




B With strand at space #6 (working counter clockwise), lay strand across loom to space #2, around peg to space #1, down to space #6 and around peg to space #7. Repeat this step one more time around the same pegs for a total of 2 loops. Continue around the loom until all 10 pegs hold 2 loops each.


When stitching centers in same color allow an 18" strand. When contrast color is desired for center stitches, substitute a 24" strand. Anchor in slot at side of loom at space #5.




Thread needle. With strand at space #5 stick needle through to the back, through space (do not pierce strand). Bring needle up through space #10, pulling tightly against center of flower and down again at space #9. This stitch will form a bar across the spoke. Again moving counter clockwise, bring needle up in space #1 and down in space #10, pulling tightly against center of flower. Continue this backstitch until every spoke has a crossbar, keeping the stitch firm and as close to center as possible. When circle is completed, strand should be at back of loom in space #8.



The slanted finishing stitch is worked clockwise. Bring needle up at space #1, count 3 spokes to the right (between spaces #9 and #8), then pierce center of spoke below crossbar, pulling needle through to the back. Bring needle up at space #10 and stitch into spoke between spaces #8 and #7. Bring needle up at space #9 and stitch into spoke between spaces #7 and #6. Complete center in this way, taking care to keep strand widened out somewhat for best effect. The final two stitches should go under first slanted stitches made instead of through them.



**SQUARED PETAL:** String fiber around two pegs each time instead of one. Stitch center as directed in steps C and D.

POUF CENTER: After completing flower, thread strand of same color yarn through the top 2 loops all around the flower, then draw loops into a pouf as you would a draw string bag; tie a double knot, clip ends and tuck into pouf.




## Rings and Earclips INSTRUCTIONS

SKILL INVOLVED: Basic flower, squared petal, pouf center\*.

MATERIALS REQUIRED: Mini-Fleur loom, ring backs, ear clips, several colors of straw or yarn in harmonizing colors, thick white craft glue.

CONSTRUCTION: The mini flower is especially suitable for finger rings and ear clips. Follow directions for basic flower or any of the flower directions such as squared petal or pouf center to make flowers, then glue or sew in place to ring backs or ear clips. Flowers made of straw will spark crisp summer costumes, while yarn flowers will harmonize with fall and winter dresses.





SKILL INVOLVED: Basic flower, squared petal, pouf center\*.

MATERIALS REQUIRED: Mini-Fleur loom, wicker plaque (10½", used for paper picnic plates), small piece of colored burlap, styrofoam cup, ornamental leaves, spray paint in desired color, thick white craft glue, several colors of straw.

CONSTRUCTION: Spray wicker plaque desired color and let dry.

A To make tub cut top half off of styrofoam cup, slice off a vertical third from bottom half, and glue burlap to outside section. Follow directions for basic flower or any of the flower directions such as squared petal or pour center to make 19 flowers. Arrange tub and flowers and glue in place. If desired small velvet or felt leaves may be added.



Foot Thongs
INSTRUCTIONS

SKILL INVOLVED: Basic flower\*.

MATERIALS REQUIRED: Mini-Fleur loom, length of 3/4" elastic, length of gold stretch cord, several yards of straw.

CONSTRUCTION: Sew Mini flowers to length of 3/4" elastic. (Measure from ankle to base of center toe for length.) Turn elastic under, stitch at either end to form casing through which gold elastic cord is threaded and tied, hide knot inside casing. (For cord length measure around ankle and center toe, allow for tying.)

\*Refer to basic flower instructions on reverse side. For squared petal and pouf center follow instructions at side of page.
