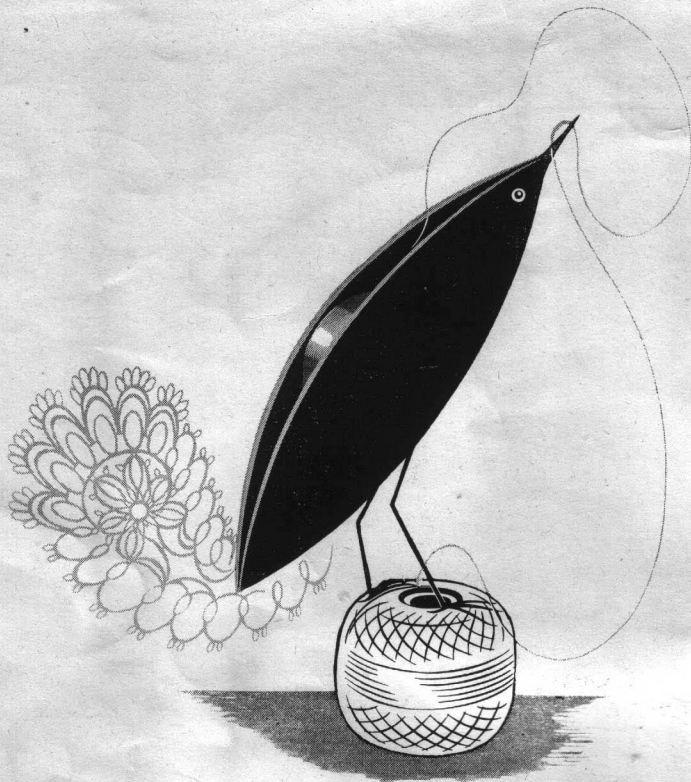

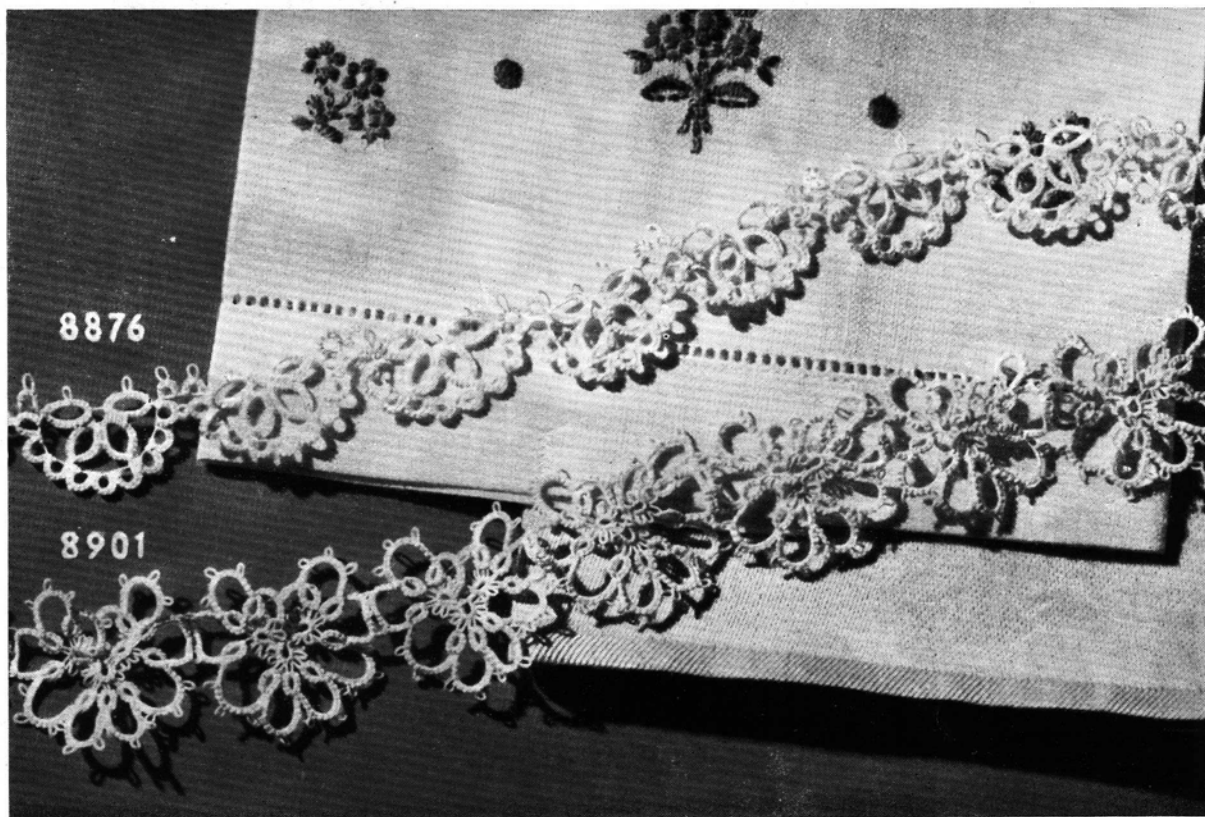

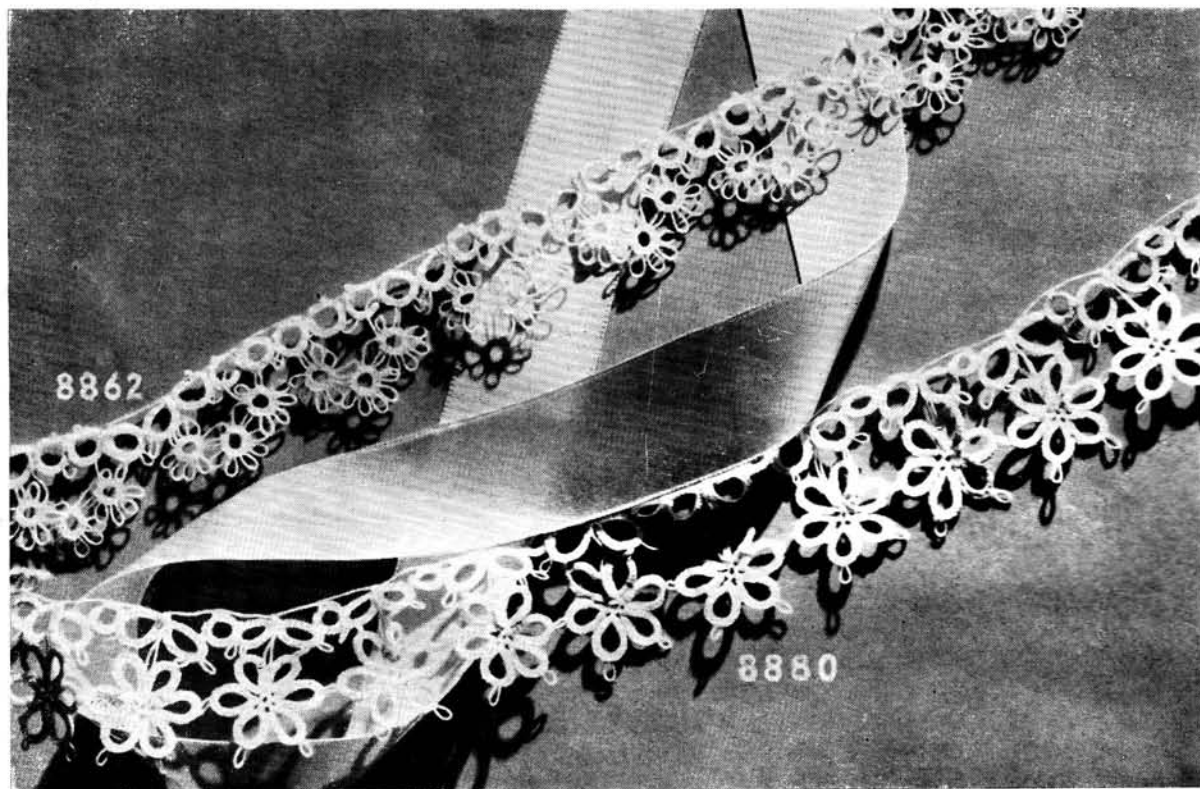

Rw, sr of 5 ds, p, 4 ds, sm p, 1 ds, part cl (that is, leave 1/16 inch sp. at base of r). * (Sr of 1 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 8 ds, sm p, 1 ds, part cl) twice. Rw, lr of 8 ds, join to sm p of preceding lr, 4 ds, join to lp of 1st lr, 4 ds, sm p, 8 ds, cl. Rw, make 3 more sr's as before. Rw, lr of 8 ds, join to sm p of 2nd lr, 4 ds, join to lp of 1st r, 4 ds, sm p, 8 ds, cl. Rw, make 2 more sr's as before. Sr. of 1 ds, join to p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 5 ds, part cl. Rw, lr of 8 ds, join to sm p of 3rd lr, 4 ds, join to lp of 1st r, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. (Sr of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, part cl) twice. Lr of 6 ds, p, 6 ds, lp, 4 ds, sm p, 8 ds, cl. No. 8901 . . . R of 1 ds, 9 p's sep. by 1 ds, cl. *Sr. of 1 ds, join to last p of r just made, 1 ds, 8 p's sep. by 1 ds, cl. Repeat from * once more. Fasten all 3 picot rings together at base. Rw, ch of 6 ds, p, 5 ds. Rw, sr of 5 ds, join to 4th p of preceding r, 5 ds, cl. **Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, sr of 5 ds, join to next p of same picot ring, 5 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, sr of 5 ds, join to next p of same r, 5 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, sr of 5 ds, join to 4th p of next picot ring, 5 ds, cl. This completes one motif. Make as many motifs as desired, joining the 3 p's of the 3rd ch to the 3 p's of corresponding ch on previous motif.

R of 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to adjacent p of 1st r, 2 ds, 5 p's sep. by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. * Sp $\frac{1}{2}$ inch. R of 2 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 2 ds, 6 p's sep. by 2 ds, 2 ds, cl. Repeat from * once more. Rw, sp $\frac{1}{2}$ inch. R of 4 ds, sm p, 8 ds, join to free p of 2nd r, 6 ds, join to next sm p of 2nd r, 2 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. R w, ch of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding ch, 3 ds, join to next p of same ch, 4 ds, 8 p's sep. by 1 ds, 4

ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds. R w, r of 12 ds, join to p of last r, 4 ds, p, 8 ds, cl. Repeat from * for length desired.

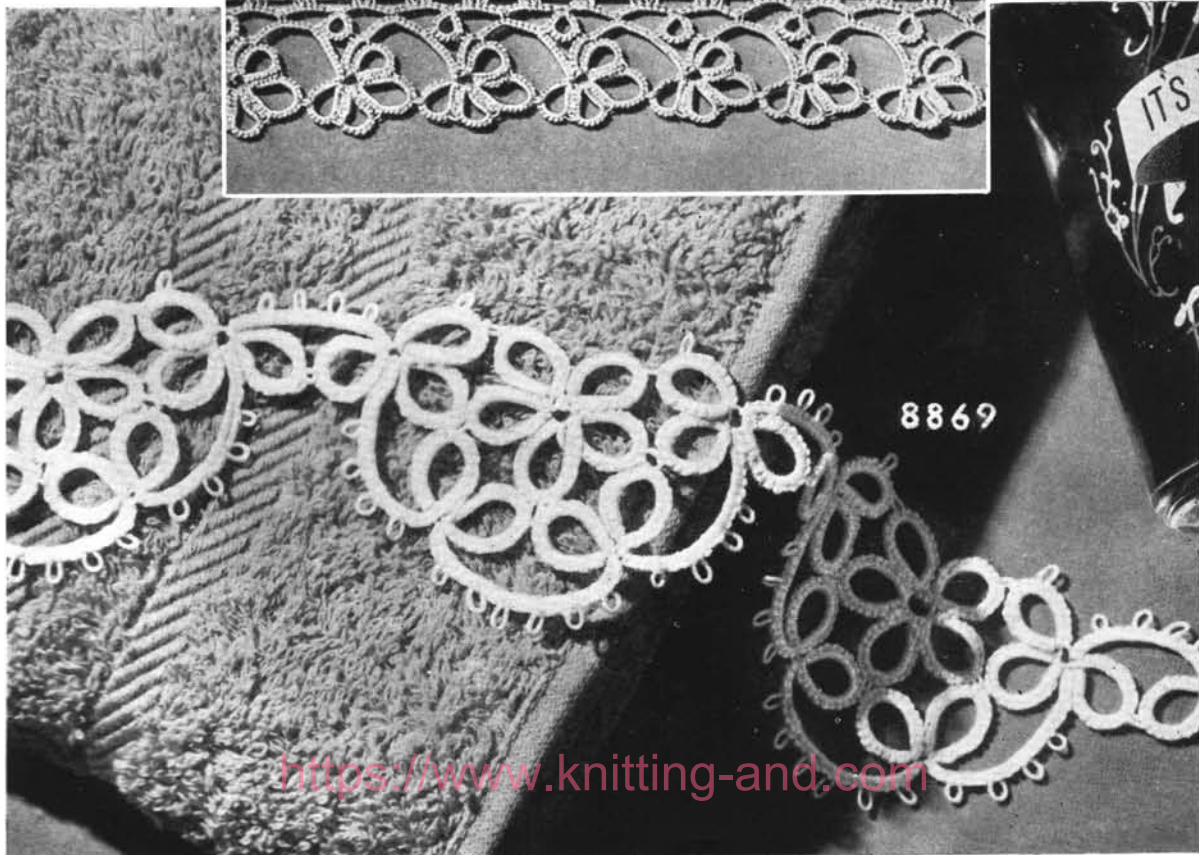
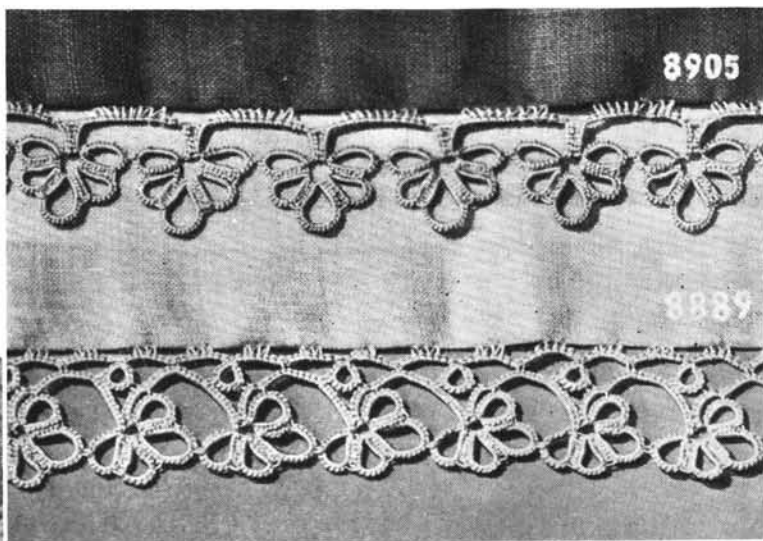

Then rw, r of 3 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 6 ds, join to p on corresponding ch of adjacent group, 6 ds. Repeat from * for length desired.

No. 8866 . . . TWO-COLOUR EDGING (Green and shaded Yellow). Use 2

shuttles, one wound with each colour.

Starting at flower, with Yellow shuttle, r of 3 ds, sm p, 12 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl. R of 3 ds, join to p of preceding r, 12 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl. R of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 6 ds, sm p, 6 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl. R of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 4 ds, sm p, 8 ds, join to 1st p of 1st r, 3 ds, cl. Tie threads and clip off short end. To make Green stem, carry thread on wrong side of work to p between the 1st and 2nd r's of flower, fasten and attach Green shuttle thread to that same p. * Using the Green thread as a ball thread, make a ch of 18 ds.

To make 2nd flower, allow sp of

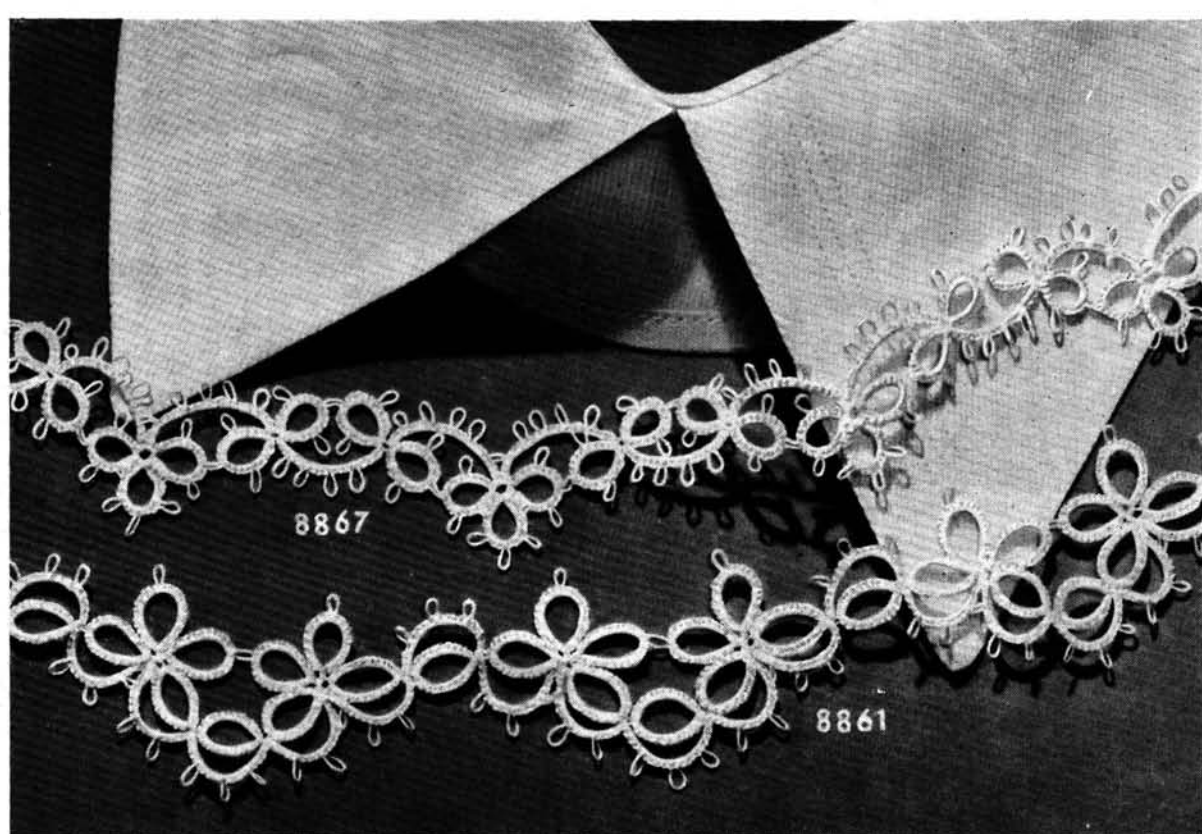
$\frac{1}{8}$ inch extra of Yellow thread and, using the Yellow shuttle, make another flower, following the directions for the 1st flower. Work with right side of tatting toward you and in joining last r to 1st, catch in the $\frac{1}{8}$ inch of Yellow thread which you allowed in making the stem, to hold it in place.

To make Green leaf, carry Green shuttle thread to the centre of the flower just completed, fasten and carry it to the p joining the 3rd and 4th r's. Fasten, turn work so that wrong side is toward you. With Green, r of 4 ds, join to adjacent p in 4th r of flower, 8 ds, join to free p of 3rd r in 1st flower, 3 ds, p, 15 ds, cl. Carry Green thread to centre of flower, fasten and carry both threads to p joining the 1st and 2nd r's. Repeat from * for length desired.

Rw, sr of 4 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Repeat from * for length desired. At corners, make the ch's that precede and follow the 3-r group of 4 ds, p and 4 ds. Tie and cut. **2nd row:** Attach thread to free p of 1st r, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, * join to joining-p of 1st and 2nd r, ch of 4 ds, 4 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds. Join to joining-p of 2nd and 3rd r's. Ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to free p of last r of 3-r group and free p of r on next 3-r group. Ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Repeat from * across.

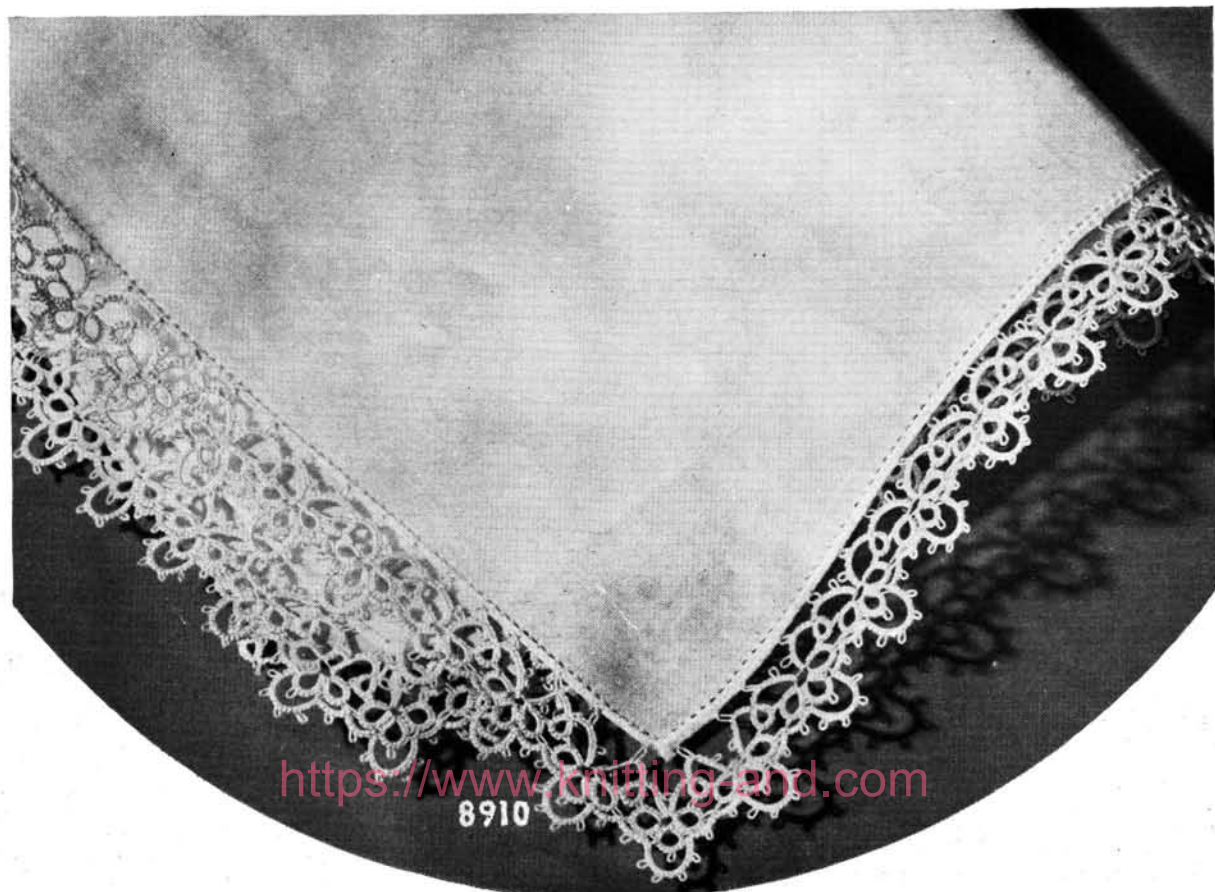

Rw, ch of 6 ds. Rw, r of 8 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 8 ds, cl. R of 8 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 8 ds, cl. Make 1 more r same as this, joining to the preceding r as before. Rw, ch of 6 ds. Rw, r of 8 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 6 ds, p, 8 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 6 ds. Rw, r of 8 ds, p, 8 ds, p, 8 ds, cl. Rw, sr of 6 ds, join to free p of 2nd r, 6 ds, cl. Attach ball thread to free p on centre r of 3-r group and make ch of 6 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, join to adjacent r that has 1 free p; make 1 more ch same as this, join to free p of next r; make 1 more ch as before, join to joining-p of 2 r's; make centre ch of 6 ds, 3 p's sep. by 6 ds, 6 ds, join to joining-p of next 2 r's and complete row to correspond with beginning. Tie and cut.

Cut off one corner of handkerchief (about $\frac{3}{4}$ inch from point of corner) and hem. Sew lace corner to linen.

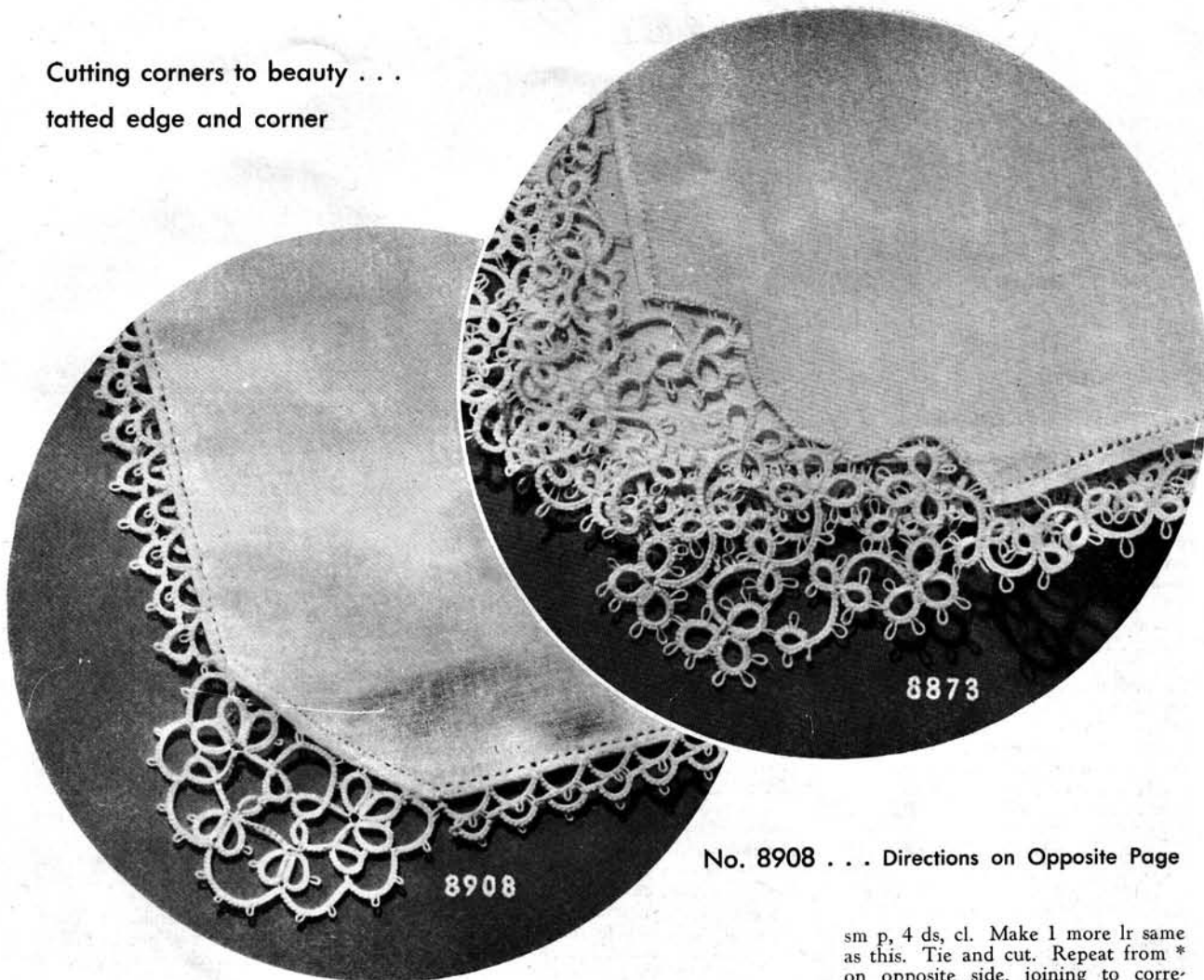
Edging . . . 1st row: Fasten thread to edge of handkerchief, * ch of 5 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 5 ds, join to handkerchief, leaving $\frac{3}{8}$ inch space. Repeat from * along entire edge. Tie and cut. **2nd row:** Attach thread to 1st p of 1st row. *Ch of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to 3rd p of same scallop. Ch of 2 ds, join to 1st p of next scallop. Repeat from * along entire edge.

sm p, 4 ds, cl. Make 1 more 1r same as this. Tie and cut. Repeat from * on opposite side, joining to corresponding picots.

To complete corner and start edging, 1r of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to 2nd p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. 1r of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to 2nd p of 1st r made, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. 1r of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 4 ds, 4 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. Ch of 8 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 8 ds. 1r, sr of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to 3rd p of 2nd r in group of 3 r's in preceding outer-edge section, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. 1r, ** sr of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. 1r, ch of 9 ds, p, 9 ds. 1r, sr of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to centre p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. 1r, sr of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. 1r, ch of 9 ds, p, 9 ds. 1r, sr of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to 2nd p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Repeat from ** around edge of handkerchief and complete corner to correspond.

Place lace corner on handkerchief, draw a line lightly along inner edge of lace, having the line touch the p's. Embroider with buttonhole stitch along the outline. Cut off excess linen and sew lace to linen. Sew remainder of edging to hem of handkerchief.

Ch of 4 ds, 10 p's sep. by 3 ds, 4 ds, turn work and join to base of 4th r, ch of 4 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Sr of 6 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. Ch of 3 ds, p, 4 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to adjacent p of 4th r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, p, 3 ds. Sr of 6 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. Ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 4 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to adjacent p of 5th r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to adjacent p of 1st r, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 17 ds, join to base of 1st r, ch of 24 ds, turn work and join to base of last r, ch of 4 ds, 10 p's sep. by 3 ds, 4 ds, turn work and join to base of 1st r. Tie and cut.

2nd and 3rd Motifs . . . Make the same as 1st Motif, joining the 5th and 6th p's of last 10-p ch to matching p's of corresponding 10-p ch of previous motif. This completes top row.

2nd row—1st Motif . . . R of 6 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of 1st sr of Top Row, 3 ds, p, 4 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to adjacent p of previous r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, p, 3 ds, join to p of next sr of Top Row, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 4 ds. Rw and complete as for 1st Motif of Top Row.

2nd and 3rd Motifs . . . Same as 1st Motif, joining to Motifs of Top Row as 1st Motif of 2nd row was joined, and joining to previous motif as 2nd Motif of Top Row was joined to 1st Motif.

3rd Row—1st Motif . . . Same as 1st Motif of 2nd Row until 1st 10-p ch is completed. Ch of 4 ds, 4 p's sep. by 3 ds, 4 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to adjacent p of previous r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, 4 p's sep. by 3 ds, 4 ds, rw. Complete as

for previous motifs.

2nd Motif . . . Work and join as for 2nd Motif of 2nd Row.

3rd Motif . . . Work as for 1st Motif of 3rd Row, joining as before.

Bottom Motif . . . Work as for 1st Motif of 3rd Row, joining to p's of 2 sr's of 2nd Motif of 3rd Row.

Fill-in Motif . . . Lr of 10 ds, skip 1 p after 2nd sr of 1st Row, join to next p, 3 ds, join to 1st p of next ch, 10 ds, cl. Ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds. *Lr of 10 ds, join to last p of next ch, 3 ds, join to 1st p of next ch, 10 ds, cl. Repeat from * once more. Ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds. R of 10 ds, join to last p of next ch, 3 ds, join to 1st p of next ch, 10 ds, cl. Join to base of 1st r. Tie and cut. Make 3 more fill-in motifs in same way.

Work another fill-in motif same as before until 3rd r is completed, then ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds. R of 10 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 10 ds, cl. Join to base of 1st r. Tie and cut. Work another fill-in motif on opposite side to correspond.

Edging . . . R of 6 ds, join to 4th p of 10-p ch on 1st Motif of 1st Row, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 4 ds. (Mark the centre p of this ch with a coloured thread for joining Side Section later.) Rw, r of 6 ds, join to 6th p of same ch, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, make r's and ch's alternately as above, joining to p's as follows: Next r (which is 3rd r) to 9th p of same ch, 4th r to 2nd p of next 10-p ch (2nd Row), 5th r to 5th p of same ch, 6th r to next p of same ch, 7th r to 9th p of same ch, 8th r to 2nd p of next 10-p ch (3rd Row), 9th r to 5th p of same ch, 10th r to next p of same ch, 11th r to 9th p of same ch, 12th r to 2nd p of next ch (same motif), 13th r to 2nd p of next ch of same motif, 14th r to 1st p of 1r of fill-in motif, 15th r to 2nd p of same 1r, 16th r to 5th free p from top of next 10-p ch (Bottom Motif). Skip 2 p's and join 17th r to next p of same ch, 18th r to 1st p of next ch on same motif, 19th r to last p of same ch. Edging for half of lace is now completed.

Continue around other half to correspond, marking the centre p of last ch for joining of Side Section later. Continue r's and ch's until there are 43 free r's. Make another ch and join to the base of the 1st r made for Edging. Tie and cut.

SIDE SECTION . . . 1st Row: Make 2 motifs same as first 2 motifs of Top Row of Centre Section. **2nd Row:** Make 2 motifs same as 1st motif of 3rd Row of Centre Section, joining as before.

Bottom Motif . . . R of 6 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Sr of 6 ds, join to 3rd free p below joinings between motifs of 2nd Row, 6 ds, cl. Ch of 3 ds, p, 4 ds. Rw, r of 6 ds, join to adjacent p of 1st r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, p, 3 ds. R of 6 ds, join to 3rd free p below joining on next motif of 2nd Row, 6 ds, cl. Ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 4 ds. Rw and complete same as motifs of 2nd Row. Work 1 fill-in motif same as 1st fill-in motif of Centre Section.

Edging . . . Work same as edging of Centre Section until 7th r is completed. Join 8th r to 2nd p of next ch (same motif), 9th r to 3rd p of next 10-p ch (Bottom Motif), 10th r to 6th p of same ch, 11th r to 8th p of same ch, 12th r to 1st p of next ch (same motif), 13th r to last p of same ch. Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 4 ds. Edging for half of lace is now completed.

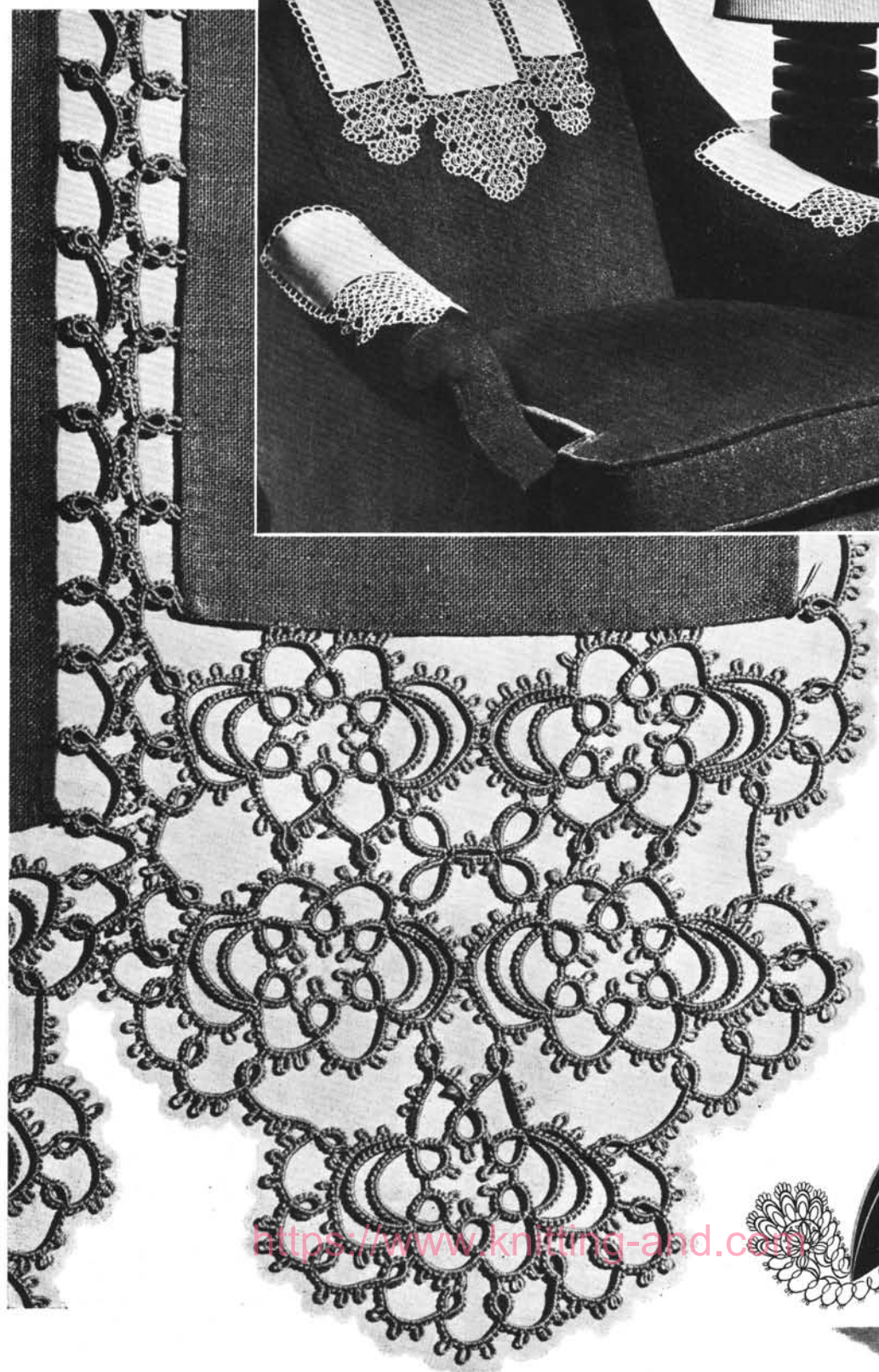
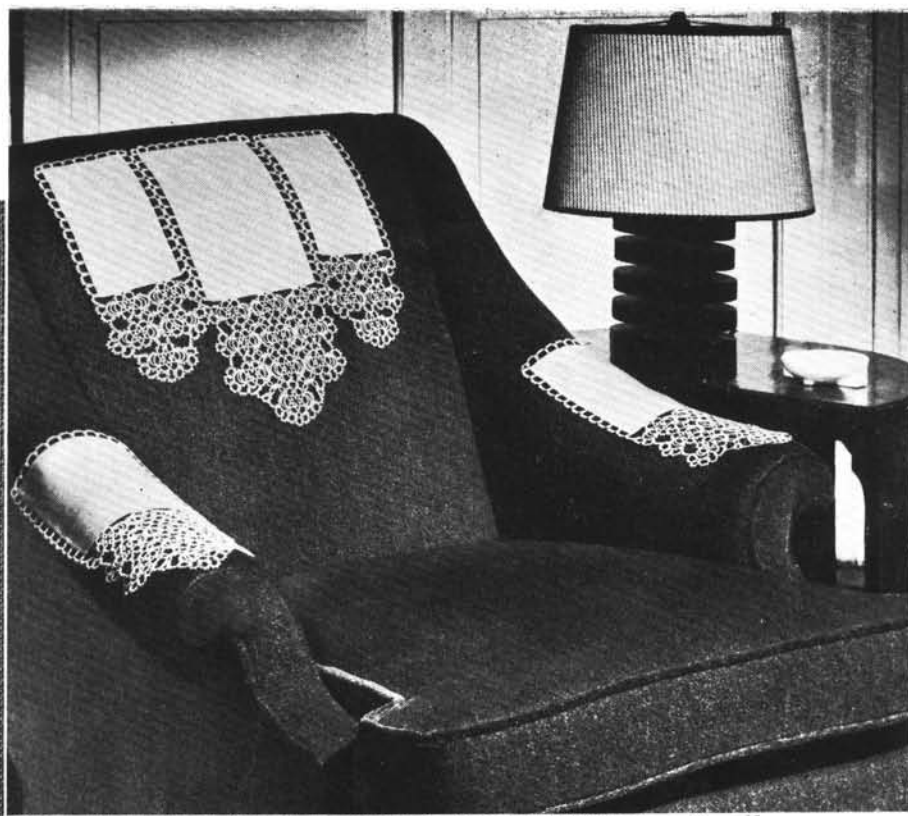

Rw, continue working r's and ch's as before, joining the centre of each ch to the centre p of adjacent ch of Centre Section, until there are 17 joinings in all between Side and Centre Sections. Work r's and ch's without joining until there are 22 free ch's, joining the last ch to the base of the 1st r of edging. Work other Side Section to correspond.

Cut one piece of linen $8\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}$ inches and two pieces $7 \times 4\frac{1}{4}$ inches. Make a narrow hem all around edges. Sew lace to linen.

ARM PIECES

Same as Centre Section of Chair Back, making 37 free r's for edging of linen. Cut linen $7\frac{1}{4} \times 6\frac{1}{4}$ inches and complete as for Centre Section. If a smaller Arm Piece is desired, make two pieces like Side Sections of Chair Back.

Finishing . . . Gather into a cluster and sew to first sr. Fasten piece to earring base and stiffen the tatting by brushing lightly with colourless nail enamel. Finish other earring in same way.

MATERIALS:

Coats Chain  **Mercer Crochet,**
No. 60. 1 Ball is sufficient for a
few pairs of earrings.

2 earring bases.

Sr of 3 ds, 3 sm p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. * R of 8 ds, part cl (that is,

Coats Chain  **Mercer Crochet,**
No. 60 1 Ball

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard of organdie, 36 inches wide.

1 yard bias binding.

1st row: Starting at front edge, make * r of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 8 ds, p, 8 ds. Repeat from * until 19 ch's are made. To make corner of collar, make r of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 8 ds, p, 8 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to p of preceding r, 4 ds, cl. Then rw, and continue making r's and ch's alternately as before until 46 ch's are made for back. For the other

corner, make another group of 2 r's joined at the p, with a ch between the r's. Make 19 more r's and ch's for the other front, ending with a r. Tie and cut. **2nd row:** R of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 9 ds, p, 9 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to p in 1st ch of 1st row, 4 ds, cl. * Rw, ch of 9 ds, p, 9 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to p in next ch of previous row. Repeat from * to end of row, at each corner making 2 r's joined to the p of corner ch in previous row and having end of row correspond with beginning. **3rd row:** Work as for 2nd row, but making ch's of 10 ds, p, 10 ds. **4th row:** Work as for previous row, but making ch's of 9 ds, 3 p's sep. by 2 ds, 9 ds.

Cut 2 rectangular pieces of organdie each $5\frac{1}{2}$ x 8 inches. Cut each piece diagonally across, thus having 4 triangles each $5\frac{1}{2}$ x 8 x $9\frac{3}{4}$ inches. Place 2 pieces together and machine stitch along the two shorter sides of triangle. Turn right side out. Make other lapel in same way, then finish the remaining side of each lapel with bias binding, leaving 6 inches of binding between the 2 lapels for back of neck and 1 inch of binding free at front ends of collar. Sew tatting to collar through the p's of the small r's on the 1st row, easing in lace to form frill. Fasten the ends of each row of tatting to the 1-inch pieces of binding left at the front ends of collar.

p, * 3 ds, 11 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, sm p, 2 ds. Rw, r of 10 ds, join to 5th p of next long ch of preceding row, 10 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 2 ds, join to sm p of preceding ch, 3 ds, 11 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, sm p, 5 ds. Rw and make another 3-r group as before. 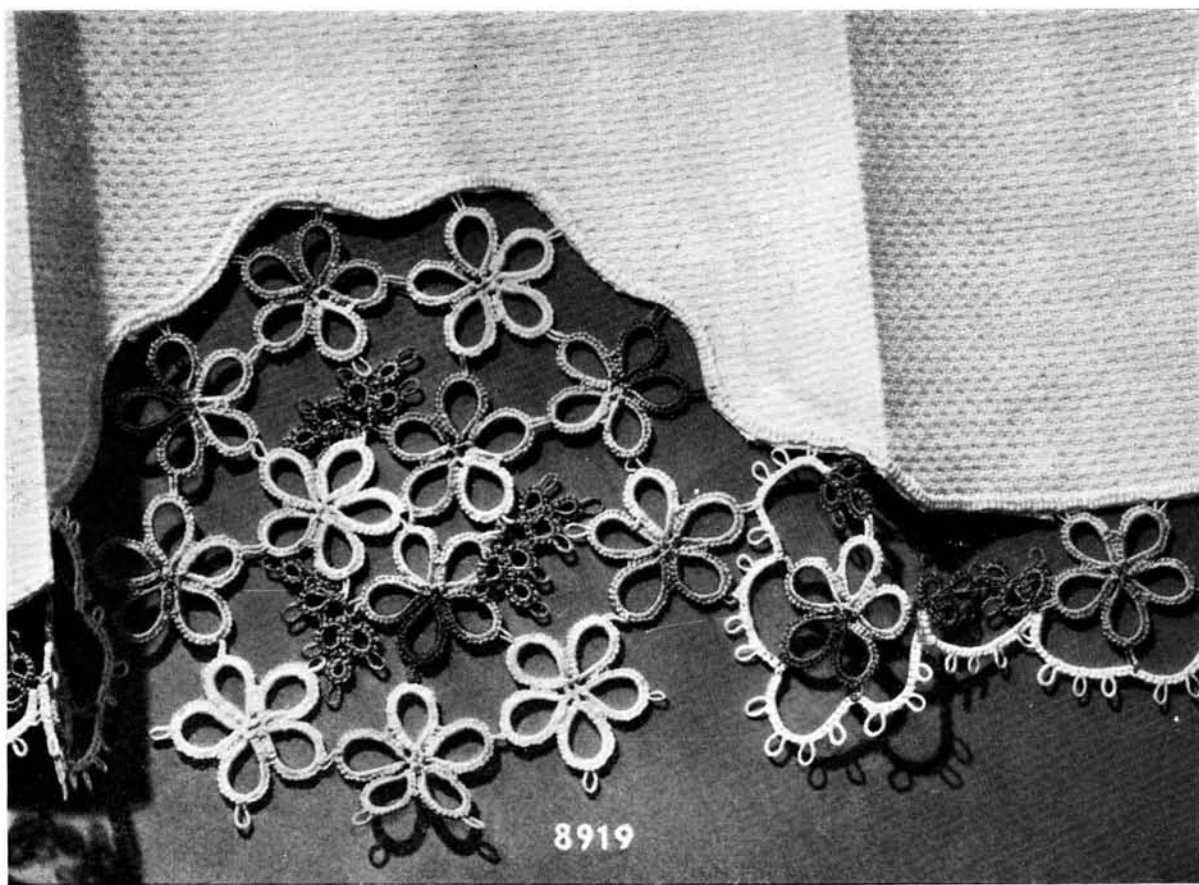

MEDALLION . . . In making flowers, alternate colours for each flower. R of 5 ds, sm p, 10 ds, p, 10 ds, sm p, 5 ds, cl. R of 5 ds, join to last sm p of preceding r, 10 ds, p, 10 ds, sm p, 5 ds, cl. Make 3 more r's like one just made, joining the last r to the 1st sm p of 1st r. Tie and cut. This completes 1 flower.

To make the 3 flowers at the very centre of Medallion, make another flower in same way joining 1 r to the p in one of the r's of the 1st flower. Make another flower and join it in the same way to the same p of the 1st flower.

There are 2 p's on each of these flowers which are so close to the cor-

responding p's of the adjacent flowers that they could almost be joined together. From these p's the green leaves are started.

LEAF . . . All leaves are made in Green. Fasten Green shuttle thread to p of flower r, sr of 6 ds, p, 3 ds, sm p, 3 ds, cl. Sr of 3 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl and tie over both closings. Carry thread on wrong side to sm p and fasten. Sr of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, cl and fasten to same sm p. Carry thread back to base of first 2 r's, fasten. Fasten to p from which leaf started (1 leaf made); carry to adjacent p of next flower and fasten. Make another leaf in this p in same way joining this leaf to the previous one at p of adjacent r. Tie and cut. Make 2 more double leaves between flowers to correspond. Make a circle of 9 flowers around the 3-flower group joining flowers to each other at p's of adjacent r's so that there are 2 free petals on each flower on the outside of the circle but at the same time join 6 r's of inner circle to the 6 free

r's of centre 3-flower group leaving every 3rd r free.

EDGING . . . Make 8 individual flowers. Make a leaf as before, joining centre r to a p on one of the 8 flowers just made. Using Green shuttle and a small ball (just a few yards) of White thread, make a ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds, join to p of upper r of one of the flowers of Medallion, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to next p of flower to which leaf is joined. Ch of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to p of next r of same flower of Medallion, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to next p of flower to which leaf is joined. Ch of 4 ds, 4 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds, join to next p of same flower. Ch of 4 ds, 4 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds, join to next p of same flower. *Rw, with shuttle make another leaf. Rw, ch of 4 ds, join to last p of preceding ch, 4 ds, 4 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, make another leaf joining centre r to p of centre r of adjacent leaf. Rw, join shuttle thread to a p in another flower.

Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to centre p of next-to-last ch, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Work remainder of edging to correspond with other side. Tie and cut. Sew the p's on ch's to edge of towel.

Ch of 4 ds, join to last p of preceding ch, 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds, join to next p of same flower. Make another ch and join to next p of flower. Repeat from * twice more.

The edging for the other side is made in the same manner and is joined to the opposite side of Medallion, leaving 3 flowers free at the bottom of Medallion.

Place tatting on towel and draw a line lightly along inner edge of lace having the line touch the p's and curving it slightly around centre Medallion to form scallops. Embroider with buttonhole stitch along the outline catching in the p's. Cut out fabric under lace.

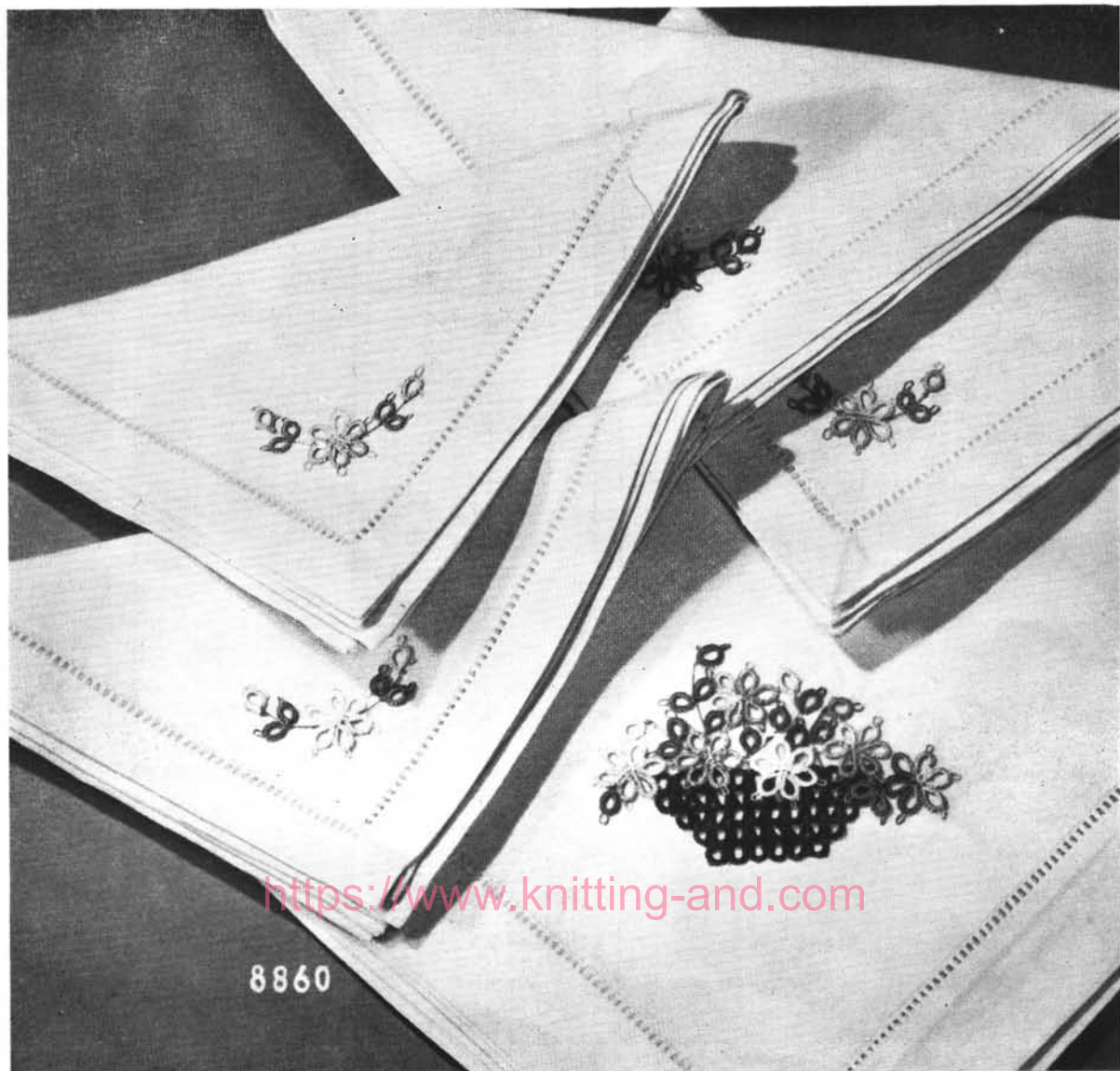

* R of 4 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, part cl (that is, leave $\frac{1}{8}$ inch sp at base of r). Repeat from * until 8 r's are made, making last r like 1st. **3rd row:** Carry thread to free p on r just made, turn work, r of 6 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. * R of 4 ds, join to p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, part cl. Fasten to p that joins the 2 r's directly below. Repeat from * until 10 r's are made, making last r like 1st. **4th row:** Work as for 3rd row, but having 12 r's in the row. **5th row:** Work as before, having only 12 r's in row, but part closing all r's. Tie and cut. To work 1st row, turn

work upside down and work 6 r's as before over the centre 6 r's of the 2nd row. Tie and cut.

FLOWERS . . . Using Yellow, r of 4 ds, sm p, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Make 4 more r's same as the one just made, joining last r to the 1st one. This completes 1 flower. Make 5 more flowers same as this—3 of shaded Rose, 1 of shaded Blue, and 1 of shaded Lavender.

A Toast to the Tatted Edge

MATERIALS:

Coats Chain  Mercer Crochet,
No. 60. 1 Ball

$\frac{1}{4}$ yard linen, 36 inches wide.

This amount of material is sufficient for 6 coasters about $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches in diameter and 6 napkins about 6 inches square.

COASTER . . . Starting at flower motif in the outside row, r of 3 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. *R w, r of 3 ds, p, 4 ds, join to 2nd p of 1st r, 4 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Repeat from * 2 more times. Fasten at base of 1st r. This completes a flower. Ch of 9 ds, p, 3 ds. R w, sr of 9 ds, p, 5 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. R w, r of 3 ds, join to p in preceding ch, 6 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. R w, ch of 10 ds. R w, lr of 12 ds, p, 12 ds, cl. Ch of 10 ds. R w, sr of 6 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, sr of 4 ds, join to last p of 1st sr, 5 ds, p, 9 ds, cl. Ch of 3 ds, join to last p of the other sr, 9 ds. R of 3 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to 1st p of last ch of corresponding flower motif, 5 ds. R w and complete flower as

before. Fasten at base of 1st r of flower.

Make 2 more groups same as this, but joining them to the preceding groups at the 2 p's of sr's and at the p of lr. These 3 groups make a half circle. Make another half circle same as this.

Cut 6 circles of linen each 3 inches in diameter. Make a narrow hem around each piece and sew lace to linen along the edges.

NAPKIN . . . Make a flower for one corner and complete edging with r of 4 ds, join to adjacent p of flower, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. *Sp $\frac{1}{4}$ inch. R of 4 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Repeat from * until edging measures 20 inches, joining to flower at last p.

Cut 6 pieces of linen each 6 inches square. Cut off one corner of each napkin to fit flower of edging. Hem linen and sew lace to linen.

BUDS . . . Each bud is made in same manner as 1 flower petal. There are 2 Blue buds, 2 Yellow buds and 1 Lavender. All thread-ends on the buds, leaves and stems should be left long enough to be pulled through the fabric for fastening, thus avoiding too many knots and thread-ends on the right side of work.

LEAVES AND STEM . . . Using Green, r of 8 ds, p, 8 ds, cl. R w, r of 8 ds, p, 8 ds, cl and tie. Sp $\frac{1}{4}$ inch. R of 8 ds, p, 8 ds, cl and tie. This completes 1 spray. Make 2 more sprays same as this and 3 single leaves.

Arrange basket, flowers, buds, stems and leaves on one corner of cloth, having bottom of basket about 4 inches from point of corner. Sew securely. Work other three corners of cloth in same way.

NAPKINS

Using Yellow make 1 flower and 2 buds as before.

STEM AND LEAF . . . With Green thread, make r of 8 ds, p, 8 ds, cl. R w, r of 8 ds, p, 8 ds, cl and tie. Sp $\frac{1}{4}$ inch. Make another stem with leaves same as this.

Arrange flower, buds, stem and leaves in one corner of napkin about $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches from point of corner. Sew securely. Using a different flower colour for each napkin, work one corner of other three napkins in same way.

Rr, ch of 5 ds. Rr, repeat from * until 6 points are made. Sew sr's to dc's on bone ring as in illustration.


Cord . . . To make a twisted cord, cut 6 strands of thread about $2\frac{1}{2}$ times the desired length and twist strands tightly; double the twisted strands and give them a second twist in the opposite direction. Knot free end of cord.

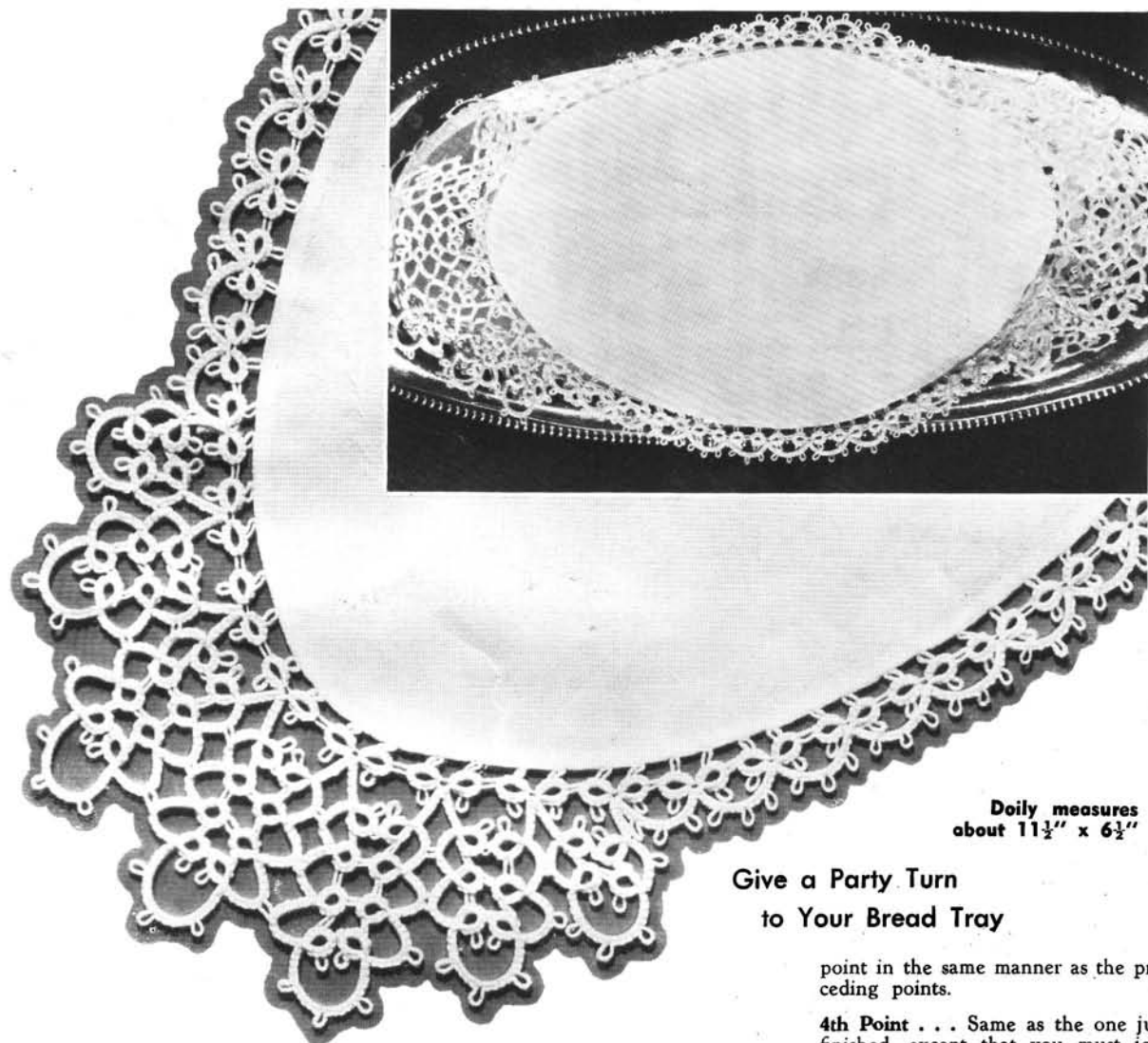

R w, r of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 5 ds, 3 p's sep. by 5 ds, 5 ds (this is end ch). R w, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 2nd p of opposite r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 4 ds, p, 4 ds. R w, r of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 3 ds, join to 2nd p of opposite r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 6 ds. R w, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 2nd p of opposite r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. This completes the 1st Point.

2nd Point . . . R of 3 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. Ch of 6 ds. R w, r of 3 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 4 ds, join to p of adjacent ch in 1st Point, 4 ds. R w, r of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds. R w, r of 3 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 6 ds, 3 p's sep. by 6 ds, 6 ds (this is end ch). Complete point in the same manner as the 1st Point, joining r's to those opposite.

3rd Point . . . R of 3 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. Ch of 6 ds. R w, r of 3 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 4 ds, join to p of adjacent ch in preceding point, 4 ds. R w, r of 3 ds, join to p of preceding r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 5 ds, join to p of adjacent ch of preceding point, 5 ds. R w, r of 3 ds, join to p of preceding r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 6 ds, p, 6 ds. R w, r of 3 ds, join to p of preceding r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R w, ch of 7 ds, 3 p's sep. by 7 ds, 7 ds. Complete

point in the same manner as the preceding points.

4th Point . . . Same as the one just finished, except that you must join the 3rd ch to the adjacent ch of previous point.

5th Point . . . Same as the 4th Point.

6th Point . . . Work to correspond with 2nd Point.

7th Point . . . Work to correspond with 1st Point.

This completes the points at one end of doily. For the edge along the side, make r of 3 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. R w, * ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep. by 4 ds, 4 ds. R w, r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 2nd p of adjacent r of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, cl. R of 3 ds, 3 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, cl. Repeat from * until 13 ch's and pairs of r's are made.

Make the points for the other end as before, then continue with edging to correspond with opposite sides. Fasten last r at base of 1st r. Tie and cut.


Place lace on linen; draw a line lightly along inner edge of lace, having the line touch the p's. Cut linen to within $\frac{1}{4}$ inch of outline. Make a narrow hem all around, having pencil mark at fold of hem. Sew lace to linen.

Delicate tracery patterns to hook together for doilies, luncheon mats, or to use as tiny coasters.

Round Motif No. 8917

Starting at centre, r of 5 ds, sm p, 7 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 7 ds, sm p, 5 ds, cl. R of 5 ds, join to last sm p of preceding r, 7 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 7 ds, sm p, 5 ds, cl. Make 4 more r's like this one, joining the last r to st sm p of 1st r. Tie and cut.

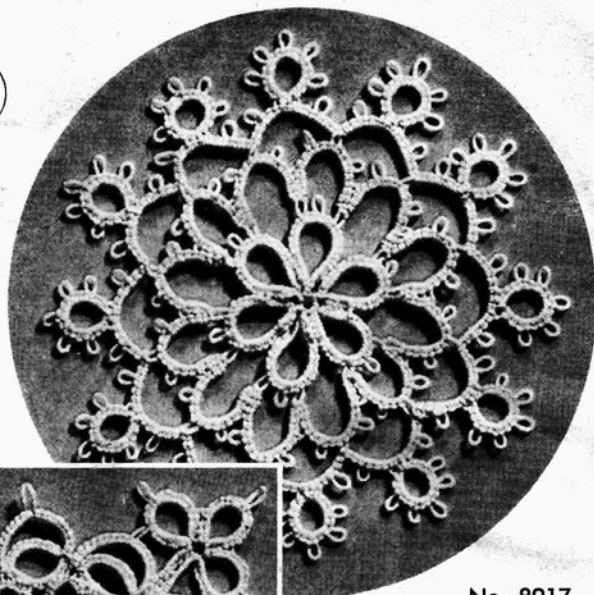
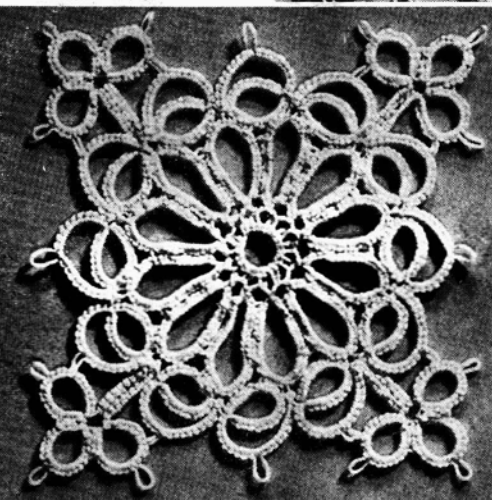

Tie and cut. **2nd row:** Fasten ball and shuttle threads to 2nd p of 1st ch in preceding row, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, sm p, 1 ds. R of 1 ds, join to sm p of ch, 3 ds, 5 p's sep. by 3 ds, 3 ds, sm p, 1 ds, cl. Ch of 1 ds, join to sm p of r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, fasten to 2nd p of next ch of previous row. Continue thus around. Tie and cut. If you wish to make several of these motifs, join them together at 2 r's on each side at centre p's, leaving 1 r free between motifs.

Square Motif No. 8915

MATERIALS:

Coats Chain  **Mercer Crochet,**
If made in No. 30, motif will
measure 2½ inches square.

Starting at centre, make r of 1 ds, 12 p's sep. by 2 ds, 1 ds, cl. Tie and cut. **1st row:** Fasten shuttle thread to 1st p of centre r. R of 2 ds, sm p, 10 ds, sm p, 7 ds, sm p, 4 ds, sm p, 3 ds, sm p, 10 ds, sm p, 2 ds cl. Join thread to same p from which r started. Carry thread to next p and

fasten. * R of 2 ds, join to last sm p of preceding r, 10 ds, join to next sm p in preceding r, 7 ds, sm p, 4 ds, sm p, 3 ds, sm p, 10 ds, sm p, 2 ds, cl and join to same p from which r started. Carry thread to next p of centre r, fasten and repeat from * 10 more times, joining the last r to the 1st and 2nd sm p's of the 1st r (12 r's in all). **2nd row:** Using ball and shuttle, fasten threads to 3rd sm p of any r of preceding row. R of 8 ds, join to 4th sm p of preceding r, 4 ds, join to 3rd p of that same r, 12 ds, cl. R w, ch of 10 ds, p, 10 ds. Fasten to same 3rd p of same r. R w, and make 2 more r's and ch's like those just finished. For corner, rw, ch of 5 ds, sm p, 4 ds. R w, r of 8 ds, join to p of next to last ch, 4 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 8 ds, p, 8 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 8 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 8 ds, cl. R w, ch of 4 ds, join to sm p of adjacent ch, 5 ds and fasten to p from which preceding ch started. This completes corner. Make another r like those already made. Ch of 10 ds, join to last p in last r of corner 3-r group, 10 ds, join to p as before. Continue working in this manner, making a corner after each group of 3 r's and ch's. Tie and cut. If you wish to make several of these motifs, join them together by the free p's all around motif.

Boutonniere No. 2679

MATERIALS:

Coats Chain  **Mercer Crochet,**
No. 60. 1 Ball

1½ yards contrasting colour narrow ribbon.

MOTIF . . . R of 4 ds, sm p, 3 ds, 7 p's sep. by 2 ds, 3 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to sm p of preceding r, 3 ds, 7 p's sep. by 2 ds, 3 ds, sm p, 4 ds, cl. Make 3 more r's like 2nd r, joining last r to 1st r at sm p. Tie and cut.

The boutonniere is made of two rounds of motifs.

Outer rnd . . . Make 18 motifs, joining them to each other at the centre p of r's so that there are 2 r's free on each motif along one edge (outer edge) and 1 r free along other edge (inner edge). Join last motif to 1st one. Tie and cut.

Inner rnd . . . Make 9 motifs, joining them together in the same way, but joining each free r (2 on each motif) to a free r on inner edge of outer rnd.

For the centre, cut a circle of linen, 1 inch in diameter, and make a narrow hem all around it. Sew the 9 free r's to the outside of this linen centre. Starch lightly and finish with a ribbon rosette.
