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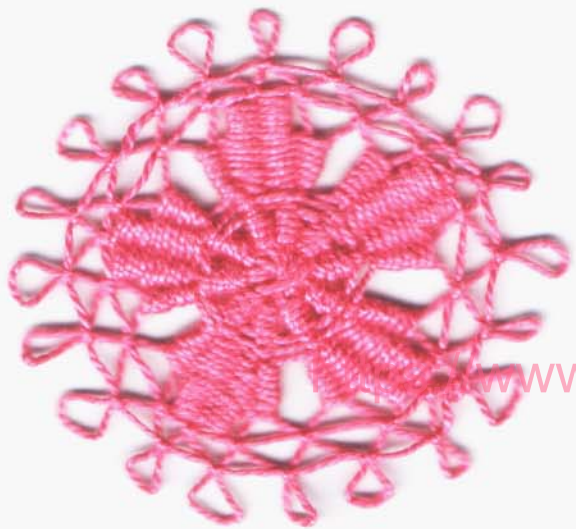
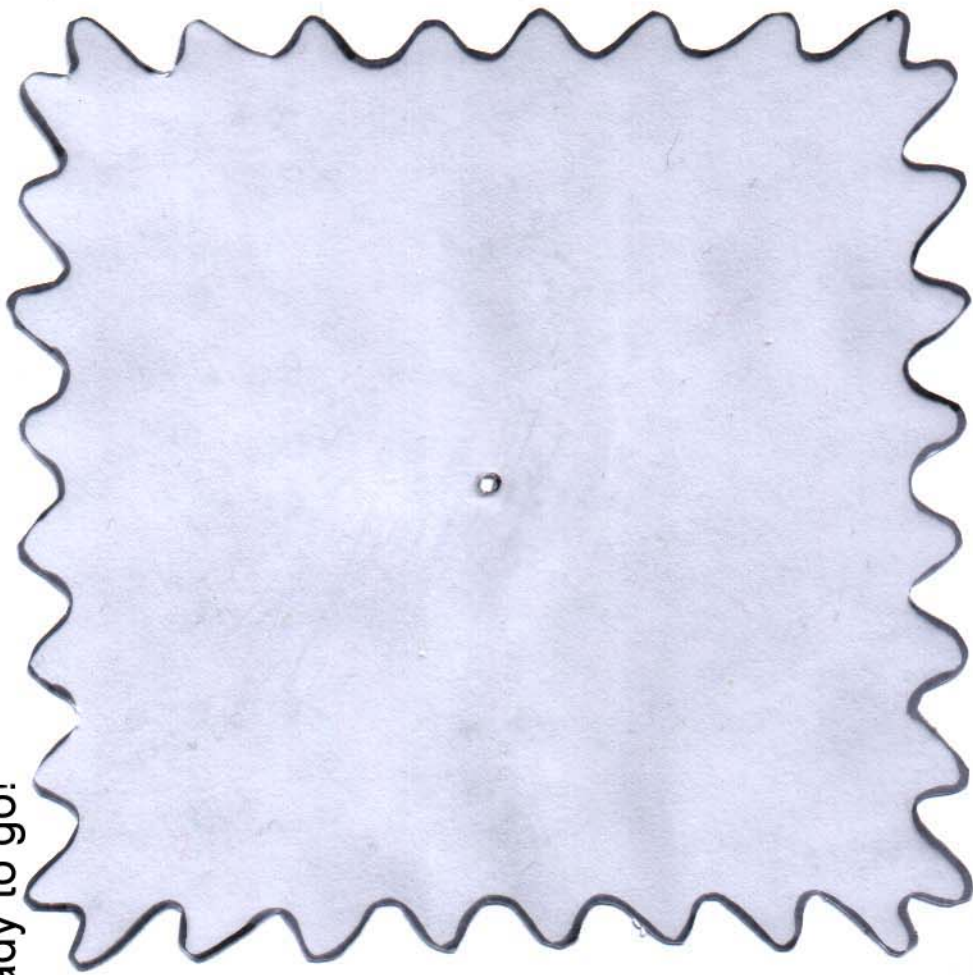
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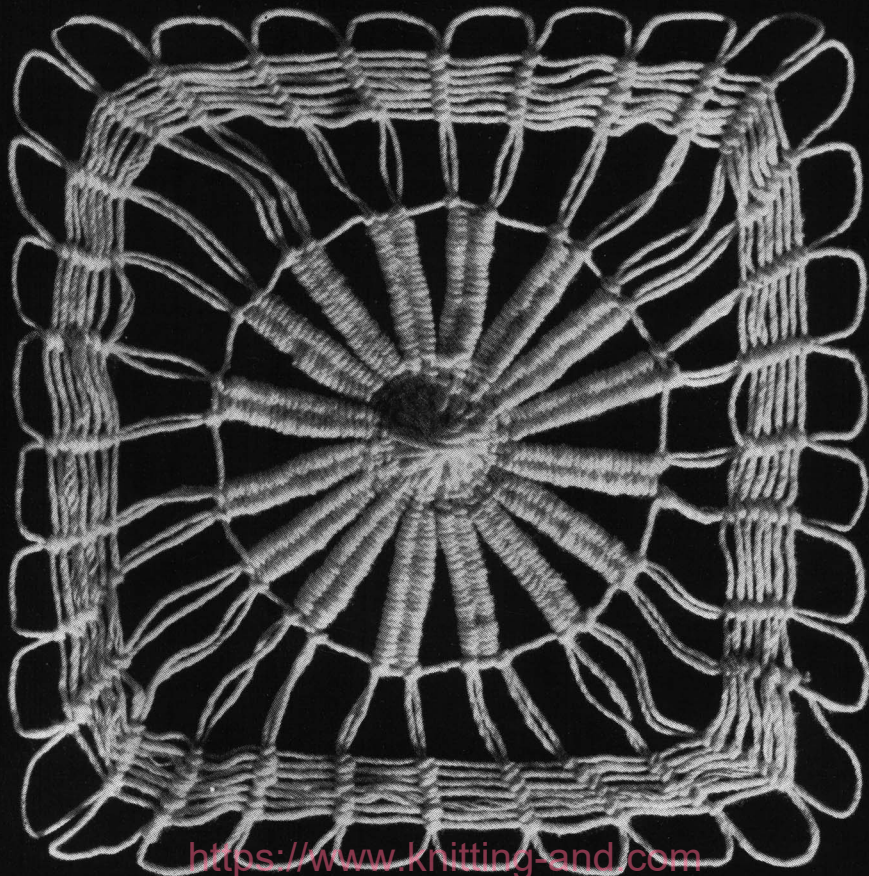

## DESIGN No. 1

1. **Center**—stitch C, under 2 threads, over 2.

2. **Spokes**—stitch C, under 2, over 2. When a spoke is finished run thread

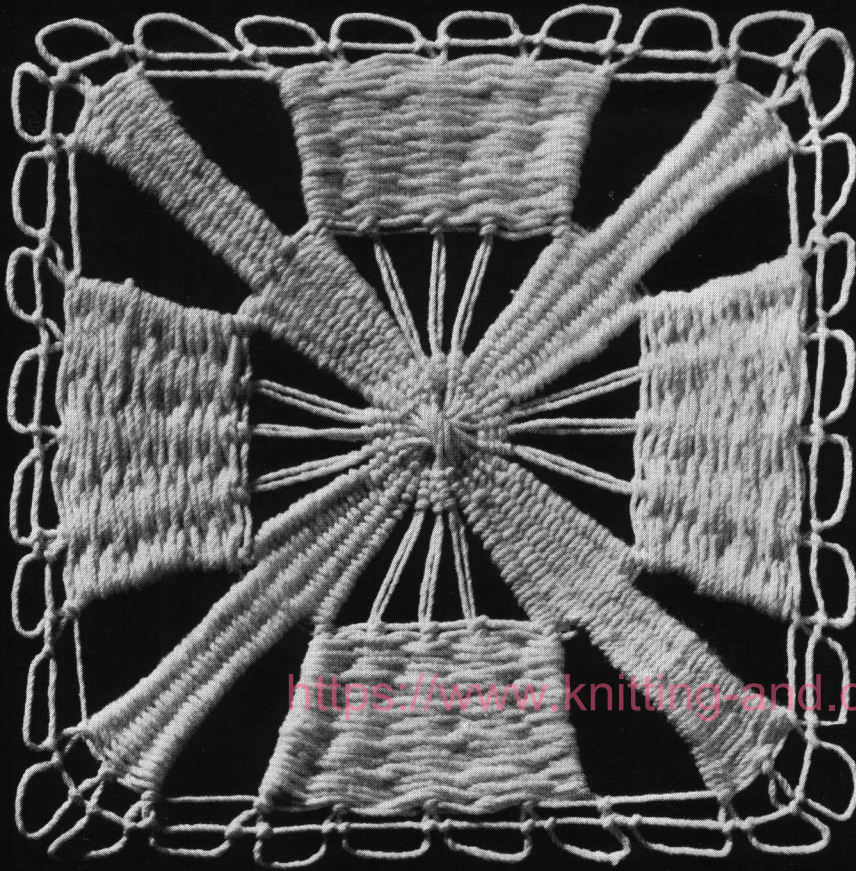
back through it to center and continue on next spoke.

3. **Knots**—1 row stitch B.

4. **Border**—7 rows stitch B.

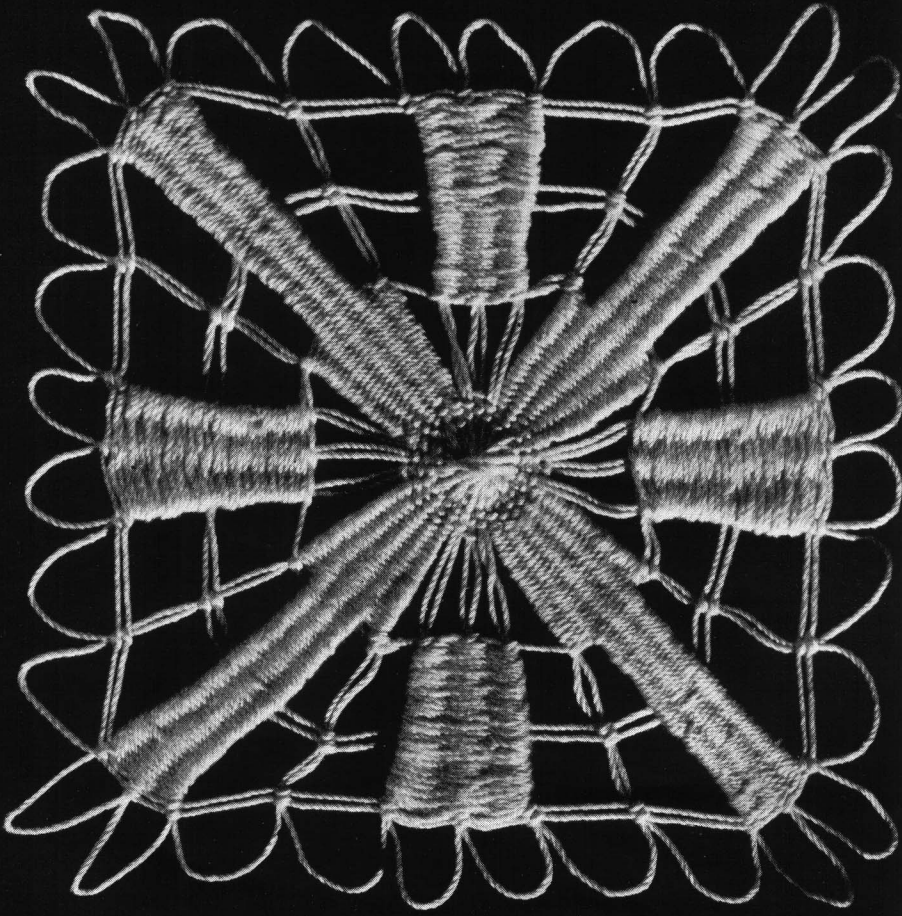




### DESIGN No. 2

1. **Center**—stitch A.
2. **Corner sections**—stitch C, under 2 threads, over 2. After a section is finished run thread back through section to fasten it.
3. **Knots**—stitch B. 2 rows of 5 knots on each side. Run thread under corner sections.
4. **Side sections**—stitch C.
5. **Edge**—stitch B. On first row work 1 knot around 2 threads. On last row work 1 knot around every thread.

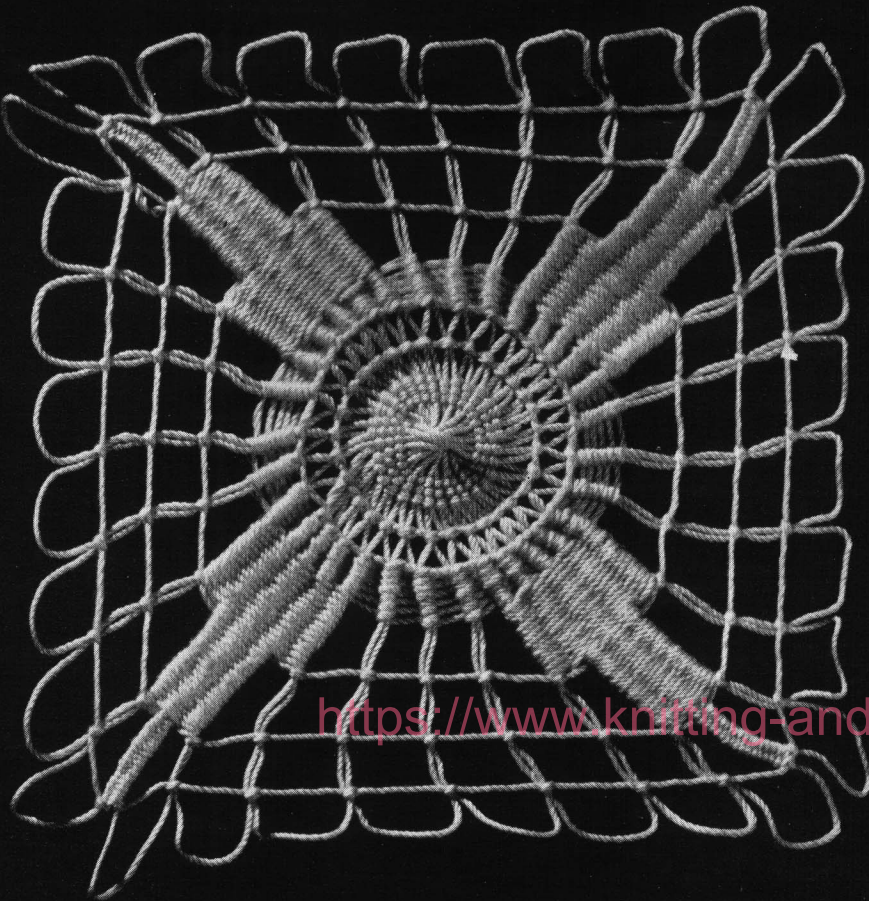


### DESIGN No. 3

1. **Center**—stitch C, under 2 threads, over 2.
2. **Corner sections**—stitch C, under 2 threads over 2. Fasten thread after each section by running it back through section.
3. **Knots**—stitch B. Run thread under corner sections.
4. **Side sections**—stitch C.
5. **Knots**—2 rows stitch B, catching thread through back of each section to keep the square shape.
6. **Edge**—2 rows stitch B.

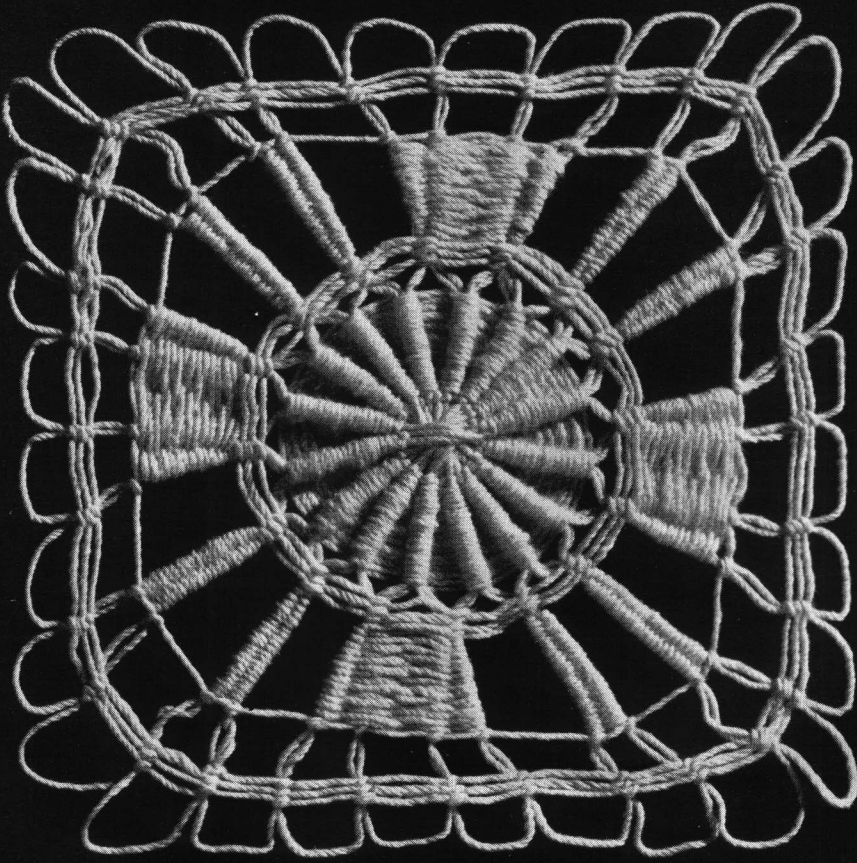




#### DESIGN No. 4

1. **Center**—Stitch A.
2. **Knofs**—stitch B. For first row use 1 thread from 1 group and 1 from next group. For next row divide threads again so pairs of threads are in original position.
3. **Solid circle**—stitch A.
4. **Corner sections**—stitch C. The 2 widest parts are worked under 2 threads, over 2. For the narrow part separate 2 center threads and work under 1, over 1. Fasten end by running it back through section.
5. **Knofs**—stitch B. On the 2 inner rows run thread under corner sections. On outer row make a knot around each pair of threads on sides, and at corners make a knot around each of the 2 threads.

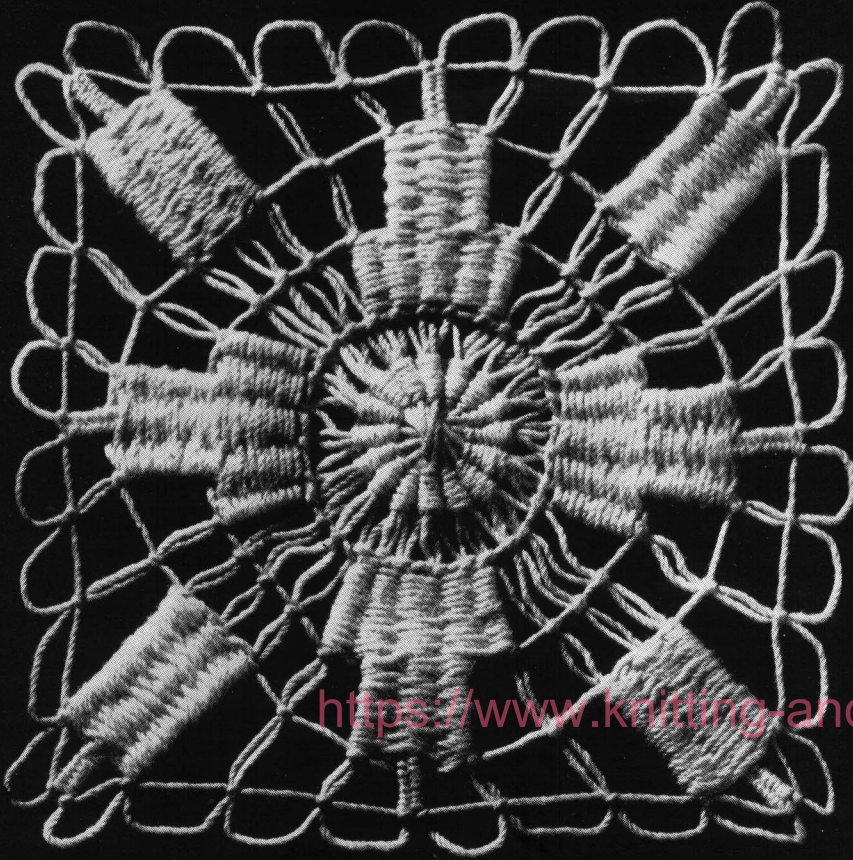


#### DESIGN No. 5

1. **Center**—stitch A. Make 1 row, 2 threads for each group. Then fill out space, using 4 threads for each group.
2. **Knofs**—3 rows stitch B. Divide threads, using 2 from each group for each knot.
3. **Solid sections**—stitch C, under 2 threads, over 2. As each section is finished fasten end by running it back through section.
4. **Knofs**—stitch B.

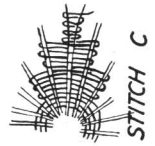
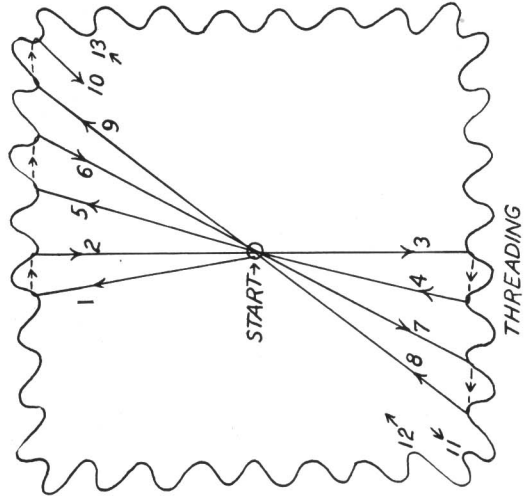


## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

### THREADING

This is the same for both square and round motifs. Use thread from ball and draw end through center hole in spider web weaver. Hold end on back. Then as in "Threading" diagram carry thread on top of spider web weaver from center hole to notch at edge (1), under a scallop to the **right** (broken lines show thread on back of form), carry thread across hole to opposite notch (2-3). Follow direction of arrows and numbers until spider web weaver is threaded **twice**. (2 threads in every notch.) All threads must cross at center at center. Threading should end over hole. Run end of needle from edge toward center between each pair of threads so that all threads are straight. Cut thread about 1 yard from spider web weaver

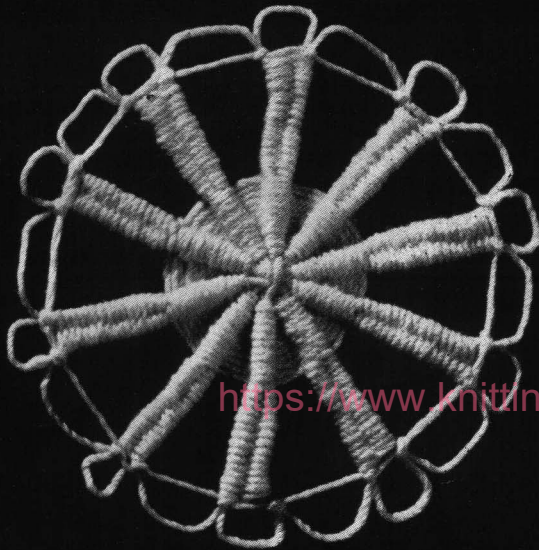
and thread in a needle. Begin to work at opposite side of center from where threading finished. At all times threads should be worked in their correct order according to the position at notched edge. Finish motif according to design diagram which may be cut out and fastened to the spider web weaver with paper clips if desired. Each line in all diagrams indicates 1 thread, except the notched edge which is edge of spider web weaver. When thread is used up fasten well by running it through a solid space. Fasten new thread in the same place—do not use knots to fasten. When motif is finished fasten thread and slip the loops carefully off the form. **Crochet motifs together with single crochet stitches in loops and chains between.**



### DESIGN No. 6

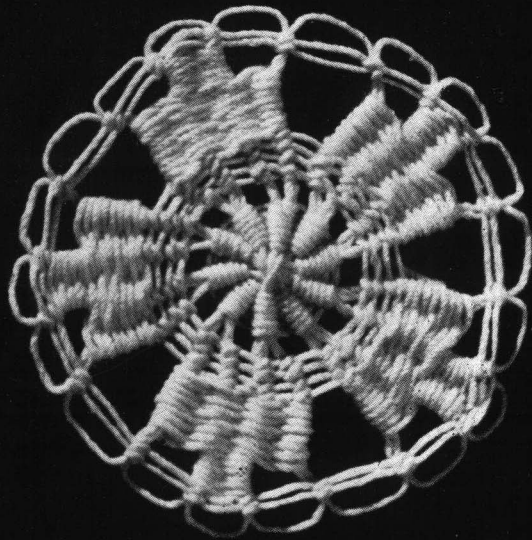
1. **Center**—Stitch A, working over 4 threads for each group.
2. **Knots**—Stitch B. Divide threads, using the 2 center ones of each group for 1 knot and the last thread of 1 group with first thread of next group for next knot.
3. **Side sections**—Stitch C. Divide threads in the original pairs. The widest parts are under 2 threads, over 2. The narrow part—under 1, over 1. Fasten thread from each section by running it back through section.
4. **Knots**—2 rows of stitch B. Run thread under the solid sections.
5. **Corner sections**—stitch C. Same as side sections.
6. **Knots**—stitch B. At small sections make 1 knot around each of the 2 threads. At other places make 1 knot around 2 threads.

**DESIGN NO. 7 — 8 Yards**

1. **Center**—stitch A, working around 4 threads for each group.
2. **Spokes**—stitch C, under 2 threads, over 2. As each spoke is finished run thread back through it, and continue for next one.
3. **Knots**—stitch B.



**DESIGN NO. 8 — 8 Yards**

1. **Center**—stitch A, working around 4 threads for each group.
2. **Knots**—4 rows stitch B, making each knot around 2 threads.
3. **Solid sections**—stitch C, under 2 threads, over 2. After each section is finished run thread back through it to fasten.
4. **Knots**—stitch B, 2 rows.

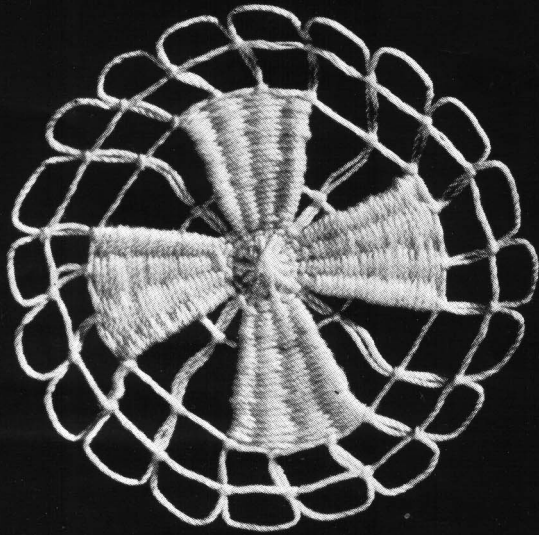

**DESIGN NO. 9 — 8 Yards**

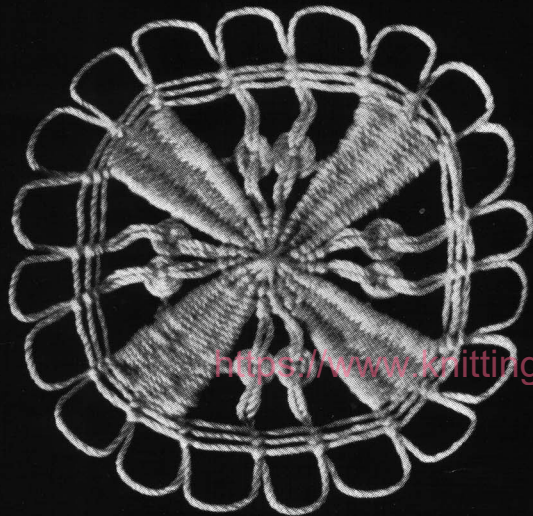
1. **Center**—stitch A.
2. **Long sections**—stitch C, under 2 threads, over 2. Work each section out as far as the first row of knots. Fasten end by running it back through section.
3. **Knots**—stitch B.
4. **Sections**—Finish long sections and make short sections.
5. **Knots**—2 rows stitch B.



**DESIGN NO. 10 — 8 Yards**

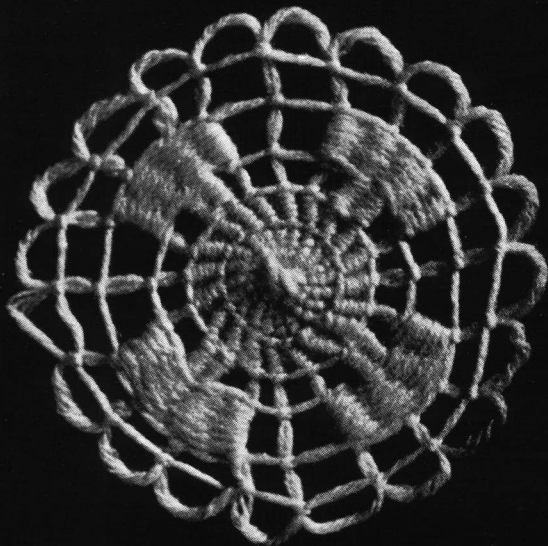
1. **Center**—stitch C.
2. **Solid Sections**—stitch C. As each section is finished run thread back through it and continue with next one.
3. **Knots**—stitch B. On first row catch thread through back of solid sections. On other 2 rows make knots all around.





**DESIGN NO. 11 — 7 Yards**

1. **Center**—stitch A.
2. **Solid sections**—stitch C, under 2 threads, over 2. After each section is finished, fasten thread by running it back through section.
3. **Small circles**—Fasten thread in side of a section, then in side of next section, keeping needle thread on top of the 2 pairs of threads on form. Make a stitch around cross thread in first space to twist it once, then work under the 2 threads, over the cross thread, until there are about 4 rounds for the little circle. Twist the needle thread once around cross thread in center space. Then make other little circle. Twist needle once around cross



**DESIGN NO. 12 — 7 Yards**

1. **Center**—3 rows stitch A. 1 row stitch B. 4 rows stitch A. 1 row stitch B.
  2. **Solid sections**—stitch C, under 2 threads, over 2. When section is finished fasten thread by running it back through section.
  3. **Knots**—stitch B. Make 3 knots between sections and run thread under solid sections.
  4. **Edge**—stitch B. 2 rows all around.
- thread in last space. Run thread through to other side of solid section and make 2 circles in next space the same way. Make circles in other 2 spaces.
- 4 **Edge**—stitch B.

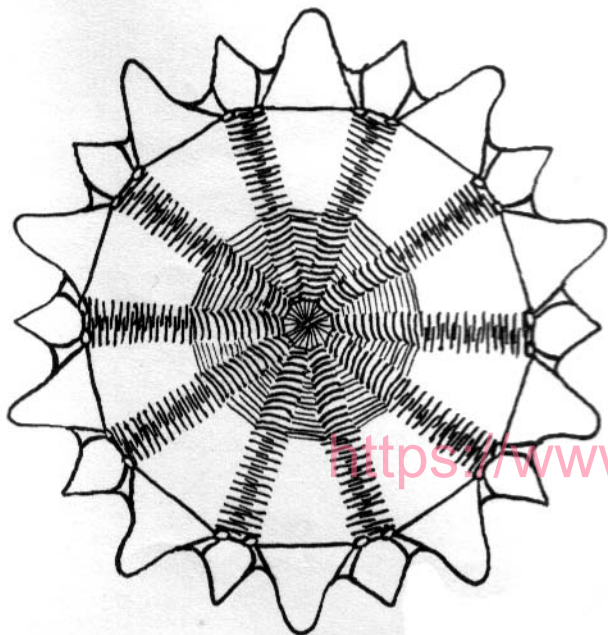
