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# General Instructions For Using

# Lily's Speed-O-Weave Frame

Speed-O-Weave or Hexagonal Weaving is a delightful, fascinating craft that is easily and quickly learned. It is simply the winding of threads back and forth around the prongs on the Speed-O-Weave Frame, requiring no skill or previous experience in handwork.

By adjusting the Frame to different sizes and shapes, and interweaving colored threads, an unlimited number and variety of designs can be made.

When learning to Speed-O-Weave, it is best to first read all the way through the General Instructions carefully, then select a simple design for your first project. The Luncheon Set, shown on pages 4 & 5, is made with one color and is the simpliest work that can be done on the Speed-O-Weave Frame. If a Luncheon Set is not needed, one of the place mats will serve beautifully as a doily for a table, radio or television. Make it in the color suggested in the directions or select a color to harmonize with your own color scheme.

After becoming thoroughly familiar with the technique of Speed-O-Weaving, it will be great fun to create your own designs for your home, for gifts and for bazaars.

#### LILY'S SPEED-O-WEAVE Frame

Lily's Speed-O-Weave Frame consists of six angular sections, identical in size and construction, each made with prongs on top to hold the threads. These sections are provided with holes through which bolts, secured by wing nuts, fasten the sections together, and are adjustable to a variety of sizes and shapes.

When Lily's Speed-O-Weave Frame is closed to

its smallest size, with its six sides completely overlapped, each side will measure  $7\frac{1}{2}$  inches. If 2, 4 or all 6 sides are extended one hole, then these sides will be 9 inches long; extended 2 holes,  $10\frac{1}{2}$  inches; 3 holes, 12 inches; and 4 holes,  $13\frac{1}{2}$  inches (fully extended).

#### ASSEMBLING THE FRAME

Lap the left end of one piece inside the right end of a 2nd piece, insert a bolt from inside of Frame through matching holes as near the center of side as possible and screw the wing nut onto bolt from outside of Frame. Repeat around Frame until all 6 sections are bolted together firmly.


#### WINDING THE FRAME

In looking over this book, it will be seen that a chart is given for each design. On these charts, each side of the Frame is lettered and each prong on each side is numbered. The corner prongs are always designated as No. 1 prongs. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it.

The winding is begun by tying the thread to a specified prong (indicated by an arrow on each chart) usually on the side nearest you ("A" side), and extending it across the Frame to a specified prong on the opposite side. **These two prongs are called a pair.** 

Wind as many times around each pair of prongs as specified in instructions. Four times will make eight threads between prongs, six times will make twelve threads, etc. After winding is completed on 1st pair of prongs, take thread across **outside** of Frame to left (clockwise) and wind around the specified next pair of prongs, parallel to 1st

pair. When this has been repeated across Frame (illustrated in figure 1 page 4) carry the thread around the corner and repeat the



TWO PRONGS OPPOSITE EACH OTHER ON ANY TWO SIDES OF THE FRAME ARE CALLED A PAIR.


winding in a 2nd direction across the Frame (illustrated in figure 2 page 5, then in a 3rd direction (figure 3 page 5). Windings in 3 directions are called a Round. Some of the instructions call for repeating a Round a 2nd time. This is done to make the article more even in appearance since winding 12, 16 or 24 threads at one time would give a lumpy appearance. The threads must be drawn tight enough so they will not sag. After the threads have been wound according to directions given for the design, they are tied together at their "intersection" to make a complete article. An "intersection" is any place lines of thread cross. In some instances, there may be only 2 lines in an intersection, in others there may be as many as 6 lines.

#### TYING THE FRAME

The "TYING" of the Frame is done with the shuttle which is supplied with each frame. Tie the thread around the groove in the shuttle, then wind as much thread on it as it will conveniently hold. Turn the frame over and do the "TYING" from the back of the design. Tie the shuttle thread to an outside corner intersection (see dots on Charts), or if specified, to the center intersection. Start tying the intersection nearest the place where the shuttle thread is fastened, by means of "half-

hitches" (see illustration)
Where 2 lines of
threads intersect,
there are 4 openings
around the inter-

section, making 2 half-hitches necessary. Where 3 lines intersect, there are 6 openings, making 3 half-hitches necessary and so on. A half-hitch is made by passing the shuttle down through one opening, bringing it up through the opening directly opposite and inserting the shuttle through the loop thus made (see illustration). Pull the loop down as tight as possible. Repeat this same operation (half-hitches) in remaining openings around the intersection to securely fasten all the threads. Take the thread across to the next intersection, pass the shuttle through an opening on the farther side and repeat as on the first intersection. Continue in this manner until the next corner is reached. then continue along the next side parallel with the Frame, and so on around the entire Frame. When one row around has been completed, skip over to the next row and repeat, tying entire Frame as in a spiral. When tying is started in



center, work around and around out to edge of design. Where 12 lines intersect as in large daisies, make 6 half hitches; where only 2 lines intersect, make 2 half-hitches. All intersections must be tied, however, unless otherwise specified. When all the thread on the shuttle has been used, cut it off shuttle, refill shuttle and tie the new end to the previous end and continue tying.

When the tying is completed, remove the article by cutting the threads just inside the Frame with scissors, or on the outside of prongs with a razor blade. Comb out the fringe and trim to an even length.

## Luncheon Set

This handsome Luncheon Set is made of one color which is the simplest type of work that can be done on the Speed-O-Weave Frame. The place mats are made with the sides of the Frame extended as shown in the illustrations. The centerpiece is made in the same way except that two sides of the Frame, A and D, are fully extended.

#### Materals:

Lily Double Quick Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 50:

17 skeins Ecru, White or a color will make a centerpiece and 6 place mats; or

Lily Frost-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 49:

7 cones Ecru, White or a color will make a centerpiece and 6 place mats.

1 Lily Speed-O-Weave Frame Place Mat (Size - 12½ x 17½")


Extend 2 sides of Frame (A & D) to 12 inches, close 4 other sides (B, C, E & F) to smallest size. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it. Hold Frame with "A" side facing you.

NOTE: Wind Double Quick 3 times (6 threads) or Frost-Tone 6 times (12 threads) around each pair of prongs in 1st Round. (It takes only half as many windings for Double Quick because it is a double-thick thread). Directions are given for Double Quick; changes for Frost-Tone are in parenthesis.

**1st Round:** Following Chart (fig. 3), tie thread to A-3 prong (see arrow).

Ist Direction: Wind thread 3 times (or 6 times for Frost-Tone, see note above) across Frame to E-9 prong. Pattern: Wind thread 3 times (or 6 times for Frost-Tone) around next pair of prongs to left. Repeat this Pattern 21 times across Frame, having all lines parallel ending on B-9 to D-3 prongs. Now the Frame is wound as in Figure 1, with the thread ending on B-9 prong. Note that all these threads (1st direction) lie parallel to each other and to 2 sides (C and F) of the Frame. Do not cut or tie the thread as it can be carried to next winding.

**2nd Direction:** Carry the thread on the outside of the Frame around the adjacent corner to C-3 prong. Now wind thread from C-3 prong across Frame to A-15 prong 3 times (or 6 times for Frost-Tone). Repeat **Pattern** 22 times across Frame, having all lines parallel - ending on D-15 to F-3 prongs. Now the Frame is wound as in

Figure 2, with thread ending on prong D-15. Now note that all these threads (2nd direction) lie parallel to each other and to 2 sides (B and E) of the Frame.

**3rd Direction:** Skip 3 prongs around corner and wind thread from E-3 prong lengthwise of Frame to C-9 prong 3 times (or 6 times for Frost-Tone). Repeat **Pattern** 16 times across Frame, having all lines parallel, - ending on F-9 to B-3 prongs. Note that all these threads (3rd direction) lie parallel to each other and to 2 sides (A and D) of the Frame.


**2nd Round:** Repeat **1st Round.** (This will make a total of 12 Double Quick threads or 24 Frost-Tone threads between each pair of prongs.)

**Tying:** Follow instructions for "Tying," wind thread on shuttle and working on back of Frame, tie all intersections (see dots on Chart fig. 3). Cut threads close to prongs with scissors, comb out fringe and trim evenly 11/4." long. Lay mat right-side-down on a padded board. Steam and press dry through a cloth.


Centerpiece: (Size - 121/2" x 19")

Extend 2 sides of Frame (A & D) to longest length (13½", - 2 pairs of prongs longer than Place Mat); close other sides (B, C, E & F) to smallest size. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it. Hold Frame with "A" side facing you. 1st Round: Follow directions for 1st Round of place mat except in 1st direction repeat Pattern 23 times instead of 21 times; in 2nd direction repeat Pattern 24 times instead of 22 times; repeat 3rd direction exactly.

**2nd Round:** Repeat **1st Round** of Centerpiece. Repeat TYING and finishing.

## "Bright and Gay" Beverage Set

SHOWN IN COLOR ON FRONT COVER

Materials: Lily Sky-Tone, Art. 123: 1 ball Red and 2 balls each Emerald Green, Yellow and Cream; or

**Lily Frost-Tone, Art. 49:** 1 cone each Red, Med Green, Lily Yellow and Cream; or

Daisy Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65, Size 20: 1 skein each Red, Em. Green, Yellow and Cream; and

#### 1 Lily Speed-O-Weave Frame.

Sufficient for 1 large Doily and 4 to 6 Coasters. Large Doily (Size— $8 \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$  inches):

Close Frame to smallest size. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it. Hold Frame with "A" side facing.

**Note:** Wind thread 3 times (6 threads) around each pair of prongs in 1st Round.

**Ist Round:** All the lines in this Round cross in center of Frame like spokes of a wheel. Following heavy lines on Chart which are marked with

a cross at ends, tie Red to A-6 (center) prong (see arrow), take it up across center of Frame to D-6 prong and wind 3 times around this pair of prongs (see NOTE above). Skip 4 prongs to left and wind from B-1 to E-1 corner prongs. Skip 4 prongs and wind from B-6 to E-6. Skip 4 prongs and wind from C-1 to F-1 corner prongs. Skip 4 prongs and wind from C-6 to F-6. Skip 4 prongs and wind from D-1 to A-1 corner prongs

**2nd Round:** Repeat 1st Round making a total of 12 threads between prongs. Tie and cut Red. **Note:** Wind threads 8 times (16 threads) around each pair of prongs in 3rd Round.

3rd Round: Follow heavy lines on Chart marked with a large dot at ends. 1st Direction: Tie Green to A-9 prong and wind 8 times (see Note above) to E-3 prong. Pattern: Skip 3 prongs around corners and wind around the next pair (parallel to 1st line). 2nd Direction: Skip 5 prongs on B and wind from B-9 to F-3. Now repeat Pattern (as given in 1st DIRECTION).

3rd Direction: Skip 5 prongs on C and wind from



C-9 to A-3. Repeat Pattern. Tie and cut Green.

**Note:** Continue to wind thread 8 times around each pair of pronas in 4th Round.

4th Round: Follow light lines on Chart which are marked wth a circle at ends. 1st Direction: Tie Cream to A-5 prong and wind 8 times (see NOTE above) straight across Frame to D-7 prong. Pattern: Skip 1 pair of prongs and wind 8 times around next pair (parallel to last line).

**2nd Direction:** Skip 7 prongs around corner and wind from B-5 to E-7, then repeat **Pattern.** 

**3rd Direction:** Skip 7 prongs around corner and wind from C-5 to F-7, then repeat **Pattern:** Tie and cut Cream.

**Note:** Continue to wind thread 8 times around each pair of prongs in 5th Round.

5th Round: Continue to follow light lines on Chart which are marked with a circle at each end. 1st Direction: Tie Cream to A-8 prong and wind 8 times across Frame to E-4 prong (parallel to Green line). Pattern: Skip 5 pairs of prongs around corners and wind around the next pair (parallel to last line). 2nd Direction: Take Cream around corner to C-8 and wind to A-4, then repeat Pattern (as given in 1st Direction).

**3rd Direction:** Take Cream around corner to E-8 prong and wind to C-4, then repeat **Pattern.** Tie and cut Cream.


**Note:** Continue to wind thread 8 times around prongs in 6th Round.

6th Round: Follow light lines on Chart which are marked with a cross in a circle. 1st Direction: Tie Yellow to A-6 prong and wind 8 times across Frame to E-6 prong. Pattern: Wind around the next pair, then skip 7 pairs of prongs around corners and wind around the next 2 pairs, having all lines parallel. 2nd Direction: Take Yellow around corner to C-6 prong and wind to A-6 prong, then repeat Pattern (as given in 1st Direction). 3rd Direction: Take Yellow around corner to E-6 prong and wind to C-6 prong, then repeat Pattern. Tie and cut Yellow.

Tying: Following GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR TYING, wind Cream on shuttle and working on back, tie each intersection (see dots on Chart), starting in center and working out to outer Yellow edge line. When completed cut threads close to prongs with scissors, comb out fringe and trim evenly 5/8 inch long.


Coaster (Size — 51/4 x 6 inches): Close Frame to smallest size. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it. Hold Frame with "A" side facing. Repeat 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Rounds. Following lines marked with a cross in a circle at ends, repeat 5th Round, using Yellow instead of Cream. Tie and cut Yellow. Repeat Tying and finishing.

Lay doilies right-side-down on a padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.



Patio Doily

Material: Lily Sky-Tone Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 123: 2 balls Red and 1 ball each Emerald Green and Cream; or

Lily Frost-Tone, Art. 49: 1 cone each Red, Med. Green and Cream; or

Daisy Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65, Size 20: 1 skein each Red, Emerald Green and Cream;

Lily Six Strand Floss, Art. 21: 1 skein Yellow No. 105: and


1 Lily Speed-O-Weave Frame.

SIZE — 15 x 17 inches.

Extend Frame to measure 9 inches on each side. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it. Hold Frame with "A" side facing.

Note: Wind thread 6 times (12 threads) around each pair of prongs in 1st Round.

1st Round: Following light lines on Chart which are marked with a circle at each end, tie Green to A-4 prong (see arrow). 1st Direction: Take thread across Frame to E-10 prong and wind around this pair of prongs 6 times (see NOTE above). Pattern: Skip 1 pair of prongs and wind 6 times around the next pair, sk 5 pairs of prongs and wind 6 times around the next par. Repeat this Pattern again across Frame, having all lines parallel. Then skip I pair of prongs and wind 6 times around the next pair (B-10 to D-4). 2nd Take thread around corner to C-4 Direction: prong and wind to A-10 prong, then repeat Pattern twice, having all lines parallel. Skip 1 pair



of prongs and wind around the next pair (D-10 to F-4). 3rd Direction: Take thread around corner to E-4 prong and wind to C-10 prong, then repeat Pattern twice, having all lines parallel. Skip I pair and wind around next pair (F-10 to B-4). 2nd Round: Take Green around corner to A-4

prong and repeat 1st Round except wind only 3 times around each pair of prongs (6 threads)

## Plaid Place Mat

SHOWN IN COLOR ON FRONT COVER

Materials: Lily Frost-Tone, Art. 49: 1 cone each Turquoise, Rose Fraise and Cream will make 6 Mats; or

Lily Sky-Tone, Art. 123: 1 ball each Turquoise, Rose and Cream will make 2 Mats; or

Lily Double Quick, Art. 50: 1 skein each Aqua, Flamingo and White will make 1 Mat; and

1 Lily Speed-O-Weave Frame.

Size — 12 x 19 inches.

Extend 2 sides of Frame (A & D) fully to  $13\frac{1}{2}$  inches; close other 4 sides (B, C, E & F) to smallest size. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it. Hold Frame with "A" side facing.


**Note:** Wind Frost-Tone or Sky-Tone 6 times (12 threads) or Double Quick 4 times (8 threads) around each pair of prongs in all Rounds.


1st Round: Following lines on Chart marked with a cross at ends, tie Turquoise (or Aqua) to A-3 prong. 1st Direction: Take thread across Frame to E-9 prong and wind around this pair of prongs 6 times (4 times for Double Quick,—see Note above). Pattern: Wind around the next 5 pairs of prongs; skip 1 pair of prongs and wind around the next 3 pairs; skip 5 pairs of prongs and wind around next 3 pairs; skip 1 pair of prongs and wind around next 3 pairs; skip 1 pair of prongs and wind around next 6 pairs, having all these lines parallel, and ending on B-9 to D-3. 3 Tie and cut Turquoise (or Aqua). 2nd Direc- 2

tion: Following lines on Chart marked with a circle at ends, tie Rose (or Flamingo) to C-3 prong and wind it 6 times (4 times for Double Quick) across Frame to A-17, then repeat Pattern (as given in 1st Direction), ending on D-17 to F-3. Tie and cut Rose (or Flamingo).

2nd Round: Following lines on Chart not marked with any symbol, tie Cream (or White) to A-9 prong and wind 6 times (4 times for Double Quick) to E-3 prong, skip 3 pairs of prongs and wind around next 5 pairs; skip 3 pairs of prongs and wind around next pair (B-3 to D-9), having all these lines parallel. 2nd Direction: Keeping Cream (or White) on B-3 prong, wind it 6 times (4 times for Double Quick) to F-9 prong, wind around the next 4 pairs of prongs, sk 7 pairs of prongs around corner and wind around the next 5 pairs. Tie and cut Cream (or White).

Following lines marked with a cross at ends, tie Turquoise (or Aqua) to B-8 prong and wind 6 times (4 times for Double Quick) to F-4 prong, then wind around the next 6 pairs of prongs (all parallel), ending on C-4 to E-8. Tie and cut Turquoise (or Aqua). 3d Direction: Following lines not marked with symbols, tie Cream (or White)

**Buffet Set** 

SHOWN IN COLOR ON FRONT COVER

Materials: Lily Mercrochet Cotton, Art. 161, Size 20: 3 balls Hunter Green and 4 balls Ecru;

Daisy Mercerized Crochet Cotton, Art. 65, Size 20: 2 skeins Emerald Green and 3 skeins Ecru;

**Lily Double Quick, Art. 50:** 4 skeins Dk. Emerald or Aqua and 5 skeins Ecru; and

1 Lily Speed-O-Weave Frame.

**Large Doily** (Size -  $14 \times 17$  inches): Extend 4 sides of Frame (B, C, E & F) to 12 inches and close other 2 sides (A & D) to smallest size. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it. Hold Frame with "A" side facing.

**Note:** Wind Mercrochet or Daisy 4 times (8 threads) or Double Quick twice (4 threads) around each pair of prongs in 1st Round.

1st Round: Following light lines on Chart not marked with any symbol, tie Green (or Aqua) to A-7 prong (see arrow). 1st Direction: Take it up across Frame to E-11 prong and wind 4 times (twice for Double Quick) around this pair of prongs (see Note above). Pattern: Wind 4 times (twice for Double Quick) around the next 2 pairs of prongs. Skip 3 pairs of prongs and wind around the next 3 pairs, doing this a 2nd time across Frame. Have all these Green lines parallel. 2nd Direction: Take Green around corner to C-7 prong and wind to A-5 prong. Repeat Pattern (as given in 1st Direction), ending on D-5


to F-7. **3rd Direction:** Take Green around corner to E-7 prong and wind to C-11 prong. Repeat **Pattern.** Then skip 3 pairs of prongs and wind around the next 3 prongs, ending on F-11 to B-7. **2d Round:** Repeat 1st Round, (16 mercrochet or Daisy threads, or 8 Double Quick threads) total between prongs. Tie and cut Green (or Aqua).

**Note:** Wind thread 8 times (16 threads) (or 4 times for Double Quick, - 8 threads) around

each pair of prongs in 3d Round.

3d Round: Following heavy lines on Chart marked with a circle at ends, tie Ecru to F-15 prong. 1st Direction: Take Ecru up lengthwise of Frame to E-3 and wind 8 times (4 times for Double Quick) around this pair of prongs (see Note above). Skip 3 pairs of prongs around corner and wind around the next pair. Skip 2 pairs of prongs and wind around the next pair, doing this a 2nd time across Frame. Then skip 3 pairs of prongs around corner and wind around the next pair (B-3 to C-15). **2nd Direction:** Skip 11 prongs on B and wind from B-15 to F-15. **Pat**tern: Skip 3 prongs on left side, 2 prongs on right and wind around the next pair. Skip 2 pairs of prongs and wind around the next pair, doing this twice more across Frame. Then skip 2 prongs on left side, 3 prongs around corner on right side and wind around the next pair. All these lines must be parallel. 3rd Direction: Take Ecru around 2 corners to E-3 and wind to C-3. Then repeat Pattern (as given in 2nd Direction), ending on F-3 to B-3.

Note: Continue to wind 8 times (4 times for



Double Quick) around each pair of prongs in 4th Round.


4th Round: 1st Direction: Skip 7 prongs on F and wind 8 times (4 times for Double Quick) from F-11 prong to D-1 corner prong. Skip 5 pairs of prongs and wind from A-1 corner prong to C-11 prong parallel to 1st line. 2nd Direction: Skip 9 prongs on A and wind from B-1 corner prong to E-7 prong. Skip 5 pairs of prongs on B and wind from B-7 to E-1 corner prong. 3rd Direction: Skip 3 prongs on B and wind from B-11 across Frame to F-7. Skip 5 pairs of prongs and wind from C-1 to F-1 corner prongs. Skip 5 pairs of prongs and wind from C-7 to E-11 prongs. Tie and cut Ecru.

**5th & 6th Rounds:** Repeat 3d & 4th Rounds, (32 Ecru Mercrochet or Daisy threads, or 16 Double Quick threads) total between prongs. Tie and cut Ecru.

Tying: Following GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR TYING, wind 2 strands Green Mercrochet or Daisy (or 1 strand Double Quick) on shuttle and working on back, tie all intersections (see dots on Chart), working out to 10 points around edge. Cut threads close to prongs with scissors, comb out fringe and trim evenly 5% inch long.

Small Doily (Size - 10 x 11 inches): Close Frame to smallest size. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it. Hold Frame with "A" side facing. Note: Wind Green 4 times (8 threads) (or twice for Double Quick) around each pair of prongs in 1st Round.

1st Round: Following light lines on Chart not marked with any symbol, tie Green (or Aqua) to A-7 prong. 1st Direction: Take thread across Frame to E-5 and wind 4 times (twice for Double




Quick) around this pair of prongs (see Note above). Pattern: Wind around the next 2 pairs of prongs, skip 3 pairs of prongs around corner and wind around the next 3 pairs, having all these lines parallel. 2nd Direction: Take Green around corner to C-7 prong and wind to A-5, then repeat Pattern across Frame ending on D-5 to F-7. 3rd Direction: Take Green around corner to E-7 and wind to C-5, then repeat Pattern across Frame, ending on F-5 to B-7.

**2d Round:** Repeat 1st Round, (16 Green Mercrochet or Daisy threads, or 8 Double Quick Threads) total between prongs. Tie and cut Green (or Aqua).

Note: Wind thread 8 times (16 threads) (or 4 times for Double Quick) around each pair of

prongs in 3d Round. 3d Round: Following heavy lines on Chart marked with a circle at ends, tie Ecru to A-3 prong. 1st Direction: Wind Ecru 8 times (or 4 times for Double Quick, - see Note above) straight across Frame to D-9. Skip 9 prongs and wind from F-1 to C-1 corner prongs. 5th & 6th Rounds: Repeat 3d & 4th Rounds, (32 Mercrochet or Daisy threads, or 16 Double Quick threads) total between prongs. Tie and cut Ecru Repeat Tying, starting in center and working out to 6 points (see dots on Chart). Repeat finishing. Make 2 Small Doilies.

Lay doilies right-side-down on a padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

Repeat Pattern 6 times across Frame, then skip 1 pair of prongs and wind around next 2 pairs (ending on D-18 to F-2 prongs). 3rd Direction: Skip 2 prongs around corner and wind thread from E-3 prong across Frame to C-17 prong, then wind around next pair of prongs. Repeat Pattern 4 times across Frame, then skip 1 pair of prongs and wind around next 2 pairs (ending on F-17 to B-3 prongs). Tie and cut Pastels.

**Tying:** Following GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR TYING, wind Pastels (or Aqua for Double Quick) on shuttle and working on back, tie each intersection (see dots on Chart).

Cut threads on outside of Frame with a razor blade, comb out fringe and trim evenly ½ inch long. With Yellow Floss, make a French Knot on tie in center of each of 23 Blue Daisies,—(see large dots on Chart).

Lay doily right-side-down on a padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.



Materials: Lily Frost-Tone, Art. 49: 1 cone each Cream and Rose Fraise; and

1 Lily Speed-O-Weave Frame.

Size — 14 x 21 inches.

Extend 2 sides of Frame (A & D) fully to  $13\frac{1}{2}$  inches, extend other 4 sides (B, C, E & F) to 9



inches. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it. Hold Frame with "A" side facing.

Note: Wind thread 6 times (12 threads) around each pair of prongs in 1st thru 4th Round. 1st Round: Following light lines on Chart not marked with symbols, tie Cream to A-4 prong. 1st Direction: Wind it 6 times (see Note above) across Frame to E-10 prong. Pattern: Skip 2 pairs of prongs and wind around the next pair. Repeat this Pattern 7 times across Frame, having all lines parallel,—ending on B-10 to D-4 prongs. 2nd Direction: Skip 5 prengs around corner and wind from C-4 prong across Frame to A-16 prong. Repeat Pattern 8 times across Frame, having all lines parallel,—ending on D-16 to F-4 prongs. 3rd Direction: Skip 5 prongs around corner and wind from E-4 prong lengthwise of Frome to C-10 prong. Repeat Pattern 6 times across Frame, having all lines parallel,—ending on F-10 to B-4 prongs.

2nd Round: 1st Direction: Skip 8 prongs around corner and wind Cream from A-7 prong across corner to F-7 prong. Skip 5 pairs of prongs and wind around next pair; skip 5 prongs on A, 2 prongs on E and wind from B-1 to E-10 prongs. Pattern: Skip 2 pairs of prongs and wind around next pair. Repeat this Pattern twice. Sk p 2 prongs on B, 5 on D and wind from C-1 to D-13 prongs; skip 5 pairs of prongs and wind around next pair (C-7 to D-7), having all these lines parallel. 2nd Direction: Keeping Cream on same (C-7) prong, wind it across end corner to B-7 prong, skip 5 pairs of prongs and wind around next (corner) pair. Repeat Pattern 6 times across Frame to next corner pair; skip 5 pairs of prongs and wind across end corner from E-7 to F-7 prongs,—having all lines parellel. 3rd Direction: Keeping Cream on same E-7 prong, wind it across corner to D-13 prong; skip 5 pairs

of prongs and wind around next pair; skip 2 prongs on F, 5 on D and wind from F-4 to D-1 prongs. Repeat **Pattern** 3 times across Frame. Skip 5 prongs on A, 2 on C and wind from A-7 to C-1 prongs; skip 5 pairs of prongs and wind across corners around A-13 to B-7 prongs, having all lines parallel. Tie and cut Cream.

**3rd & 4th Rounds:** Repeat 1st & 2nd Rounds (24 Cream threads total between prongs). Tie and cut Cream.

**Note:** Wind thread 8 times (16 threads) around each pair of prongs in 5th Round.

5th Round: Following heavy lines on Chart marked with a circle on ends, tie Rose Fraise to A-3 prong. 1st Direction: Wind it 8 times (see Note above) across Frame to E-11 prong. Pattern: Skip 1 pair of prongs and wind around next pair; skip 3 pairs of prongs and wind around next pair. Repeat this Pattern 3 times across Frame. Skip 1 pair of prongs and wind around next pair (B-11 to D-3), having all lines parallel. 2nd Direction: Take thread around corner to C-3 prong and wind across Frame to A-17 prong. Repeat Pattern 4 times across Frame; skip 1 pair of prengs and wind around next pair (D-17 to F-3). having all lines parallel. 3rd Direction: Take thread around corner to E-3 prong and wind lengthwise of Frame to C-11 prong. Repeat Pattern 3 times; skip 1 pair of prongs and wind around next pair (F-11 to B-3), having all lines parallel. Tie and cut Rose Fraise.

**Tying:** Following GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR TYING, wind Rose Fraise on shuttle and tie each intersection (see dots on Chart). Cut threads close to prongs with scissors, comb out fringe and trim evenly 1 inch long.

Lay doily right-side-down on a padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

tion: Skip 5 prongs on C and wind from C-9 prong across Frame to A-3 prong. Repeat **Pattern**, ending on D-3 to F-9 prongs. Tie and cut Red.

**3rd Round:** Repeat 1st Round (20 Cream threads or 12 Ecru Double Quick threads) total between prongs. Tie and cut Cream (or Ecru).

Tying: Following GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR TYING, wind Cream (or Ecru) on shuttle and working on back, tie each intersection (see dots on Chart), starting in center and working out to 6 points. Cut threads close to prongs with scissors, comb out fringe and trim evenly around points 3/4 inch long. Lay doily right-sidedown on a padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.



Lily Six Strand Floss, Art. 21: 1 skein Yellow No. 105; and



#### 1 Lily Speed-O-Weave Frame.

Size — 12 x 19 inches


Extend 2 sides of Frame (A & D) fully to  $13\frac{1}{2}$  inches, close other 4 sides (B, C, E & F) to smallest size. Tie a string around "A" side to mark it. Hold Frame with "A" side facing.

**Note:** Wind Frost-Tone or Sky-Tone 3 times (6 threads) or Double Quick twice (4 threads) around each pair of prongs in 1st Round.

**1st Round:** Following light lines on Chart, tie Green (or Aqua) to A-4 prong (see arrow). **1st Direction:** Take thread up across Frame to E-8 prong and wind around this pair of prongs 3 times (twice for Double Quick,—see Note above). Continuing to left, wind 3 times (twice for Double Quick) around each of the next 2 pairs of prongs (A-5 to E-7 and A-6 to E-6)

Pattern: Skip 1 pair of prongs and wind around the next 3 pairs, repeating this Pattern across Frame to far side, all lines being parallel to each other,—ending on B-8 to D-4. 2nd Direction: Take Green around corner to C-4 and wind to A-16, then wind around the next 2 pairs of prongs. Now repeat Pattern (as given in 1st DIRECTION),—ending on D-16 to F-4. 3rd Direction: Take Green around corner to E-4 and wind to C-8, then wind around the next 2 pairs of prongs. Now repeat Pattern, ending on F-8 to B-4. Tie and cut Green (or Aqua).

Note: Wind Frost-Tone or Sky-Tone 6 times



(12 threads) or Double Quick 3 times (6 threads) around each pair of prongs in 2d Round. 2d Round: Following heavy lines on Chart marked with a circle at ends, tie Cream (or White) to A-3 prong. 1st Direction: Take thread up across Frame to E-9 and wind 6 times (3 times for Double Quick) around this pair of prongs. Pattern: Skip 3 pairs of prongs and wind around the next pair, repeating this Pattern across Frame to far side, all lines being parallel, -ending on B-9 to D-3. 2nd Direction: Take Cream around corner and wind from C-3 to A-17. Now repeat Pattern as given in 1st DIRECTION, ending on D-17 to F-3. 3rd Direction: Take Cream around corner and wind from E-3 to C-9. Now repeat Pattern across Frame, ending on F-9 to B-3.

3d Round: Repeat 2d Round, (24 Frost-Tone or Sky-Tone threads, or 12 Double Quick threads) total between prongs. Tie and cut Cream (or White).

Tying: Following GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR TYING, wind Yellow Floss on shuttle and working on back, tie the center of each Cream (or White) daisy and also the half-daisies around edge of design (see large dots on Chart). Then wind Green (or Aqua) on shuttle and tie all remaining intersections (see small dots on Chart). When completed, cut threads close to prongs with scissors, comb out fringe and trim evenly 1 inch long. Lay doily right-side-down on a padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.

crochet or Daisy threads, or 12 Double Quick threads) total between prongs. Tie and cut Green.

**Note:** Wind Mercrochet or Daisy 8 times (16 threads) or Double Quick 4 times (8 threads) around all pairs of prongs in 3d Round.

3d Round: All the lines in this Round cross in center of Frame like spokes of a wheel. Following heavy lines on Chart marked with a cross on ends, tie Ecru to A-6 (center) prong and wind it 8 times (4 times for Double Quick, - see Note above) across center of Frame to D-6 prong; skip 4 prongs and wind from B-1 to E-1 corner prongs; skip 4 prongs and wind from B-6 to E-6

(center) prongs; skip 4 prongs and wind from C-1 to F-1 corner prongs; skip 4 prongs and wind from C-6 to F-6 (center) prongs; skip 4 prongs and wind from D-1 to A-1 corner prongs.

4th Round: Repeat 3d Round, (32 Ecru Mercrochet or Daisy threads, or 16 Ecru Double Quick threads) total between prongs. Tie and cut Ecru.

Tying: Following GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR TYING, wind 2 strands Green Mercrochet or Daisy, or 1 strand Green Double Quick, on shuttle and working on back, tie each intersection (see dots on Chart), starting in center and working out to points. Cut threads close to prongs with scissors, comb out fringe and trim evenly around points 3/4 inch long. Lay doily right-side-down on a padded board. Steam and press dry thru a cloth.
