sc in next petal) 11 times, ch 2, join with sl st in 1st sc. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

2d BLOCK: In White, sc in one petal of another Daisy, * ch 1, keeping lp on hook, insert hook in a ch-2 sp on 1st Block, Y O and draw thru lp on hook (sl st made), ch 1, sc in next petal on 2d Daisy, ch 1, sl st in next ch-2 sp on 1st Block, ch 1, sc in next petal on 2d Daisy, (ch 2, sc in next petal) 9 times, ch 2, join with sl st in 1st sc and fasten off.

3d BLOCK: Repeat 2d Block to *; ch 1, sl st in 2d ch-2 sp to left of joining of 1st 2 Blocks, ch 1, sc in next petal of 3d Daisy, ch 1, sl st in next ch-2 sp to right toward joining of 1st 2 Blocks, ch 1, sc in next petal on 3d Daisy, ch 1, sl st in 1st ch-2 sp on next Block to right of joining, ch 1, sc in next petal on 3d Daisy, ch 1, sl st in next ch-2 sp to right, ch 1, sc in next petal on 3d Daisy, ch 2, sc in next petal) 7 times, ch 2, join to 1st sc and fasten off.

SHRUG (SIZE - medium): Make and join 170 Daisy Blocks as in Chart. Join Block C on Chart to 2 Blocks D on end of each sleeve. To fill out bottom corners of Back marked B, attach White yarn with sc in 2d ch-2 sp up right-hand Block, ch 2, dc in next sp, ch 1, dc down in joining of Blocks drawing it up to level of previous dc for a long dc, ch 1, dc in 1st ch-2 sp on next Block, ch 2, sc in next sp. Fasten off. Repeat on opposite corner.

HALF-BLOCKS: To fill in 14 spaces marked with dotted lines on Chart, attach White yarn to 1st ch-2 sp up right side of one space, ch 3, sc in 1st ch-2 sp on Block at bottom of space, draw out 1p on hook 1" long, Y O and draw thru 1p, insert hook between single back strand and 2 front strands, Y O and draw thru, Y O and draw thru the 2 lps on hook to complete sc (1 Knot St made). Make a 2d Knot St, sc in next sc on same Block, make 2 Knot Sts, sc in next ch-2 sp on same Block, ch 3, sc in 1st ch-2 sp on next Block on left side of space. Fasten off. Repeat in remaining 13 spaces.

BAND: Attach White yarn with sc in center ch-2 sp on Block marked A at back of neck, ** ch 1, dc in next ch-2 sp, dc down in ch-3 sp at start of next Half-Block drawing this dc up to height of Knot Sts (a long dc), * sc between 2d & 3d strands of next double Knot St, sc between next 2d & 3d strands of same Knot Sts, * ch 2, repeat from * to *; long dc down in final ch-3 sp of Half-Block, dc in 1st ch-2 sp on next Block, ch 1, sc in next sp, ** (ch l, dc in next sp, ch l, long dc down in joining of Blocks, ch l, dc in 1st ch-2 sp on next Block) twice, ch l, sc in next sp, repeat from ** to **; (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice. PATTERN: Ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1, long dc down in joining of Blocks, ch 1, dc in 1st ch-2 sp of next Block, ch 1, sc in next sp, ch 2, sc in next sp (1 PATTERN made); make 2 more PATTERNS, (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice, make 2 PATTERNS (see italics above), ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next (corner) sp, ch 1, sc in next sp, ch 2, sc in next sp, repeat from ** to **; ch 2, sc in next sp, repeat from ** to **; make 3 PATTERNS (see italics above) making final sc in sc on Block C. Turn and working down to B corner, ch 2, sc in next ch-2 sp on next Block, ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1, long dc in joining of Blocks, ch 1, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, sc in next sp, ch 2, sc in next sp, ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1, long dc in joining of Blocks, ch l, dc in next ch-2 sp, ch l, sc in next sp, (repeat from ** to **; ch 2, sc in next sp)

twice, *** ch 1, dc in 1st sp on corner B pattern, ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next long dc, (ch 1, dc in next sp) twice, ch 1, sc in 1st ch-2 sp on next Block, *** ch 2, sc in next sp, (repeat from ** to **; ch 2, sc in next sp, repeat from *** to ***; (ch 2, sc in next sp, repeat from ** to ***) twice, make 2 PATTERNS (see italics above) putting final sc in sc on Block C. Turn and working along sleeve to corner of Front, (ch 2, sc in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1, long dc in joining of Blocks, ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1, sc in next sp) 3 times, (repeat from ** to **; ch 2, sc in next sp) twice, ch 1, (dc, ch 3, dc) in next (corner) sp, ch 1, sc in next sp, ch 2, sc in next sp, make 2 PATTERNS (see italics), (ch 2, sc in next sp) twice, make 3 PATTERNS (see

italics), ch 2, sc in next sp, repeat from ** to **; ch 1, dc in next sp, ch 1, long dc in joining of Blocks, (ch 1, dc in next sp) twice, ch 1, long dc in joining of Blocks, ch l, dc in next sp, ch l, join to 1st sc with sl st. Drop but do not cut. Fold Shrug wrong-side-out and sew underarm seams, going thru 1 lp of each st. Turn right-side-out. BAND RND 2: Ch 1, sc in same sc with sl st, mark this 1st sc with a pin, (ch 1, sk 1 st, sc in next st, ch 1, sc in next st) repeated around. Do not join rnds. End with ch 1, sc in back lp of 1st sc. RND (Ch 1, sc in back lp of next sc) repeated around. RND 4: Repeat Rnd 3 but make 6 increases around the curve of each Front: To increase, ch 1, sc thru 2 lps of next ch-1, ch 1, sc in back lp of next sc. RNDS 5 & 6: Repeat Rnd 3 twice. RND 7: (Ch 1, sl st in back lp of next sc) repeated around, join and fasten off. CUFF: Attach White with sc in 3d ch-2 sp on 1 Block.

lp of 1st sc. RNDS 3 thru 6: Repeat Rnd 3 of Band 4 times. RND 7: Repeat Rnd 7 of Band. Repeat CUFF on other sleeve.

Fold Shrug flat, stretch and pin it down on a padded board in desired size. Steam and press dry thru a folded cloth.

make 5 PATTERNS (see italics) around sleeve, join to 1st sc. RND 2: Ch 1, sc in same sc, * (ch 1, sk 1

st, sc in next st) twice, ch l, sc in next st; repeat from

* around. Do not join rnds. End with ch 1, sc in back

HANDBAG: Follow directions for Daisy Blocks for Shrug except wind yarn twice around each spoke making 12-petal Daisies with 2 ps in each petal, see Ill. C on Page 4. Make and join 77 Daisy Blocks

as in Chart. Fold work crosswise in center as marked.

EDGE: Attach White yarn to joining of Blocks at A
and working thru both sides of bag, * make sc, ch 2,

sc shell in next 4 ch-2 sps, holding back the last lp of each dc on hook make dc in next ch-1 sp, dc in next ch-1 sp on next Block, Y O and draw thru all 3 lps

on hook (Cluster-decrease); repeat from * 3 times. Separate 2 halves of Bag and working around top of front half, make a shell in next 6 ch-2 sps, a 2-dc Cluster-dec in angle, a shell in next 4 ch-2 sps, a dec in angle, a shell in next 6 ch-2 sps, a dec in angle, a shell in next 2 ch-2 sps, a dec in angle, a shell in next 6 ch-2 sps, a dec in angle, a shell in next 4 ch-2 sps, a dec in angle, a shell in next 6 ch-2 sps, hold left



Repeat around other half of top. Sew ends tog at end of crochet and trim ends into 3/4" pom pon. Make a 2d Tie and thread thru Bag from opposite side. Line Bag up to Ties with White felt. FRONTS



CRAZY DAISY DIAMOND BLOCKS

Repeat Square Block to *; wrap around Nos. 5 and 6 spokes once more; wrap twice around Nos. 7 and 8 spokes; twice around Nos. 9 and 10 and twice around Nos. 11 and 12. Cut and make Center before removing Daisy from Winder (see Ill. E).

EDGE: Attach yarn with sc thru both lps of one long petal, ch 3, sc in same petal, * (ch 3, sc in both lps of next petal) 4 times, ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next long petal, (ch 3, sc in next petal) 4 times, ch 3, join to 1st sc. Cut 6" long and fasten off on back,

2d BLOCK: Repeat to * in EDGE"; (ch 3, sc in next petal) twice, ch 1, sl st in 1 lp of 2d st of center ch-3 sp on 1 side of 1st Block, ch 1, sc in next petal on 2d Daisy, ch 3, sc in next petal, ch 3, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next long petal and complete Block as for 1st Block. Continue to join Blocks at sides into a straight row.

2d ROW: Attach yarn with sc in one long petal of another Daisy, ch 1, sl st in 1 lp of center st of ch-3 top point of 1 Block in 1st Row, ch 1, sc back in same long petal and complete Block. Continue making a straight row of Blocks, joining to each other on sides as in 1st Row and to top points of 1st Row Blocks,

3d ROW: To fill in openings between Rows, attach yarn to one long petal on another Daisy, ch l, sl st in side joining of 2 Blocks in 1 row, ch 1, sc back in same long petal, * (ch l, sl st in next ch-3 sp on next Block ch 1, sc back in next petal) twice, ch 1, sl st in joining of 2 rows of Blocks; ch 1, sc back in next petal, (ch 1, sl st in next ch-3 sp on next Block, ch 1, sc back in next petal) twice, * ch 1, sl st in side joining of 2 Blocks, ch l, sc back in same long petal; repeat from * to *, joining to 1st sc. Fasten off. Fill in each opening in same way. Continue to make and join Blocks for desired size.

CRAZY DAISY SQUARE BLOCKS

With left thumb, hold yarn at center allowing end to extend 1". With right hand, pass yarn from right to left around spokes 3 and 1 (as numbers are printed in Ill. B); across center, from right to left around Nos. 2 and 4; wrap around these 4 spokes once more in same way; across center, from left to right around No. 5; from right to left around No. 6; * around these 2 spokes twice more; hold yarn in center with thumb, wind from right to left around Nos. 9 and 7 spokes; across center and wind from right to left around Nos. 8 and 10; wind around these 4 spokes once more; across center and wind from left to right around No. 11 spoke; across center and wind from right to left around No. 12 spoke; wind around these 2 spokes twice more and cut 1" beyond center. Make Center before removing Daisy from Winder (see Ill. E).

EDGE: Attach yarn with sc thru 2 lps of one long corner petal, ch 3, sc in same petal, * ch 2, sc in a longest lp of 3 lps of next petal, ch 1, sc in shortest lp of same petal, ch 1, sc in 3d lp of same petal, ch 2,

** (sc, ch 3, sc) thru 2 lps of next long petal; repeat from * twice and from * to ** again; join to 1st sc. Cut 6" long, thread to a needle and fasten off on back.

2nd BLOCK: Attach yarn thru 2 lps of one long corner petal, ch 1, keeping lp on hook, insert hook in l lp of center st of ch-3 at a corner of 1st Block, Y O and draw thru it and lp on hook (sl st made), ch 1, sc in same corner lp on 2nd Block, ch 1, sl st in next ch-2 sp on 1st Block, ch 1, sc in longest lp of 3 lps of next petal of 2nd Block, ch 1, sc in shortest lp of same petal, sl st in corresponding center sc on 1st Block, ch 1, sc in 3d lp of same petal of 2d Block, ch 1, sl st in next ch-2 sp on 1st Block, ch 1, sc in both lps of next long corner petal on 2d Block, ch l, sl st in 1 lp of 2d st of ch-3 corner sp on 1st Block, ch 1, sc in same petal on 2d Block. Complete 2d Block as for 1st one. Make 2 more Blocks, joining to each other and to 1st 2 Blocks in same way, joining thru the same corner st at joining of 1st 2 Blocks. Continue to make and join Blocks for desired size.

TO MAKE DAISIES

Illustration A-Back view with spokes released.

See illustration E.

close to center.

Hold winder in left hand with flat side toward you. Holding knob between thumb and fore finger of right hand with thumb at bottom, push thumb to left to turn knob and release spokes.

Illustration B—Single Petal Daisy Wrapped Over 1 Spoke. With left thumb, hold yarn across center of winder leaving end extend about 1 inch beyond center. With right hand, pass yarn from left to right around spoke at top (No. 1); across center of winder from right to left around spoke directly opposite (No. 2), across center of winder from left to right around spoke No. 3 at right of 1st spoke wrapped; across center, from right to left around spoke No. 4 at left of 2nd spoke wrapped; across center, from left to right around spoke No. 5; across center, from right to left around spoke No. 6; and continue in this way wrapping each spoke once, always passing across center to wrap spoke opposite, until the 12th spoke is wrapped. Bring yarn across center and cut end about 1 inch beyond center. Make center before removing daisy from Winder.

Illustration C—Double Petal Daisy Wrapped Over 1 Spoke. With left thumb hold yarn at center leaving end to extend about 1 inch; with right hand, pass yarn from left to right around spoke No. 1 at top; across center; from right to left around spoke No. 2 directly opposite, wrap around these 2 spokes once more in same way; across center, from left to right around spoke No. 3 at right of spoke 1st wrapped; across center, from right to left around spoke No. 4 at left of 2nd spoke wrapped; wrap these 2 spokes once more; across center, from left to right around spoke No. 5; from right to left around spoke No. 6; around these 2 once more; and continue in this way wrapping twice around 2 spokes exactly opposite then passing on to the next 2, until all spokes are wrapped twice ending with No. 12; bring yarn across center and cut end about 1 inch beyond center. If a daisy of more layers of petals is desired, wrap as many times as you desire layers of petals. Make

center before removing daisy from Winder See Illustration E.

Illustration E—Center. Thread needle with yarn for center. Fasten at center of wrong side of daisy as for embroidery. The side of daisy toward you is the wrong side. Insert needle under 4 petals, draw yarn through tightly; bring yarn back over the last 3 of these 4 petals, insert needle under these 3 petals and 1 more making 4 petals in all; draw yarn through, continue to bring yarn back over 3 petals and draw it under 4 petals each time until you have made 13 stitches. Be sure there are 13, otherwise your center will not be complete. As the weaving stitches are worked, be careful to carry around the starting yarn end of Daisy, taking each weaving stitch over this end for at least 10 stitches so as to fasten it securely. This is particularly necessary with all the cotton threads. Fasten yarn on wrong side. Cut off all ends

Turn knob in opposite direction to draw in spokes and release daisy.
