IMPORTANT!

The correct size of any of the garments illustrated in this Book will only be obtained by USING THE WOOL RECOMMENDED IN THE RECIPE AND KNITTING AT THE CORRECT TENSION. To ensure this, use the wool and needles specified, and knit a small piece of fabric in the given pattern. If knitted correctly, the number of stitches to the inch in width should correspond with the tension given.

¶ When the instructions read, "Cast off 2 stitches, K.2" (or similar stitches), the stitch on the right-hand needle, after casting off, is counted as one stitch.

Maize (shade 2042) 4 ozs.

"WHITE HEATHER" Embroidery Wool.

Light Orange (shade 5377) 1 skein

Dark Orange (shade 5380) 1 skein

Rust (shade 7087) 1 skein

Green (shade 13A) 1 skein

"Beehive" Knitting Needles 1 pair No. 9

ABBREVIATIONS:—See page 3.

TENSION:—

It is absolutely necessary to work at a tension to produce 1 pattern to 2 inches in width.

THE TEA COSY.—Cast on 63 stitches.

1st row.—Knit plain. Repeat the 1st row for $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches. Proceed as follows:—

1st row.—K.1, K.2 tog., * wl. fwd., K.9, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., repeat from * to the last 12 stitches, wl. fwd., K.9, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1.

2nd and alternate rows.—K.1, purl to the last stitch, K.1.

3rd row.—K.3, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.3, repeat from * to the end of the row.

5th row.—K.4, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.5, repeat from * to the last 11 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.4.

7th row.—K.5, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.7, repeat from * to the last 10 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.5.

9th row.—K.6, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., wl. fwd., K.9, repeat from * to the last 9 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., wl. fwd., K.6.

11th row.—K.4, * K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.3, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5, repeat from * to the last 11 stitches, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.3, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.4.

13th row.—K.3, * K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.5, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, repeat from * to the end of the row.

15th row.—K.2, * K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.7, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, repeat from * to the last stitch, K.1.

16th row.—K.1, purl to the last stitch, K.1.

Repeat from the 1st to the 16th rows once.

Proceed as follows:—

1st row.—K.3 tog., * wl. fwd., K.9, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., repeat from * to the last 12 stitches, wl. fwd., K.9, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o.

2nd and alternate rows.—K.1, purl to the last stitch, K.1.

3rd row.—K.2 tog., * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.3, repeat from * to the last 11 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.2 tog.

5th row.—K.2 tog., * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.5, repeat from * to the last 9 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.2 tog.

7th row.—K.2 tog., * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.7, repeat from * to the last 7 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.2 tog.

9th row.—K.2 tog., * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o.,

wl. fwd., K.9, repeat from * to the last 5 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., wl. fwd., K.2 tog.

11th row.—K.2 tog., K.2, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.3, repeat from * to the last 13 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.2, K.2 tog.

13th row.—K.2 tog., K.2, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.5, repeat from * to the last 11 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.2, K.2 tog.

15th row.—K.2 tog., K.2, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.7, repeat from * to the last 9 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.2, K.2 tog.

17th row.—K.2 tog., K.2, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., wl. fwd., K.9, repeat from * to the last 7 stitches, slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., wl. fwd., K.2, K.2 tog.

19th row.—K.3 tog., wl. fwd., K.3, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5, K.2 tog., repeat from * to the last 6 stitches, wl. fwd., K.3, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o.

21st row.—K.2 tog., K.4, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.5, repeat from * to the last 13 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.4, K.2 tog.

23rd row.—K.2 tog., K.4, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.7, repeat from * to the last 11 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.4, K.2 tog.

25th row.—K.2 tog., K.4, * wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., wl. fwd., K.9, repeat from * to the last 9 stitches, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., wl. fwd., K.4, K.2 tog.

26th row.—K.1, purl to the last stitch, K.1. Cast off.

Work another Section in the same manner.

THE LINING.—Cast on 56 stitches.

1st row.—Knit plain. Repeat this row for 5 inches.

Continue working in Garter Stitch, decreasing once at the beginning and end of the needle in the next and every alternate row, until 30 stitches remain. Cast off.

Work another Section in the same manner.

TO MAKE UP THE COSY.—With a slightly damp cloth and warm iron, press lightly. Using the Embroidery Wool, work the flowers and leaves in Lazy Daisy Stitch at the top point of every alternate diamond. Sew up the side seams, leaving an opening at each side for the spout and handle. Make two twisted cords 12 inches in length and finish with a tassel at one end. Sew the cord in position round the sides and top of the Cosy, placing the tassels at the top.

THE TEA POT HOLDER.—Cast on 39 stitches.

1st row.—Knit plain. Repeat this row once.

3rd row.—K.1, purl to the last stitch, K.1.

Proceed as follows:—

1st row.—K.1, K.2 tog., (wl. fwd., K.9, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o.) twice, wl. fwd., K.9, wl. fwd., K.2 tog., K.1.

2nd and alternate rows.—K.1, purl to the last stitch, K.1.

3rd row.—K.3, (wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.3) three times.

5th row.—K.4, (wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.5) twice, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.4.

7th row.—K.5, (wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.7) twice, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.5.

9th row.—K.6, (wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., wl. fwd., K.9) twice, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.2 tog., p.s.s.o., wl. fwd., K.6.

11th row.—K.4, (K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.3, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.5) twice, K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.3, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.4.

13th row.—K.3, (K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.5, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.3) three times.

15th row.—K.2, (K.2 tog., wl. fwd., K.7, wl. fwd., slip 1, K.1, p.s.s.o., K.1) three times, K.1.

16th row.—K.1, purl to the last stitch, K.1.

Repeat these 16 rows twice, then 1st row once. Cast off.

THE LINING.—Cast on 40 stitches.

1st row.—Knit plain. Repeat this row for 6 ins. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP THE TEA POT HOLDER.—With a slightly damp cloth and a warm iron, press lightly. Using the Embroidery Wool, embroider flowers and leaves in Lazy Daisy Stitch on every alternate diamond. Sew the lining in position. Make a twisted cord and sew round edge of the Holder, making a loop in one corner.
