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

MODEL "A"

Coats Chain Mercer-Crochet

No. 40 (20 Gram).

1 ball each of 621 (Kingfisher blue), 575 (Laurel Green), 441 (Gorse Yellow).


1 Tatting Shuttle. Abbreviations: See page 10.

Leaves and Stems: Using Green, tie ball and shuttle threads together. * R of 10 ds, p, 10 ds, cl. Rw, r of 10 ds, p, 10 ds, cl (2 leaves made). Rw, ch of 20 ds, draw tightly to form a curve (stem made). Rw, make 2 more leaves as before. Reversing curve of ch, make ch as before. Rw; repeat from * length required. Tie and cut.

Flower: Using Blue, r of 5 ds, 3 p's sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl. (R of 5 ds, join to p of preceding r, 2 p's sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl.) 3 times, joining last r to first r. Tie and cut. Attach to centre of first stem by making a French knot in Yellow in centre of floar Ties and the second of the second results. centre of flower. Tie and cut. Make another flower and attach to next stem. Continue for length required.

Heading: Using Green, tie ball and shuttle threads together. R of and shuttle threads together. R of 5 ds, join to p of r at top of first flower, * 5 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to p of top leaf of 2 leaves made. Ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to top r of next flower. Ch as before, join to top leaf of next 2 leaves. Ch as before. Rw, r of 5 ds, join to next flower. The second of the join to next flower; repeat from * across. Tie and cut.
Insertion: Make exactly as for

edging. Attach Green to opposite side of first flower. Ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to p of second leaf of first



2 leaves. * Ch of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, rw, r of 5 ds, join to next flower, 5 ds, cl. Rw, ch as before, join to second leaf of next 2 leaves. Ch as before, join to next flower. Ch as before, join to next leaf; repeat from * across. Tie and cut.

MODEL "B"

Coats Chain Mercer-Crochet No. 40 (20 Gram).

1 Ball each 513 (Tangerine), 761 (Kingfisher Blue), 623 (Spring Green).

1 Tatting Shuttle.

Abbreviations: See page 10.

Large Flower: Using Tangerine, r of 5 ds, 3 p's sep by 10 ds, 5 ds, cl. (R of 5 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 10 ds, 2 p's sep by 10 ds, 5 ds, cl) 4 times, joining last r to first r. Tie and cut. Attach Blue to centre of flower (r of 5 ds, cl) 3 times. Join to centre of flower. Tie and cut. Make necessary number of large flowers.

Small Flower: Using Blue, r of 10 ds, join to p between r's of large flower, 10 ds, cl. R of 10 ds, p, 10 ds, cl. R of 10 ds, p, 10 ds, cl. R of 10 ds, join to p between r's of next large flower, 10 ds, cl. R of 10 ds, p, 10 ds, cl. Tie and cut. Make necessary number of small flowers, joining each between large flowers as before, having 2 r's free on large flowers at top.

Heading: Using Green, tie ball and shuttle threads together. R of and shuttle threads together. R of 10 ds, join to p between 2 r's of first large flower (preceding the joining of large and small flowers), 10 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 5 ds, 3 p's sep by 6 ds, 5 ds, join to p of r of small flower, * ch of 5 ds, join to last p of preceding ch, 6 ds, 2 p's sep by 6 ds, 5 ds. Rw, r of 10 ds, join to p between 2 r's of next large flower, 10 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 5 ds, 3 p's sep by 6 ds, 5 ds, join to next small flower; repeat from * across. Tie and cut. and cut.

Insertion: Work exactly as for edging. Now work heading along opposite long side as follows:—Using Green, r of 10 ds, join to p between r's at opposite side of first large flavor. Tie and cut.

MODEL "C"

No. 40 (20 Gram).
1 ball each 690 (Pale Lilac), 623 (Spring Green).

1 Tatting Shuttle.

Abbreviations: See page 10.

First Flower: Using Pale Lilac, r of 5 ds, 3 p's sep by 8 ds, 5 ds, cl. * (R of 5 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 8 ds, 2 p's sep by 8 ds, 5 ds, cl) 4 times, joining last r to

Second Flower: R of 5 ds, join to p of r of first flower, 8 ds, 2 p's sep by 8 ds, 5 ds, cl. (R of 5 ds, join to p of r of first flower, 8 ds, 2 p's sep by 8 ds, 5 ds, cl. (R of 5 ds, join to p of preceding r, 8 ds, 2 p's sep by 8 ds, 5 ds, cl.) 4 times, joining last r to first r. Tie and cut.

Third Flower: R of 5 ds, p. 8 ds, join to p of next r of first flower, 8 ds, p, 5 ds, cl. (R of 5 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 8 ds, 2 ps sep by 8 ds, 5 ds, cl.) 3 times. (R of 5 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 8 ds, join to next p between r's of second flower, 8 ds, join to p of first r of flower, 5 ds, cl (scallop made). Tie and cut. Tie and cut.

Fourth Flower: R of 5 ds, p, 8 ds, join to p of r of third flower to correspond, 8 ds, p, 5 ds, cl; repeat from * on first flower for length

from * on first flower for length required. Tie and cut.

Heading: Using Green, tie ball and shuttle threads together, r of 7 ds, p, 7 ds, cl. Join to p of r of first flower (at extreme left). Rw, ch of 8 ds, 2 p's sep by 9 ds, 8 ds, join to p of r (previously joined, first and third flowers). * Rw, r as before. Rw, ch as before and join to p between next 2 flowers; repeat from * across. Tie and cut.

Insertion: Repeat first, second and third flowers of edging.


Fourth Flower: R of 5 ds, join to third flower as second flower was joined to first flower, 8 ds, 2 p's sep by 8 ds, 5 ds, cl. (R of 5 ds, join to preceding r, 8 ds, 2 p's sep by 8 ds, 5 ds, cl) 3 times. R of 5 ds, join to preceding r, 8 ds, join to p of adjoining r of second flower, 8 ds, join to first r of flower, 5 ds, cl. Tie and cut.

Fifth Flower: R of 5 ds, p, 8 ds, join to p of adjoining r of third flower and complete flower as for third flower of edging. Continue to

third flower of edging. Continue to work in this manner for length required.

Heading: Work heading as for edging. Tie ball and shuttle threads together, r of 7 ds, join to opposite side of p of r of second flower, 7 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 8 ds, 2 p's sep by 9 ds, 8 ds. Rw, r of 7 ds, join to p between r's of second and fourth flowers, * 7 ds, cl. Rw, ch as before Rw, r of 7 ds, cl. Rw, ch as before Rw, r of 8 ds. Rw, r of 7 ds, cl. Rw, ch as before Rw, r of 8 ds. Rw, r of 8 7 ds, cl. Rw, ch as before. Rw, r of 7 ds, join between next 2 flowers; repeat from * across. Tie and cut.

MATERIALS:

Coats Chain & Mercer-Crochet 1 Ball No. 50 white or ecru. Measurements: 12ins. by 6½ins. Abbreviations: See page 10.

Foundation Motif: R 5 ds, p, 5 ds, p, 1 ds, p, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Ch 5 ds, 4 p sep by 5 ds, 5 ds. R 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to 2nd p in centre of last r, 1 ds, p, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Ch at last ch. R as last. Ch as last. R as last but join to p in centre of 1st r also. Ch as last. Fasten off firmly. Tie and cut. To join motifs: R as 1st r of last motif. Ch 5 ds, p, 5 ds, p of lower right corner. Ch of last motif, 5 ds, join to 4th p of same ch, 5 ds. R as last motif. Ch 5 ds, join to 1st p of next ch of last motif, 5 ds, join to 2nd p of same ch, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Complete motif as before. Work 9 of these for each side of the

Curved Motifs: These are worked around the ends. A motif. 1st r as in other motifs. Ch 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to 3rd p of lower right corner, ch of last motif, 5 ds, join to next p of same ch, 5 ds. R as usual. Ch 6 ds, join to 1st p of next ch of last motif, 12 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 6 ds. R as

last R, ch 6 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 12 ds, p, 6 ds. 4th R of motif as usual. Ch 5 ds, 3 p sep by 5 ds, 5 ds. Fasten off firmly. Tie and cut. Work five more motifs similar to the last, joining the last of them to 1st motif of length of work for other side of doily. Work curved motifs for the other end to correspond.

Inner Rings and Chains: R 4 ds, p, d ds, join to any p on inner side of foundation motifs, 4 ds, p, 4 ds. ch 4 ds, p, 4 ds. r 4 ds, join to p of last r. 4 ds, join to any p of motif, 4 ds, p, 4 ds. Repeat from * around, but a soon at the second se as soon as the curved end motifs are reached make rings of 5 ds, join to p of last r, 5 ds, join to p of motif, ch 5 ds, p, 5 ds. And make chains of 4 ds, p, 4 ds. Work 2nd side and end to correspond.

The Edging Scallops: R 6 ds, 5 p sep by 3 ds, 6 ds. * Ch 6 ds, join to 1st p of 1st ch on outer edge of a motif, 6 ds. R 5 ds, join to 2nd p of same ch, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Ch 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to last p of r before ds, p, 3 ds, join to last p of r before the last one, 3 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. R 5 ds. p, 5 ds, join to last p of last r, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Close beside make another r of 4 ds, 3 p sep by 4 ds, 4 ds. Ch 3 ds, 5 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to 2nd p of last r and continue ch for 3 ds, 5 p sep by 3

ds, 3 ds. R 4 ds, p, 4 ds, join to p of last r to which ch is also joined, of last r to which ch is also joined, 4 ds, p, 4 ds. Close beside make another r of 5 ds, 3 p sep by 5 ds, 5 ds. Ch 3 ds, 5 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. R 5 ds, join to 2nd p of last r, 5 ds, join to 2nd p of last r, 5 ds, join to 2nd p of set r of this scallop, 5 ds, join to 1st p of next ch of foundation motif, 5 ds. The End Motifs: These are worked in two sections, a foundation motifiand a border of rings and chains, by which it is joined to the inner edge of the border.


Foundation Motif: Centre r 2 ds, 9 p sep by 3 ds, 1 ds. Tie and cut. R 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to a p of centre r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds. * Ch 6 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 6 ds. R 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 2nd last p of last r, 3 ds, join to next p of centre r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Repeat from * 5 times. Tie and cut off.

Border of Motif: This is a double row of rings divided by diagonal chains, and joined to the inner edge of the border by the rings of its outer row. Before commencing this row, fold the border in

MATERIALS:

Coats Chain () Mercer-Crochet

No. 30 or 40, 3 balls, tatting shuttle.

ABBREVIATIONS: See page 10.

Mats of any size may be made by varying the number of foundation motifs. Both large and small mats are made in the same way.

First work the required number of motifs, then the remainder of the design, which is done in three rounds.

Small Square Mat: Worked as illustrated in No. 40 cotton, this mat is 7in. square, and the large one 16in. x 11in.

Foundation Motif: Centre Section: Centre ring, 2 ds, 8

p, sep by 3 ds, 1 ds. Tie and cut. Ring, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to a p of centre ring, 3 ds, p. 3 ds, p, 3 ds. * Chain 7 ds, p, 7 ds. Ring, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 2nd last p of last ring. 3 ds, join to next p of centre ring, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Repeat from *. Join last ring to 1st, and fasten off last chain by joining to top of 1st ring. Tie and cut.

Border of Motif: * Ring 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to p of a chain of centre section, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Close beside make another ring of 5 ds, 3 p sep by 5 ds, 5 ds. Chain 3 ds, 5 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds/join to 2nd p of last ring, and continue chain for 3 ds, 5 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Ring 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to p of last ring, to which chain is joined, 5 ds, p,

5 ds. Close beside make another ring of 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to p of next chain of centre section, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Chain, 3 ds, 7 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Repeat from *.

To Join the Motifs: Work centre section, 1st pair of close together rings of next motif, and chain of 3 ds, 5 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to 2nd p of last ring, and continue for 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 3rd p of 2nd part of lower right corner chain of last motif, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Next pair of close together rings as in last motif. Chain 3 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to 4th p of next chain of last motif, 3 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Pair of close-together rings as before. Chain 3 ds, p,

Coats Chain Mercer-Crochet No. 60 (20 Gram).

1 ball selected colour.


1 Tatting Shuttle. 1 Handkerchief.

Abbreviations: See page 10.

Edging: ** R of 4 ds, 3 p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 8 ds, rw, sr of 4 ds, join to adjacent p of previous r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Ch of 8 ds, rw, r of 4 ds, 3 p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds, cl. * Sp ($\frac{1}{8}$ in. - .3 cm.). R of 4 ds, join to adjacent p of previous r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl; repeat from * 3 times more, rw, ch of 8 ds, sr of 4 ds, join to free p of previous sr, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 8 ds, rw, r of 4 ds, join to free p of last r, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl; repeat from ** for length required.

Sew to edge of handkerchief as shown in illustration.

Damp and press.



3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 3rd p of next chain of last motif, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 2nd p of last ring and continue for 3 ds, 5 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Complete motif as before. Join another motif to the first one in the same way and when joining the 4th one make the joins along the first side as before.

To Join the Motifs: After working the 1st part of the 2nd corner chain, join it to 2nd p of last ring as usual, then continue for 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 3rd p of 2nd part of nearest corner chain of next motif 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Pair of rings as usual. Join next two chains by centre picot to centre picots of corresponding chains of previous

motif, and complete this one as before.


The first round: Ring 6 ds, p. 6 ds, join to 4th p of 2nd part of right hand corner chain of work, 6 ds, p, 6 ds. * Chain 6 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 6 ds. Ring 3 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds, join to last p of last ring, 3 ds, 3 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Close beside make another ring of 3 ds, 7 p, sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Chain as last. Ring 6 ds, join to 4th p of last ring, 6 ds, join to 3rd p of next chain of motif with 5 p on it, 6 ds, p, 6 ds. Repeat from * twice, joining 2nd round ring to 2nd p of 1st part of right corner chain of the work. Next chain and ring as usual.

To turn a corner: Close beside last ring, make another of

3 ds, 5 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Chain 6 ds, 4 p sep by 6 ds, 6 ds. Ring 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, join to 3rd p of last ring, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 3 ds. Close beside make another ring of 3 ds, 7 p sep by 3 ds, 3 ds. Chain 6 ds, p, 6 ds, p, 6 ds. Round ring as usual, joining it to 4th p of next chain of motif. Repeat from * right round.

The second round: Ring 5 ds, p, 5 ds, join to any p of last round, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. * Chain 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Ring 5 ds, join to p of last ring, 5 ds, join to next p of last round, 5 ds, p, 5 ds. Repeat from *. Make corner chains of 5 ds, 4 p sep by 5 ds, 5 ds.

1 ball (10 or 20 gram) selected colour.

2 Guest Towels.

1 Tatting Shuttle.

Abbreviations: See page 10.

Edging No. 1: Lr of 6 ds, p, 6 ds, Lp, 4 ds, smp, 8 ds, cl and tie Rw, sr of 5 ds, p, 4 ds, smp, 1 ds, part cl (1/16in. - .1 cm. sp at base of r). * (Sr of 1 ds, join to smp of preceding r, 8 ds, smp, 1 ds, part cl) twice. Rw, Lr of 8 ds, join to smp of preceding Lr, 4 ds, join to Lp

of first Lr, 4 ds, smp, 8 ds, cl. Rw, make 3 more sr's as before. Rw, Lr of 8 ds, join to smp of 2nd Lr, 4 ds, join to Lp of first r, 4 ds, smp, 8 ds, cl. Rw, make 2 more sr's as before, sr of 1 ds, join to p of preceding r, 4 ds, p, 5 ds, part cl. Rw, Lr of 8 ds, join to smp of 3rd Lr. 4 ds, join to Lp of first r, 6 ds, p, 6 ds, cl. (Sr of 4 ds, p, 4 ds, part cl) twice, Lr of 6 ds, p, 6 ds, Lp, 4 ds, smp, 8 ds, cl. Rw, sr of 5 ds, join to corresponding p of adjacent scallop, 4 ds, smp, 1 ds, part cl. repeat from * for length required. Edging No. 2: R of 1 ds, 9 p's sep by 1 ds, cl. * Sr of 1 ds, join to last p of r just made, 1 ds, 8 p's sep by 1 ds, cl; repeat from * once more. Fasten all 3 picot rings together

at base. Rw, ch of 6 ds, p, 5 ds. Rw, sr of 5 ds, join to 4th p of preceding r, 5 ds, cl. ** Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, sr of 5 ds, join to next p of same picot ring, 5 ds. cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, sr of 5 ds, join to next p of same r, 5 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 4 ds, 3 p's sep by 4 ds, 4 ds. Rw, sr of 5 ds, join to 4th p of next picot ring, 5 ds, cl; repeat from ** until 3 sr's are made on each picot ring. Rw, ch of 5 ds, p, 6 ds (10 ch's in all). Fasten at base of 3 picot rings, tie and cut. This completes one motif. Make as many motifs as desired, joining the 3 p's of the 3rd ch to the 3 p's of corresponding ch on previous motif.

Sew edgings to guest towels.

1 Tatting Shuttle.

1 Steel Crochet Hook No. 4.

Piece of Old Bleach Linen to match.

Abbreviations: See page 10.

Measurements: Centrepiece: 10in. x 14in. (25.2 cm. x 35.5 cm.) Small Mat: 6in. (15 cm.) square.

First Motif: Tie ball and shuttle threads together.

R of 5 ds, smp, 3 ds, 5 ps sep by 2 ds, 3ds, smp, 5 ds, cl. * Rw, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, rw, r of 5 ds, join to last p of previous r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, smp, 5 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, rw, r of 5 ds, join to last p of previous r, 3 ds, 5 ps sep by 2 ds, 3 ds, p, 5 ds, cl, r of 5 ds, join to last smp of previous r, 3 ds, 5 ps sep by 2 ds, 3 ds, p, 5 ds, cl, r of 5 ds, join to last smp of previous r, 3 ds, 5 ps sep by 2 ds, 3 ds, p, 5 ds, cl; repeat from * omitting one r at end of last repeat, joining last r to first p of first r. Tie and cut.

Second Motif: Tie ball and shuttle threads together.

R of 5 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, join to centre p of large ring, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 5 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, rw, r of 5 ds, join to last p of previous r, 3 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 5 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 3 ds, p, 3 ds, rw, r of 5 ds, join to p of previous r, 3 ds, p, 2 ds, join to centre p of next large ring on same side of previous motif, 2 ds, p, 2 ds, p, 3 ds, p, 5 ds, cl and complete as for first motif (no more joinings).


Make necessary number of motifs joining as shown in illustration.

TO MAKE UP:

Centrepiece: Lay joined motifs on linen and draw a-line all round inside. Lay a small hem round drawn line. Work a row of dc all round over hem. Sew motifs to dc edge of linen.

SMALL MAT (MAKE 2):

Make up in same manner as centrepiece.

1 Ball each of 494 (Old Rose), 623 (Spring Green). 1 Tatting Shuttle.

Abbreviations: See page 10.

Flower: Using Old Rose, sm r of 1 ds. 8 p's sep by 1 ds. 1 ds. cl. Tie and do not cut. (Sp of 1/16in. (.2 cm.), join to next p of sm r. R of 5 ds, join to last p of preceding r, 5 ds, 2 p's sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl)

7 times, joining last r to first r. Tie and cut.

24 balls selected colour. Milward Steel Crochet Hook No. 4. 1 Tatting Shuttle.

The above quantity is sufficient for a Luncheon Set consisting of 6 place mats each 12in. x 18in. (30.5 cm. x 46 cm.) and a centre mat 16in. x 38in. (40.5 cm. x 96.5 cm.).

Centre Mat - First Motif: Use

shuttle and ball thread.

Make '1 r of 5 ds, 3 p's sep by 5 ds, 5 ds, cl. Rw, make a centre r of 7 ds, p, 7 ds, cl. * Make a ch of 7 ds. Rw, r of 4 ds, join to adjacent p of Ir, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. Lr of 4 ds, join to p of adjacent r, 4ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. R of 4 ds, join to last p of Ir, 4 ds, p, 4 ds, cl (a clover made). Rw, ch of 7 ds, r of 7 ds, join to p of centre r, 7 ds, cl. Rw, Ir of 5 ds, join to last p of clover,

5 ds, p, 5 ds, p, 5 ds, cl. Rw: repeat from * until Ir of 4th clover is completed. Then make r of 4 ds, join to last p of Ir of clover. 4 ds, join to first p of first Ir made at beginning of motif, 4 ds, cl. Rw, ch of 7 ds. Cut threads, leaving 3in. (7.5 cm.) lengths, tie to ends at beginning of motif and cut.

Second Motif: Work exactly as for first motif, joining one corner p to a corner p of first motif.

Third Motif: Join one corner to the corner p of second motif which is directly opposite joining between first and second motifs. Continue in this way until there is a strip of 11 motifs.

First Motif of Second Strip: Holding first strip at top, join to first motif at left end of strip, by joining to the corner which is adjacent to the joining between first and second motifs of first strip.

Second Motif of Second Strip: Join second Motif or Second Strip: Join to motif just completed, joining one corner to first corner after previous joining, and joining next corner to adjacent corner to second motif of first strip. Continue to join motifs as before until there are 25 strips of 11 motifs each. Fill in all spaces between motifs as follows:

With shuttle make Ir of 4 ds, p 10 ds, join to p of Ir at centre of one side of motif, 10 ds, p, 4 ds, cl. one side of motil, 10 ds, p, 4 ds, ci.

* Lr of 4 ds, join to last p of previous r, 10 ds, join to free p on side of next motif, 10 ds, p, 4 ds, cl; repeat from * once more, lr of 4 ds, join to p of previous r, 10 ds, join to free p of next motif, 10 ds, join to free p of first lr of fill in, 4 ds, in the policy of the pol cl. Cut and tie ends. Fill in all other spaces in same way.
