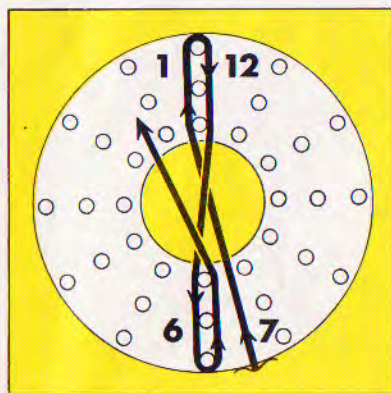
STEMMED FLOWERS — TOTE BAG

Many exciting projects (large and small) can be created by using the MAGNI-FLEUR LOOM. Included in this package are instructions for use of the Magni-Fleur loom, directions for the projects pictured and a needle.

Directions for Basic Flowers



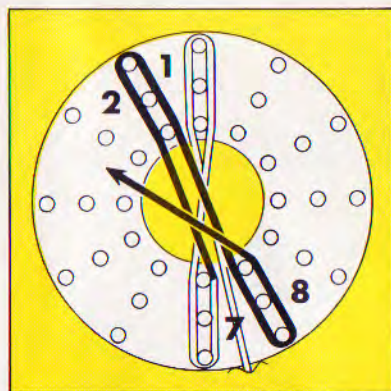
A Holding loom so that space #1 appears at the top, insert end of strand in slot at space #7. Working on outer circle of pegs (row A) only, lay strand across loom to space #1, around outer peg to space #12, down to space #6, and around peg to space #7. Repeat this step four more times around the same pegs for a total of five loops.

B With strand at space #7 (working counter clockwise), lay strand across loom to space #2, around peg to space #1, down to space #7 and around peg to space #8. Repeat this step four more times around the same pegs for a total of five loops.

Continue stringing up the loom, putting five loops on every set of pegs, always moving counter clockwise with each change of position, until strand is at space #6.

Measure off 40 inches on the strand with which you are working and cut, leaving the 40 inch length attached to the flower and insert in slot. This will be used later in stitching center of flower.

C String three loops of fiber on all pegs of middle row (row B), following steps A and B. Cut strand from skein and insert in slot.



D The inner circle of petals is strung on in like manner, using the inner pegs (row C) only. String three loops of fiber on all pegs, following steps A and B. Cut strand from skein and insert in slot.

BASIC TRIPLE (5 1/4") Follow steps A through F.

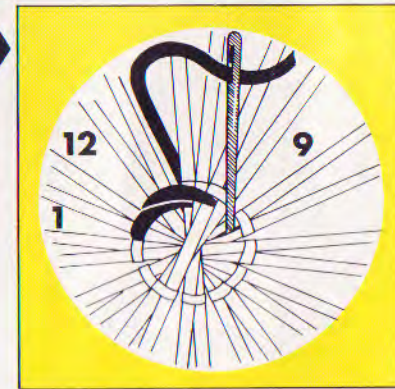
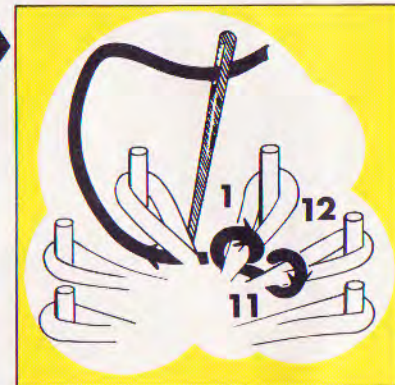
4 more flower sizes may be made on the Magni-Fleur by using the above instructions.

E Thread the 40 inch strand (left on outside row) into a sharp needle (yarn darning 14/18). With strand at space #6, stick needle through space to the back. (Do not pierce strand.) Bring needle up through space #12, pulling tightly against center of flower and down again at space #11. This stitch will form a bar across the spoke. Again moving counter clockwise, bring needle up in space #1 and down in space #12. Continue this backstitch until every spoke has a crossbar, keeping the stitch firm and as close to center as possible. When circle is completed, strand should be at back of loom in space #10.

F The slanted finishing stitch is worked clockwise. Bring needle up at space #1, count 3 spokes to the right (between spaces #11 and #10), then pierce center of spoke below crossbar, pulling needle through to the back. Bring needle up at space #12 and stitch into spoke between spaces #10 and #9. Bring needle up at space #11 and stitch into spoke between spaces #9 and #8. Complete center in this way, taking care to keep strand untwisted for smooth finish. The final two stitches should go under first slanted stitches made instead of through them. Remove flower from loom by gently pulling loops up from pegs.



SINGLE (MEDIUM, ROW B) Middle Circle. Follow steps C, E, & F. If using contrasting color for center, follow step C, cut strand and tape to side of loom. Cut 24" of contrasting color, tape to side of loom at space #6 and follow steps E & F to stitch center.

DOUBLE (LARGE, ROWS A, B) Follow steps A, B, C, E & F. If using contrasting color for center, follow steps A & B, cut strand and tape to side of loom. Cut 24" of contrasting color, tape to side of loom at space #6 and follow steps E & F to stitch center.

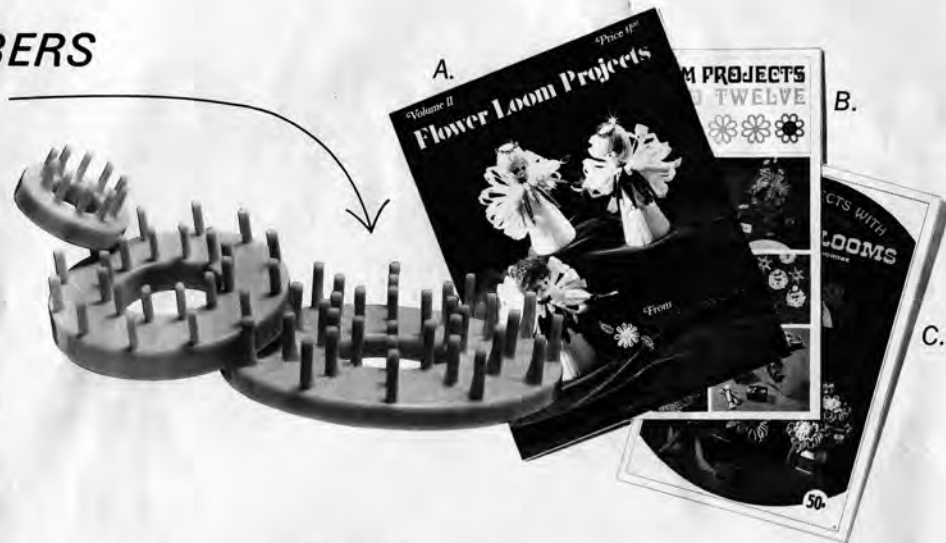

YARDAGE REQUIRED:

BASIC TRIPLE (5¼") 12 yards

POUF CENTER: After completing flower, thread strand of same color yarn through the top 2 loops all around the flower, then draw loops into a pouf as you would a draw string bag; tie a double knot, clip ends and tuck into pouf.



Long Stemmed Flowers

INSTRUCTIONS

SKILL INVOLVED: Basic triple flower and pouf technique*

MATERIALS REQUIRED: Magni-Fleur loom, 3 colors of yarn, 2 colors of straw, #16 stem wire, small piece of felt for leaves, thick white craft glue, ice pick.

CONSTRUCTION:

String 2 loops green yarn on all pegs in row C
String 1 loop green straw on all pegs in row B
String 2 loops green yarn on all pegs in row B
String 2 loops yellow straw on all pegs in row A
String 3 loops yellow yarn on all pegs in row A
String 2 loops brown yarn on all pegs in row C

Stitch flower center with any color.

Remove flower from loom.

LARGE FLOWER

A Pierce flower through center with ice pick and immediately insert stem wire and bend over to make loop on top in center. This holds wire in place.

B The top loops from row C are poufed to cover wire loop. (See directions at side for pouf.) The green yarn on bottom of flower is also poufed to form flower calyx.

C Transfer leaf pattern on felt, and cut. Pierce with ice pick where indicated on leaf pattern and thread onto stem. Bend leaf together at stem and glue leaf to stem (about ½").



SMALL FLOWER

String 2 loops green yarn on all pegs in row C
 String 1 loop green straw on all pegs in row C
 String 1 loop green yarn on all pegs in row C
 String 2 loops yellow straw on all pegs in row B
 String 3 loops yellow yarn on all pegs in row B
 String 2 loops brown yarn on all pegs in row C

Stitch flower center with any color.

Remove flower from loom and insert stem as directed above and pouf top 2 loops and bottom 2 loops.

BUD

String 2 loops green yarn on all pegs in row C
 String 2 loops green straw on all pegs in row C
 String 1 loop green yarn on all pegs in row C
 String 3 loops yellow yarn on all pegs in row B

Stitch flower center with any color.

Remove flower from loom, insert stem wire and pouf all loops in row B to form bud and bottom 2 loops of green yarn to form calyx.

These flowers may be used for a lovely flower arrangement in a bud vase. For a larger bouquet make more flowers in desired color and display in a large vase.

Tote Bag

INSTRUCTIONS

SKILL INVOLVED: Basic triple flower, double flower* and embroidery.

MATERIALS REQUIRED: Magni-Fleur loom, 2 sisal place mats, fringed on ends, 4 colors of straw (1 green), 2 bamboo handles, yarn in color to match place mats, beauty pins (optional)

CONSTRUCTION: Make one basic triple flower and one basic double flower. Plan design to allow for 4" to be turned down at one end of each place mat. Embroider stems and leaves.

Fasten flowers in place with beauty pin (this makes it possible to change flower to match different color schemes if desired), or sew in place from back, through flower centers.

A Turn down 4" hem on each place mat and hold in place with clothespins while sewing mats together with overcast stitch along sides. Use backstitch along bottom.

B Use overcast stitch to sew handles in place.

*Refer to basic triple flower and double flower on reverse side. For pouf technique follow instructions at side of page.
